# NURSERY



## ENGLISH

Number 12 was introduced to the students. They did counting of number 12 using different objects and practiced writing number 12 in their workbook.



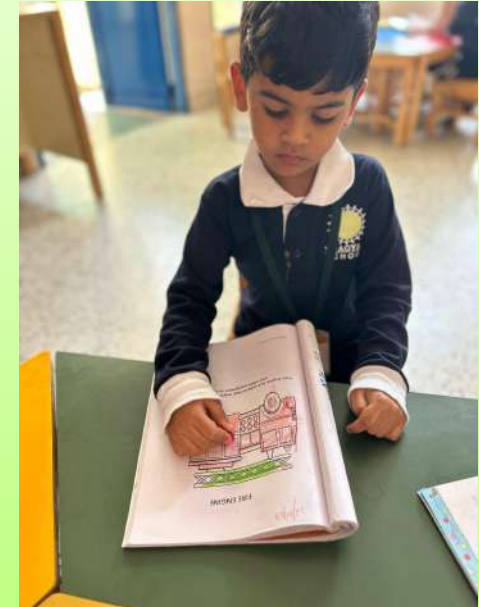
# HINDI

# KINDERGARTEN

## ENGLISH



The children were introduced to lowercase letter 'y' using pictures and jolly phonic songs. They also learnt three letter words of 'ab' family. Written work was done both in notebook and workbook.

# MATHS

During Maths class, sequence counting 140-150 was introduced in writing and oral counting from 0-150 was done in class. Practice of writing from 100-150 was also done.



# HINDI

Vyanjan ऋ was introduced to the children in class. They were introduced to different words related to the vyanjan. The children did written work in busybee and notebook.

Children naturally love to move and sing. Students of Nursery and KG enjoyed learning and revising the song 'Meri Jhopdi ke Bhag' during their music class.



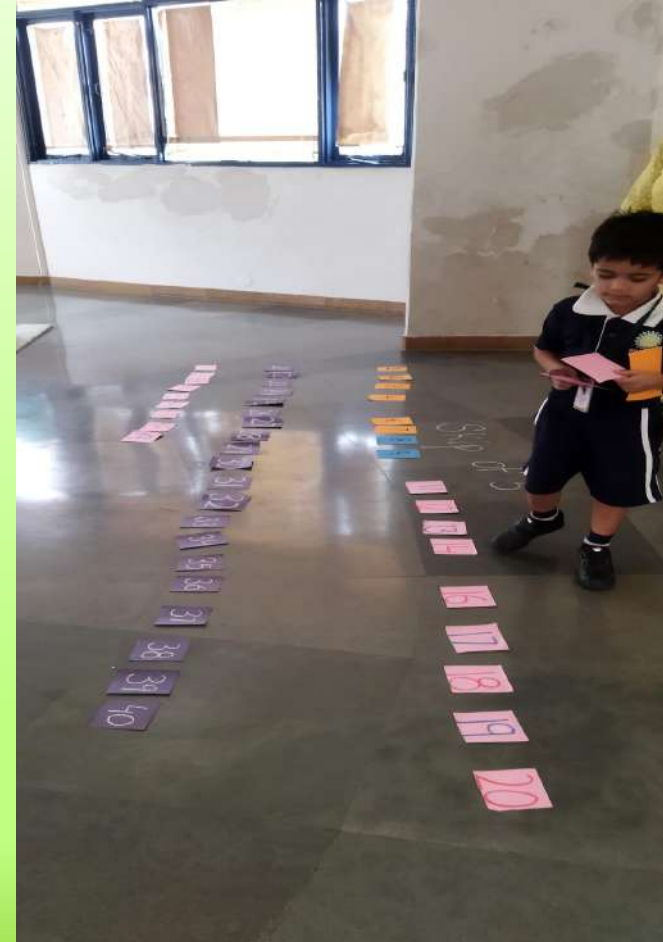
# INTER CLASS ACTIVITY

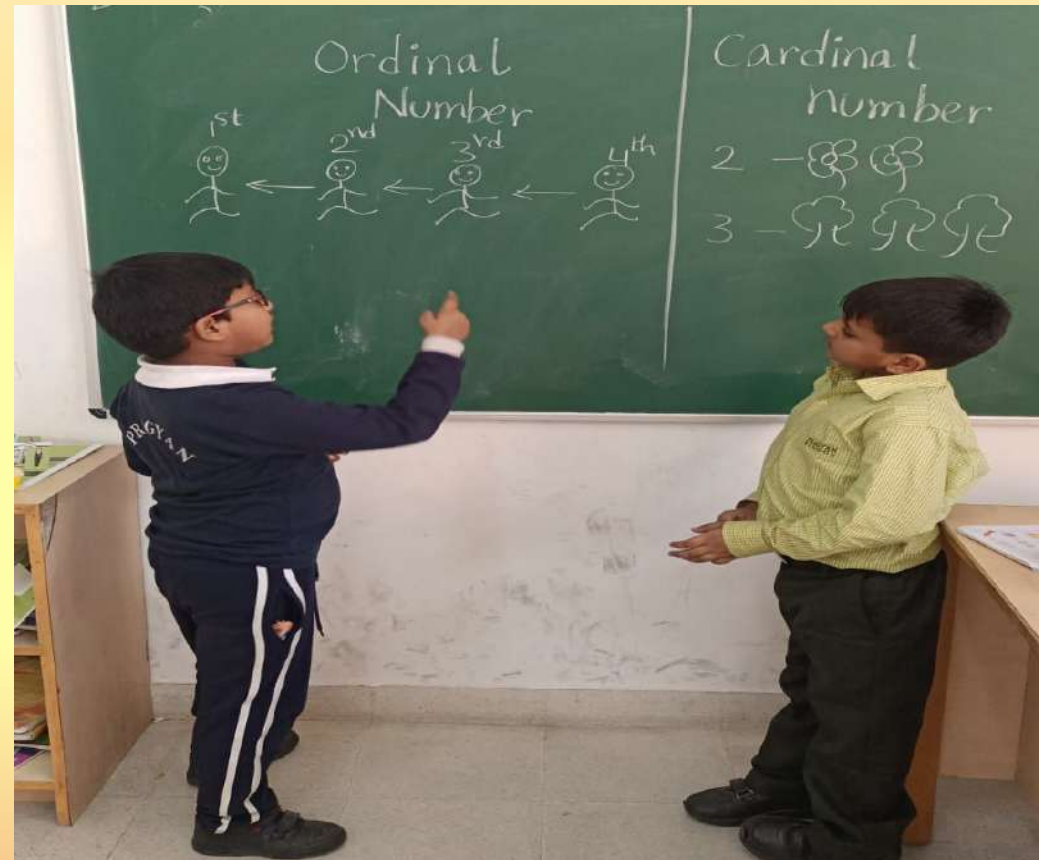




# Math

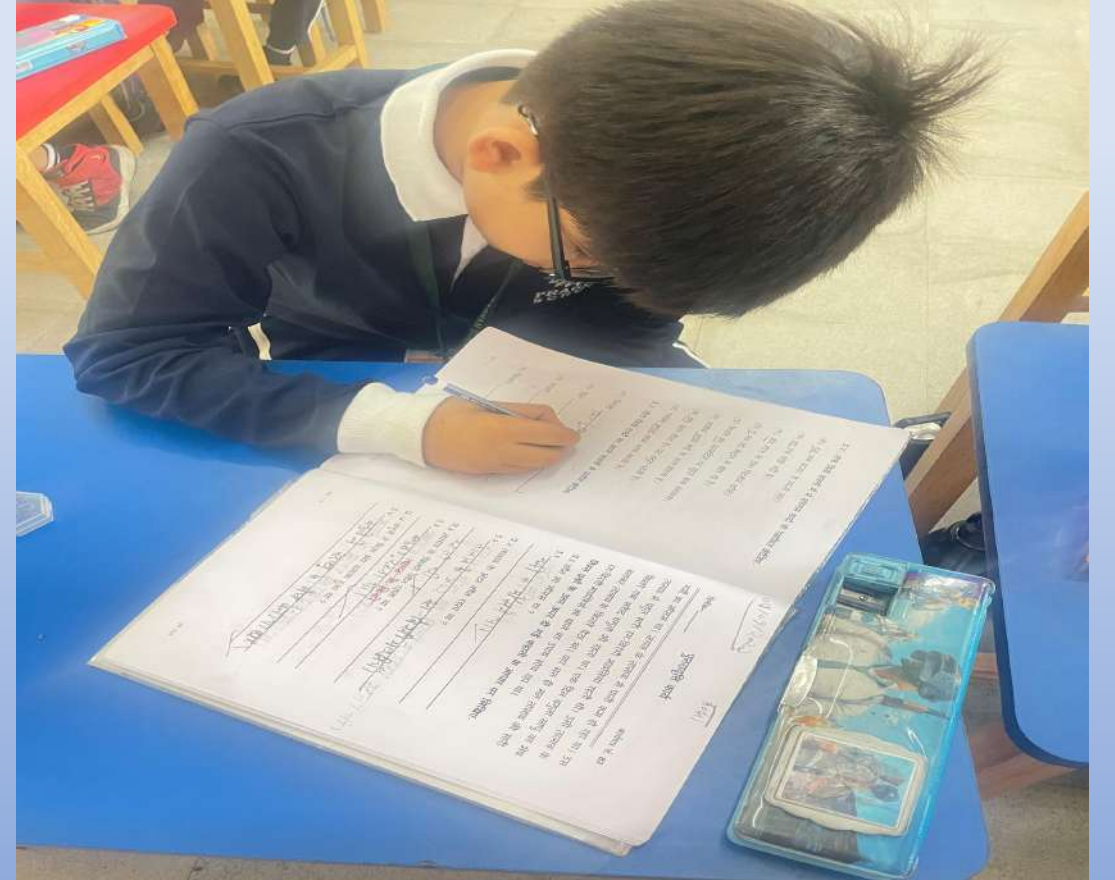

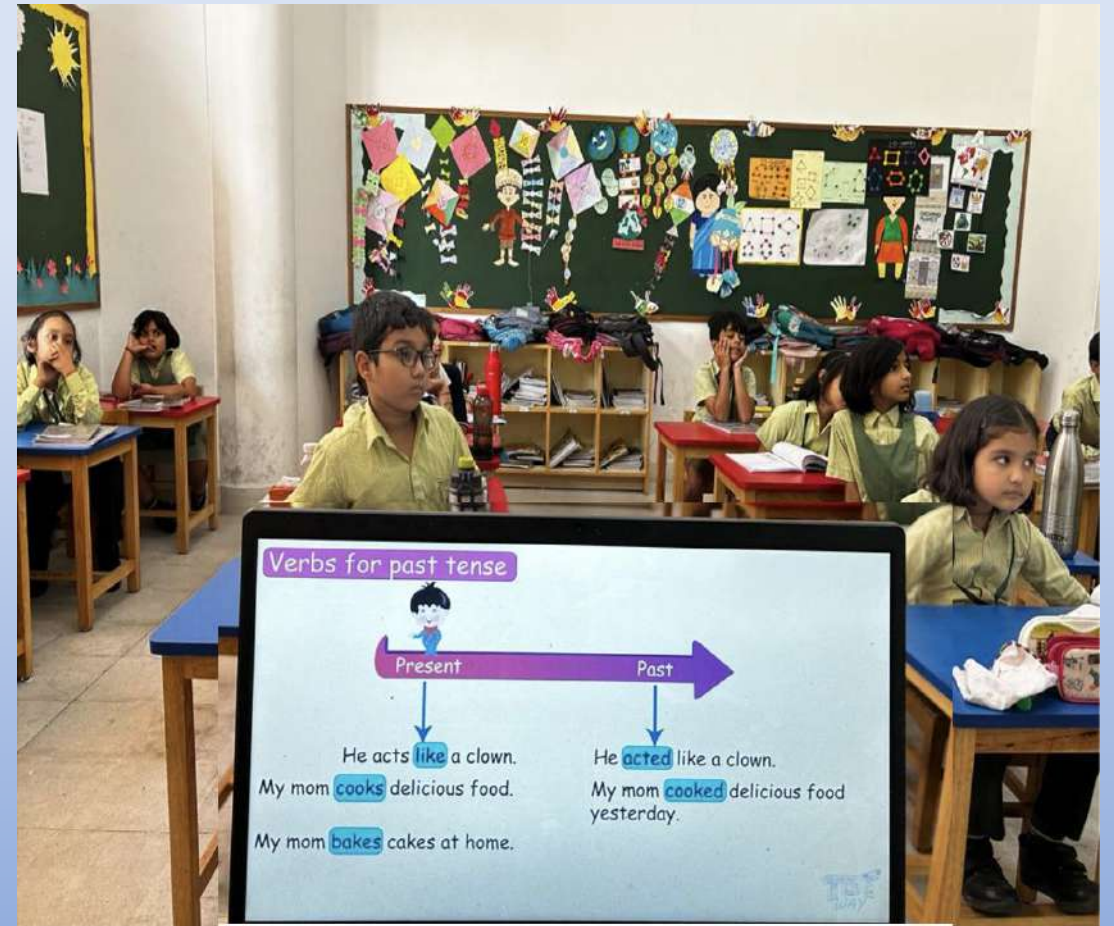

और आदरभाव को प्रस्तुत किया ।

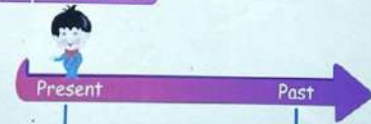

“Reading makes us learn different words daily.” These words can give a better sense of the sentences we speak. Students of classes 1 & 2 selected story books of their choice and read them during their class.



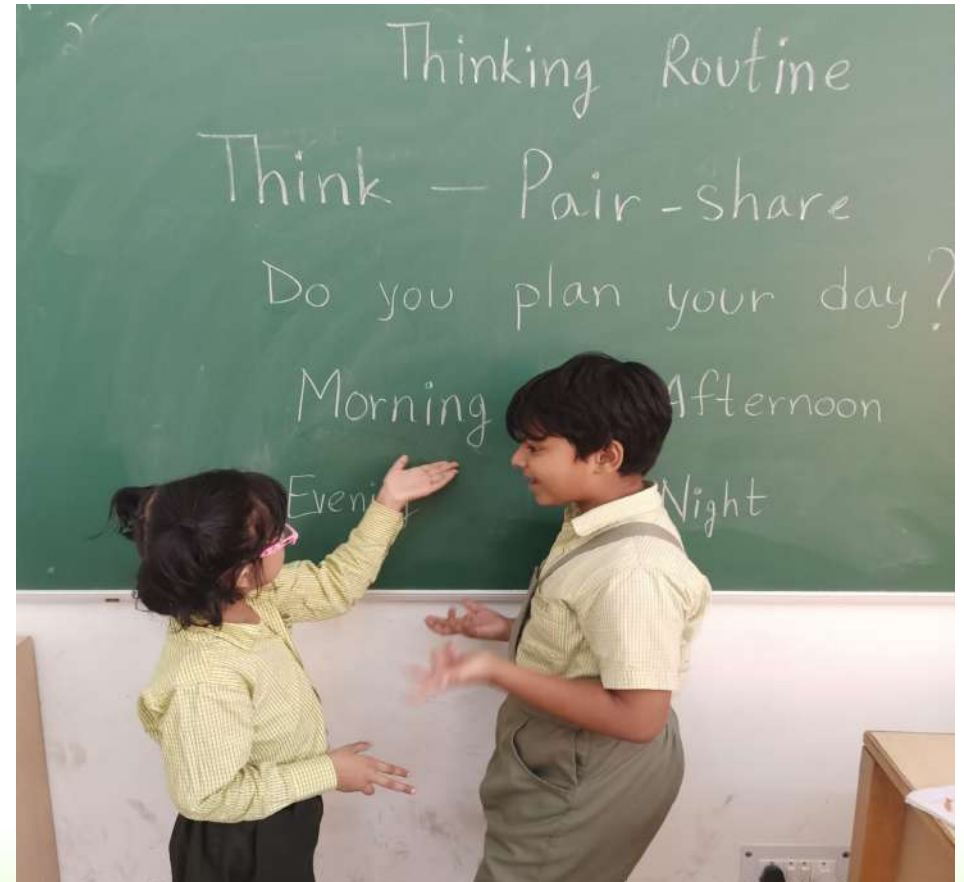
# STEM CLASS

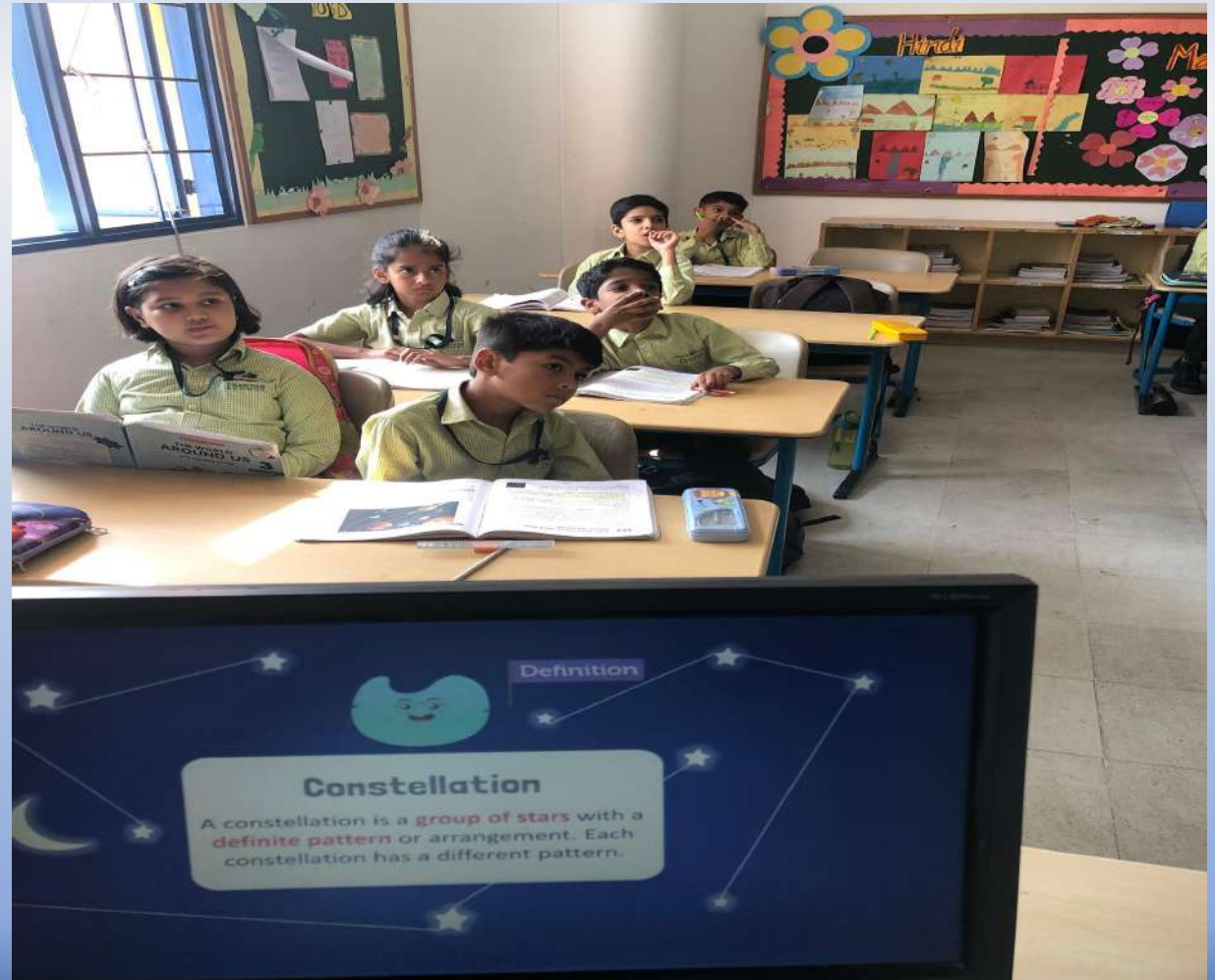
Students of Class 3 did Muhavare in their hindi workbook. They also read the chapter, Himmat na Haro.
