**Hindi**: Revision of all the vyanjans done till now was done in the class.

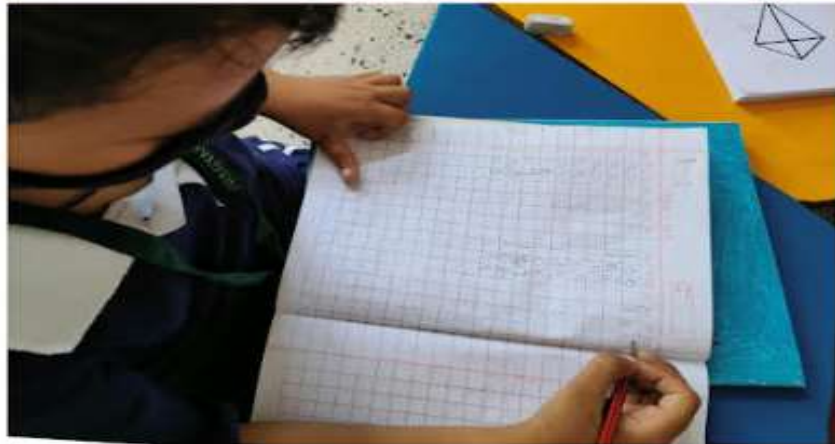
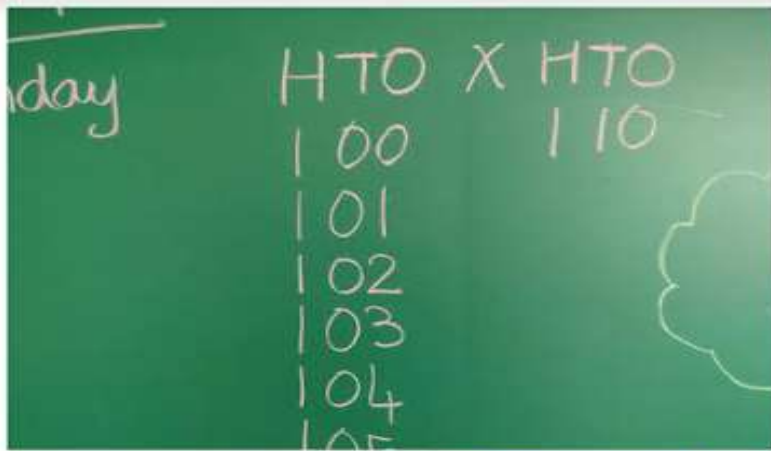
# KINDERGARTEN

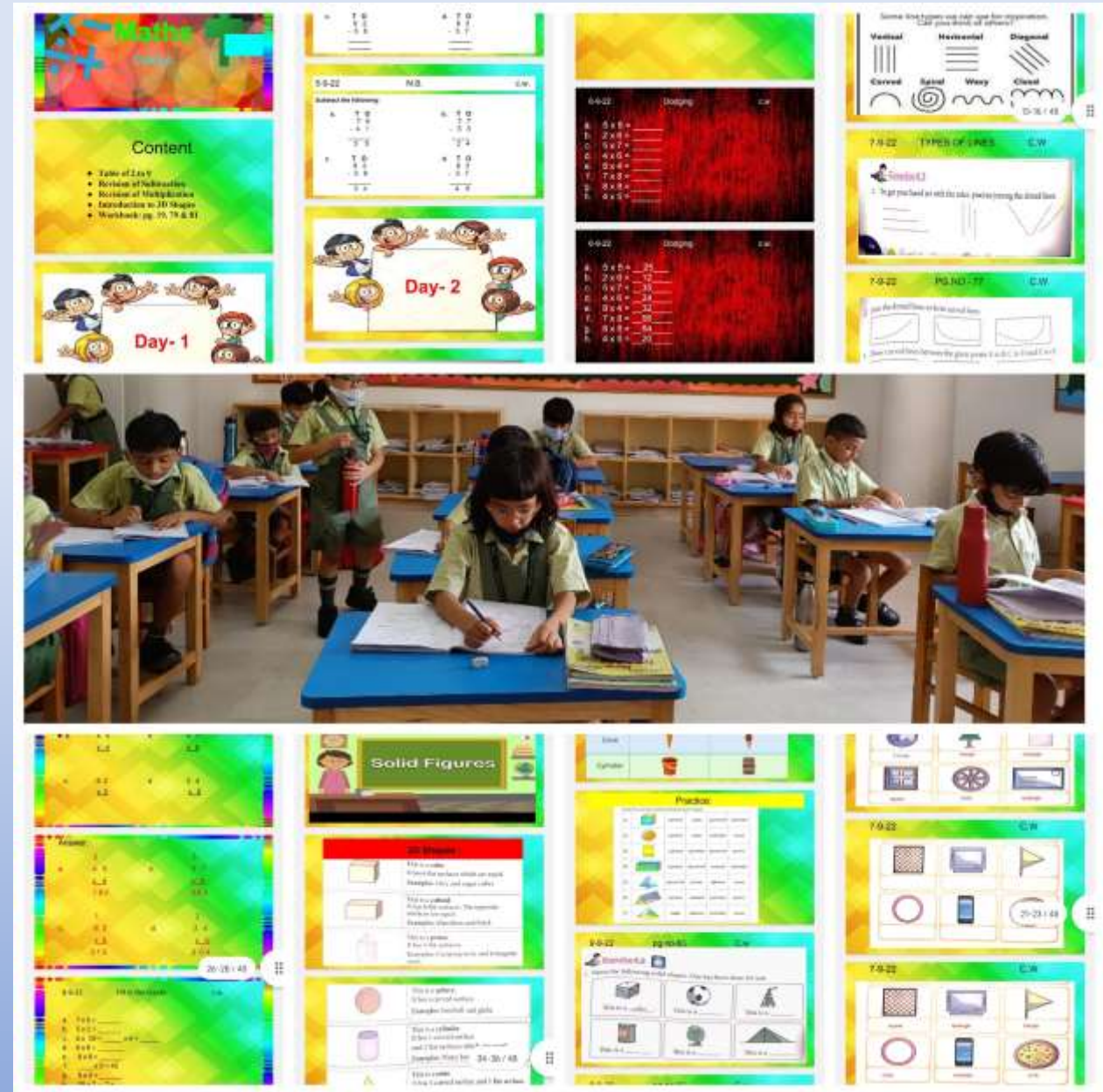
