# NURSERY



## MUSIC

# CRAFT

# KINDERGARTEN

## MATHS



Students of Kindergarten participated in an engaging activity where the teacher called out numbers, and the children had to pick the corresponding number. This activity aimed to assess their understanding of numbers from 1 to 30 in a fun and interactive way.

# CRAFT

Students enthusiastically participated in a creative activity where they coloured pictures of a school to make their own headgear. They were delighted to wear their handmade creations. Additionally, they engaged in a tear-and-paste activity to create beautiful flowers. This activity was designed to enhance their fine motor skills while encouraging creativity and enjoyment.



# HANDS ON ACTIVITY (KG)

Students revised Swar using flashcards, where they identified the Swar written on each card and named a word that begins with it. This interactive activity made learning fun and engaging, helping them reinforce their knowledge in an enjoyable way.





# ENGLISH

During the week students did reading of alphabets with pictures and also wrote uppercase and lowercase letters related to the pictures in their English reader book.



# HINDI

During this week, students did a recapitulation of Swar and Vyanjan. All the Swar and Vyanjan were written on the board, and students were invited to recognize, read and say 2-3 related words or objects. This activity helped reinforce their recognition and vocabulary in a fun and interactive way.



# CRAFT

In their first week of school, students eagerly unleashed their creativity as they transformed simple school-themed illustrations into vibrant, personalized headgear, duck craft and artistic impressions.





Students of class 1 enjoyed the story entitled “The hungry caterpillar”. They came to know the life cycle of butterflies and its various stages like egg, caterpillar, pupa and adult form. Children enjoyed the recitation of the poem “The fuzzy little caterpillar” based on the story. Revision of three letter words and sm sound words was also done as written work.





# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Class 1 students were introduced to the topic “My Body”. They learned about the functions and importance of various body parts. To enrich their understanding, a video was shown that visually supported and reinforced the concepts learned in class. Students further consolidated their understanding by completing a simple activity related to the topic in their notebooks.





Children of class 1 enjoyed doing number art and also made clouds in their maths notebook. They enjoyed revising the number names and number comparison concept done in the previous class. Related questions were done in books and notebooks.

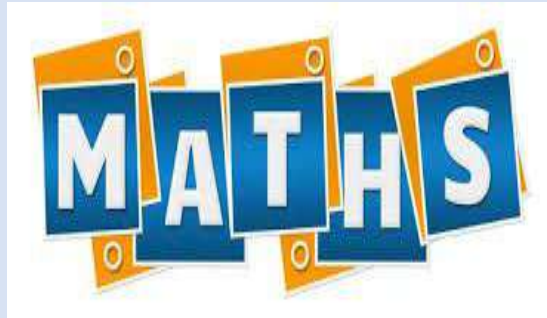


# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

As part of our efforts to enhance the students' learning experience, our class focused on important dining hall etiquettes. The students were taught proper table manners, how to maintain good hygiene, and the importance of respecting others while dining.

Additionally, to make learning more interactive and engaging, we organized a virtual zoo tour for class 2 students. This tour allowed them to explore different animals and their habitats from the comfort of the classroom, enhancing their understanding of wildlife and animal conservation.





The students of Class 2 had a thoroughly enjoyable week, packed with engaging activities. They explored the creative intersection of art and numbers, participated in lively dodging games, and revisited key concepts from their previous year. Additionally, they diligently completed notebook exercises focused on number names, numerical comparisons, and tables from 2 to 5.



# INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC (1&2)



Learning to play musical instruments early boosts cognitive abilities, creativity, and discipline, while also promoting emotional expression and enhancing focus and memory. Students of classes 1 and 2 were introduced to the keyboard and learned to play Alankaar on the instrument.

# ART & CRAFT (1&2)



Students of Classes 1 and 2 have practiced for the upcoming Draw and Colour interclass activity.

Grade 1 students have drawn a snail and colored their drawings, while Grade 2 students have drawn a chameleon in their art files and colored their drawings.

# VOCAL MUSIC (CLASS 1)



Vocal music is any music that features the human voice as the primary instrument. It can be performed with or without instrumental accompaniment and spans a wide range of genres and styles.

Children learnt the devotional song – “Subah savere lekar tera naam prabhu” and they also enjoyed sargam geet (sa se sargam gayenge re se raag sunayenge ).

# DANCE (CLASS 1)

Students of class 1 learnt new dance steps through various characters in the story. They also practice simple foot steps on counts and drum beats.



# PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)

Passing ball games offer numerous benefits, including improving hand-eye coordination, gross motor skills, social skills like cooperation and turn-taking, and even language development. Children of class 1 and 2 enjoyed doing ball passing, zig zag running and hurdle jump.

Reading is a good habit that everyone should inculcate. Students of class 2 came to the library to read different books and learn new things.



# DEAR PERIOD

Reading is important because it develops the mind and gives excessive knowledge and lessons of life. It helps to understand the world around you better. It keeps our mind active and enhances our creative ability. Children of classes 1 & 2 enjoyed their DEAR period on the very first day of their school. DEAR means Drop Everything And Read. It is scheduled every Tuesday.



# ASSEMBLY (1&2)

We welcomed our students to the new session. Teachers of classes 1 & 2 ensured a warm and enthusiastic start. The assembly commenced with a few exercises, followed up by new prayer, poem etc. The highlight of the assembly was a captivating story narrated by our librarian, Ms. Saira, who inspired our young minds to develop a love for reading. Sankalp of Class 2D, who was awarded with the Book Hero Badge for his generous contribution of donating books to our school library.





Students of class 3 were introduced to the poem of the month ‘My Hat is Full of Rabbits.’ They revised the grammatical concept of common and proper nouns, followed by some written exercises.

# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The students of Class 3 revised the topic of plants, including their types and the edible parts of plants, along with relevant examples. They were introduced to a new chapter – Living and Non-living Things. As part of the introduction, students drew one living and one non-living thing and explored the characteristics that differentiate them. They also learned about the concept of habitats. To enhance understanding, a video and a PowerPoint presentation were shown. Students actively identified living and non-living things from the PPT and participated in class discussions on examples. They also read the chapter and noted down the new vocabulary in their notebooks.





Grade 4 students tackled a series of engaging funny riddles. In their first class, they also discovered fascinating maths facts, sparking curiosity and enthusiasm. Through this, they developed problem-solving skills, logical reasoning, and mathematical thinking.





Students of class 4 were introduced to the lesson, Heidi this week. They read the chapter and wrote the new words. They were also introduced to the new words and poem of the month.





# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The students of Grade 4 studied the chapter “Globes and Maps,” where they learned about the globe, different types of maps and their uses. Through discussions and real-life examples, students understood the importance of maps in daily life. To enhance their learning, they also watched engaging videos related to the topic.

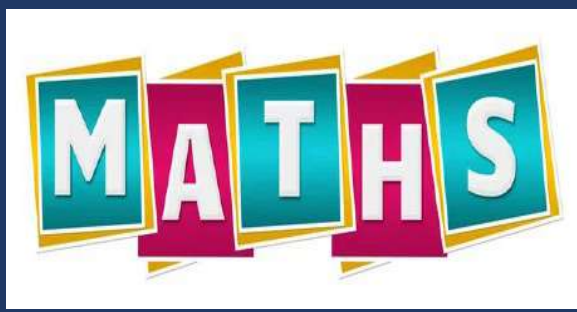




# हिन्दी
