# NURSERY



## ENGLISH

Letter U was introduced to the children with the help of picture flashcards. They also enjoyed the Jolly phonics song of letter U. Students did worksheets related to the letter in their workbook and also in their notebook. They tried identifying things starting with letter U.

# MATHS

The numbers 22 and 23 were introduced to the children using fish blocks and counting different objects. They did worksheets related to the numbers as well. Students also enjoyed the activity, 'Sequence the Number Cards'. Number cards 0-23 were randomly placed on the table, and students were asked to put the cards in the correct sequence, developing their problem-solving skills and understanding of the concept of sequencing.



# HINDI

Vyanjan 'य' was introduced to the students with the help of pictures. They also enjoyed colouring 'य' related objects in their Hindi letter book.



# GENERAL AWARENESS

Animals were introduced to the children. They learnt about wild animals and discussed different wild animals in the class. Students also coloured the worksheets related to the topic.



# MUSIC

Nursery students enjoyed learning the music notes of 'Jingle Bells'. They practiced singing and clapping along, developing their rhythm and timing.



## INTER CLASS ACTIVITY- CARD MAKING & HINDI CALLIGRAPHY

This week, nursery students created beautiful cards using square-shaped paper cutouts and colorful pictures in the Interclass Card Making Activity, which was held on 11th December, 2024. Under guidance and supervision, they folded, colored, and pasted the cutouts with precision. Winners will soon be awarded with the certificates of merit based on creativity and neatness.



# KINDERGARTEN



## ENGLISH

Students were made aware of the "-op" word family, exploring words like hop, top, pop, and stop. The children practiced reading and writing these words in their notebook.

# HINDI

This week, students were introduced to the vyanjan "घ". Through engaging activities, storytelling, and colorful worksheets, the young learners discovered how to recognize, pronounce, and write "घ". The interactive sessions included identifying words like घर, घास etc. sparking their curiosity and creativity.



# YOGA

This week the kindergarten students enjoyed a fun and relaxing yoga session where they practiced Sarvangasana(shoulder stand) and Supta Vajrasana (Reclining Thunderbolt Pose). The children followed the instructions, gently stretching their bodies while maintaining focus. These poses help improve their flexibility, calm their minds, and strengthen their posture. The session concluded with deep breathing exercises, leaving the kids refreshed and energized.



# HANDS ON ACTIVITY (KG)

Students were introduced to 'i family' words, and to reinforce their understanding, they participated in an activity using flashcards. They identified pictures on the flashcards and formed corresponding words.



# SKILL BASED LEARNING (KG)

The students of kindergarten learnt to set up a demo stall featuring different currencies. In this hands-on experience, some students took on the role of buyers, while others became sellers. Through this activity, the students learned that each currency is used specifically within its respective market. Additionally, they gained valuable insights into the concept of quantifying purchases and understanding the value of currency in real-world transactions.





## CIRCLE TIME

During the circle time, students discussed animals, the difference between living and nonliving things, and between herbivores and carnivores.

# HINDI

During the week students revised Hindi numbers through various activities conducted in class. They did worksheets related to the topic. Reading and writing practice of passage that was done in the Hindi notebook. This helped in focussing on their accuracy and fluency.



# GENERAL AWARENESS

During the week the students did an activity Guess the animals that was related to the topic animals. In this activity the students had to read the puzzles and pick the correct animal. They also did worksheets related to the topic.



# SCIENCE DEMONSTRATION

The students of Upper Kindergarten did an experiment related to static energy. Through this experiment they learnt how the energy gets transferred from one object to another. Students excitedly participated in this experiment that allowed them to develop analytical thinking, problem solving and coping skills.



## INTER CLASS ACTIVITY(KG & UKG)

As part of Inter class activity held on 11th December, 2024 students of Kindergarten and Upper Kindergarten participated in Hindi Calligraphy. The students were instructed to focus on copying sentences from the board. They formed letters and words by carefully copying simple sentences, helping them improve their handwriting and attention to detail. This exercise supported their early writing skills and gave them confidence in sentence structure. The activity was a wonderful way to encourage focus and build foundational Hindi skills in our young learners. Winners will soon be awarded with certificates of merit.

# EDUCATIONAL OUTING- FIRE STATION

As part of the educational outing, students of kindergarten and upper kindergarten visited the Fire Station on 11th December 2024. The visit to the station provided the students with an enriching and informative experience. They learnt essential fire safety measures, such as steps to be taken during a fire emergency, understanding the importance of staying calm and alert. The children also got the opportunity to explore a firetruck, marveling at its tools and equipment, and observe how firefighters use hoses, ladders, and other gear to fight fires. An interactive session with the firemen helped the students to gain valuable insights that deepened their understanding of the firefighters' role in the community.

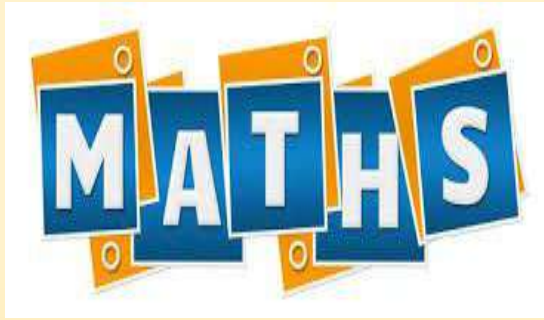




# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Uses of plants were introduced to the students of class 1 during their EVS class. They were guided in reading the chapter along with a discussion on the topic. The students went for the nature walk, where they observed different types of plants like trees, shrubs, herbs and climbers etc. They had the opportunity to touch and feel the plants and identify their parts. Finally, they sat outside in the natural environment and participated in an oral discussion about how we are dependent on plants.





Revision helps recall the details of the topic studied. Revising the topics helps students gain more confidence to attempt any related question. Timely revision helps reduce anxiety and stress levels. Children of class 1 enjoyed practicing math concepts like ordinal numbers, cardinal numbers, addition and doing through notebook work and orals.

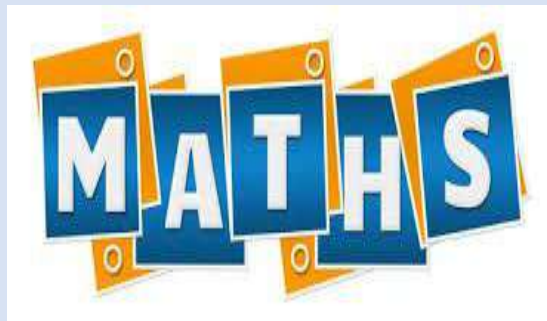
This week, the students of Class 2 read the chapter Maths for Dance Drill, engaging in experiential learning through an enactment activity conducted in the classroom. Sports equipment was creatively used as props, making the activity lively and interactive. It was a fun and enjoyable experience for the children, and they all participated with great enthusiasm and joy. The activity not only enhanced their understanding of the chapter but also encouraged teamwork and creativity. Such hands-on learning experiences help make concepts more relatable and enjoyable for young learners.





Class 2 students participated in an engaging discussion on the significance of safety in our daily lives. They demonstrated their understanding of this crucial topic by completing a series of question-answer sessions and chapter-related exercises in their EVS workbook, showcasing their ability to work independently and think critically.





This week, Grade 2 students revised important mathematical concepts, focusing on measuring length, understanding capacity, and revisiting time. They practiced measuring objects with rulers and explored different units of length. In the capacity topic, students discussed the amounts of liquid various containers hold, compared them and did some worksheets on the same concept. They also refreshed their knowledge of time, including reading clocks and understanding hours and minutes, and completed a time worksheet in their workbooks to reinforce their learning.



# INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC (1&2)



Learning to play musical instruments at an early age not only enhances rhythm and coordination but also fosters self-expression and builds confidence. In continuation of practicing the birthday song, students of Classes 1 and 2 enthusiastically revisited it this week. Special focus was given to playing the birthday song on the harmonium and keyboard, emphasizing rhythm and accuracy. The song was taught using the C major scale, allowing students to refine their musical skills with enthusiasm and dedication.

# ART & CRAFT (1&2)



As a part of RIDS, students of classes 1 and 2 participated in a collage-making activity focused on the neighbouring countries of India, such as Japan, China, Pakistan, and Bangladesh. They pasted pictures related to various aspects of these countries, including food, harvest festivals, traditional costumes etc.



# COMPUTER (1&2)



Children of class 1 learned to use the grass, flower, rainbow, rain and foam selectors of the Magic Tool and Paint Tool in Tux Paint. Children also made paintings on the “Nature Theme” in Tux Paint. Children of class 2 were introduced to the different brushes of MS Paint. They also made beautiful paintings on the “Metropolitan City” theme in MS Paint.

# VOCAL MUSIC (1& 2)



The song “Joy to the World” is a reminder that Jesus not only came once as a little baby to be our Savior, but that he will return some day to be our King. And through all of the time in between, he lives with those who love him – in their heart, mind and spirit. Children of class 1 and 2 enjoyed learning the Christmas carol ‘Joy to the world” and “Deck the hall” during their vocal music class.

# PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)

Hand-eye coordination is considered a complex cognitive ability and is seen as important to the development of a child. Children of class 1 and 2 were involved in practicing eye-hand coordination activities like catch and throw, dribbling the ball, regular exercise and jogging.



# VALUE EDUCATION

The topic for this week's Value education session was 'How can we take care of the environment?'. The students were sensitized with the word "Environment", and its importance. As a part of discussion each child got an opportunity to share their views on the topic and how they can contribute to saving the environment. Kids did brainstorming and came up with ideas like reuse of paper and planting more & more trees.



# CIRCLE TIME

This week the students of Class 1 and 2 spoke on the topic “एक मनोरंजक घटना”. Children enjoyed sharing their thoughts on the topic and expressed their views. Children were excited to speak about their time which they spend with their family and friends.



# CLASS ASSEMBLY (2C)

# हिन्दी

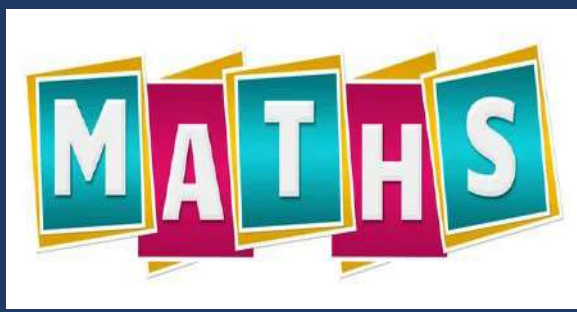
