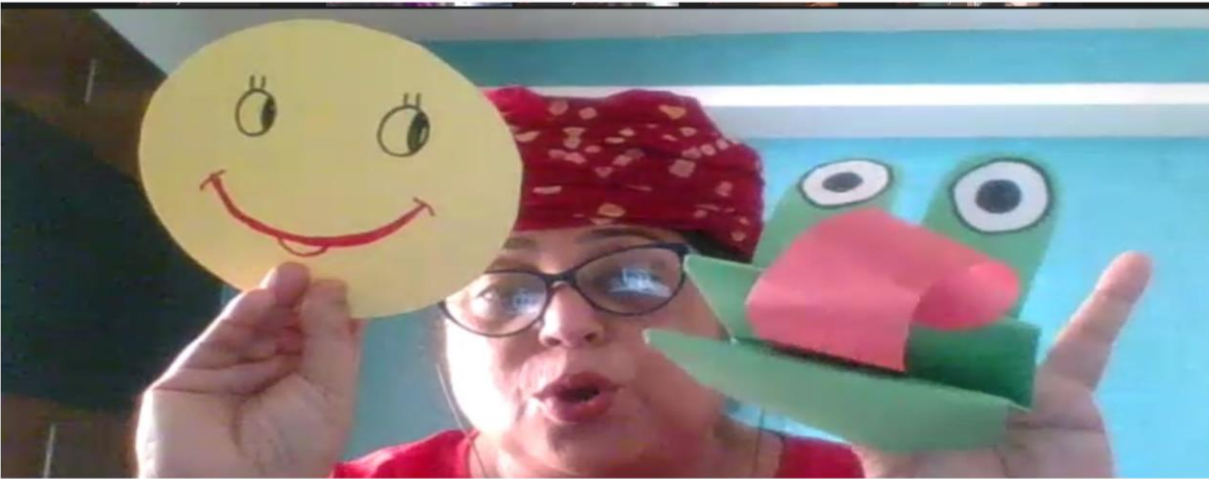
Nursery

- Hindi - Vyanjan 'ॠ' was introduced and students enjoyed coloring the different pictures of Vyanjan 'ॠ' in the worksheet.



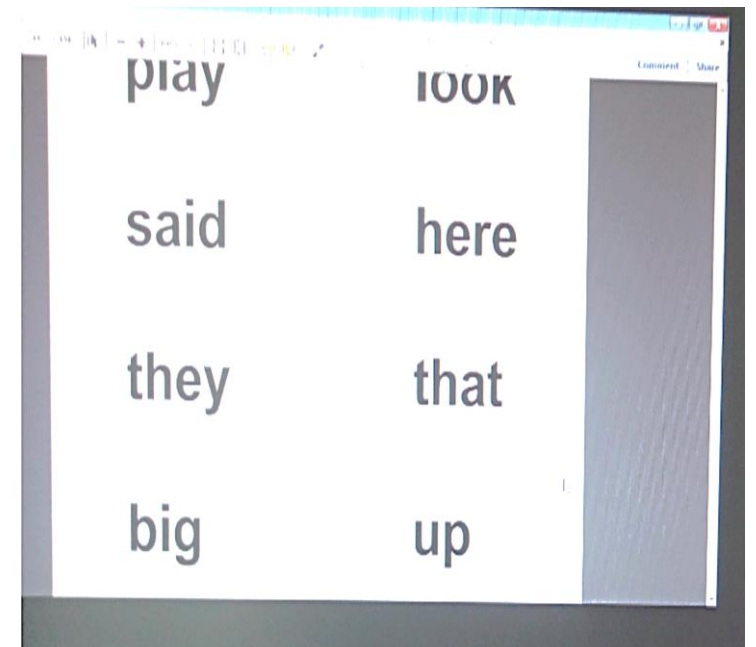
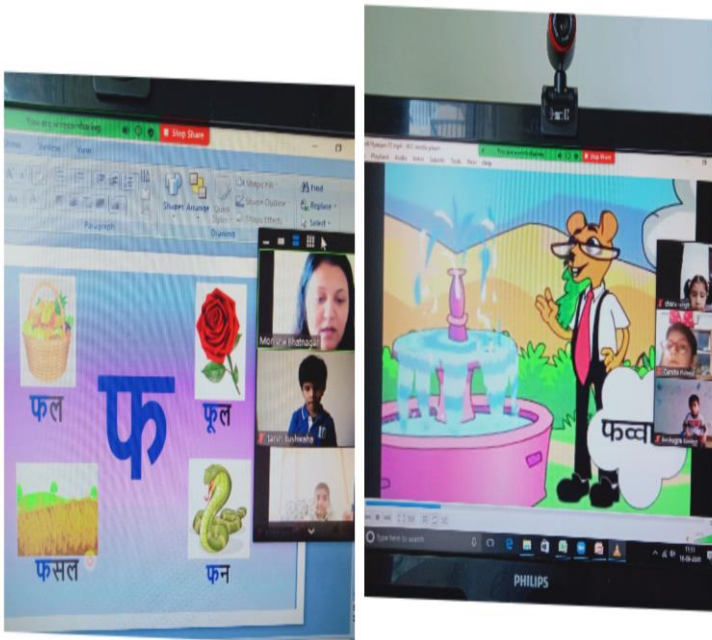
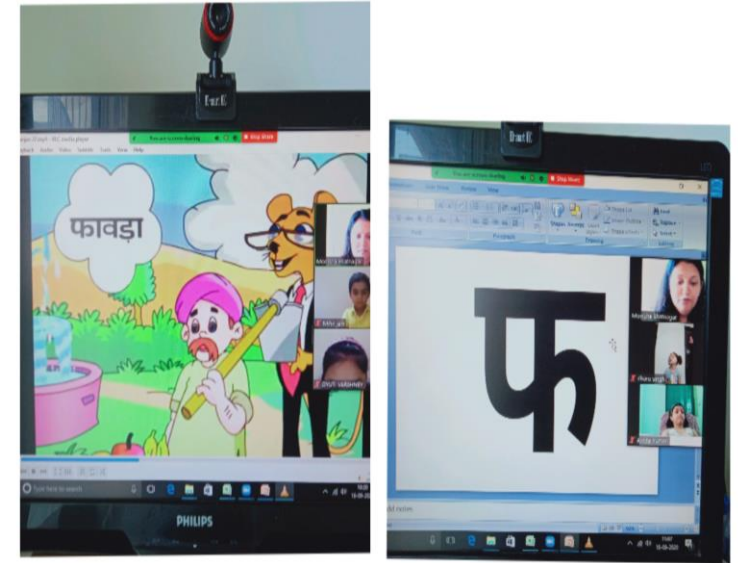
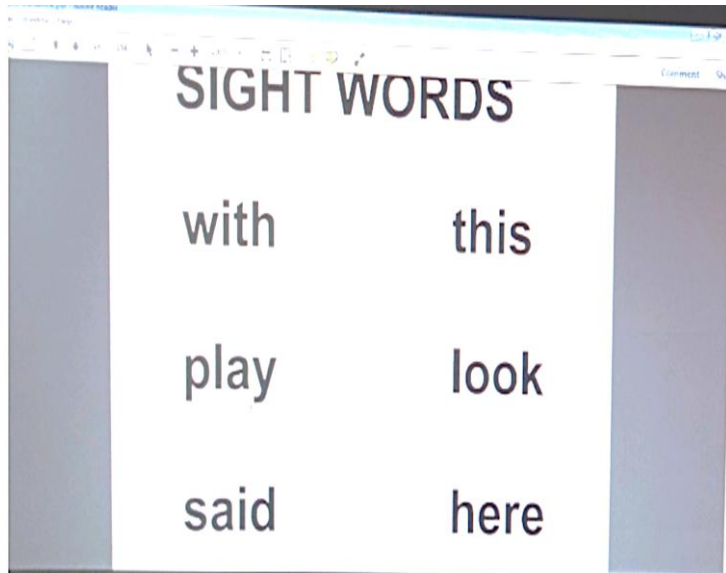
Nursery

Kindergarten




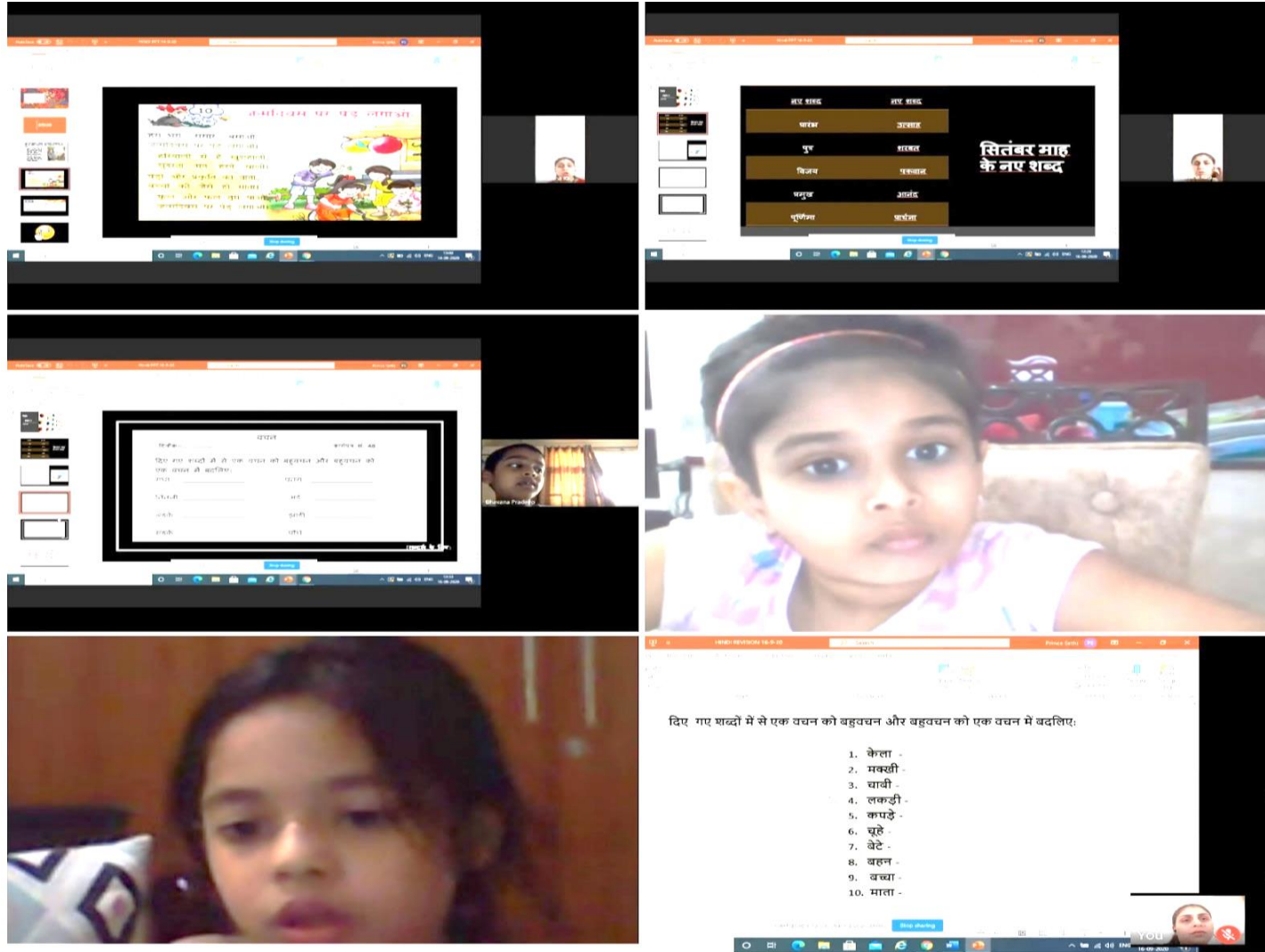
Maths

Solid Shapes or 3D Shapes

A shape that has the three dimensions, namely length, width (breadth) and height (depth), is called a solid shape or 3D shape.

	This is a cube . It has 6 flat surfaces which are equal. Examples: Dice and sugar cubes
	This is a cuboid . It has 6 flat surfaces. The opposite surfaces are equal. Examples: Matchbox and brick
	This is a prism . It has 5 flat surfaces. Examples: Camping tents and triangular roofs
	This is a sphere . It has a curved surface. Examples: Football and globe
	This is a cylinder . It has 1 curved surface and 2 flat surfaces which are equal. Examples: Water bottle and jar
	This is a cone . It has 1 curved surface and 1 flat surface. Examples: Christmas tree and birthday cap

From rectangular doors, to triangular roofs and circular wheels - shapes are everywhere. Learning shapes helps children identify and organize visual information. Students of class 2 enjoyed their Maths class where they learnt about 2D and 3D shapes.

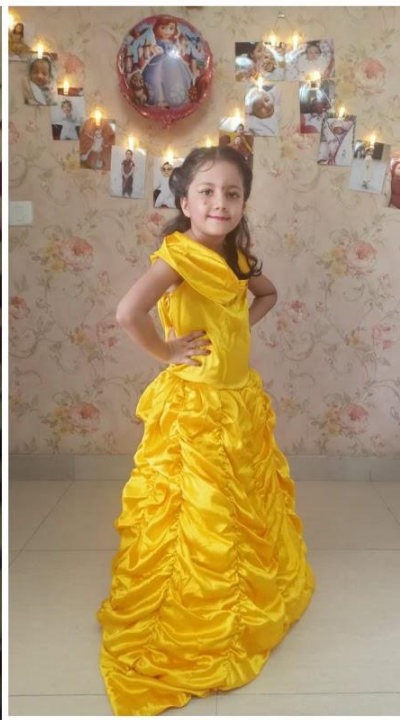

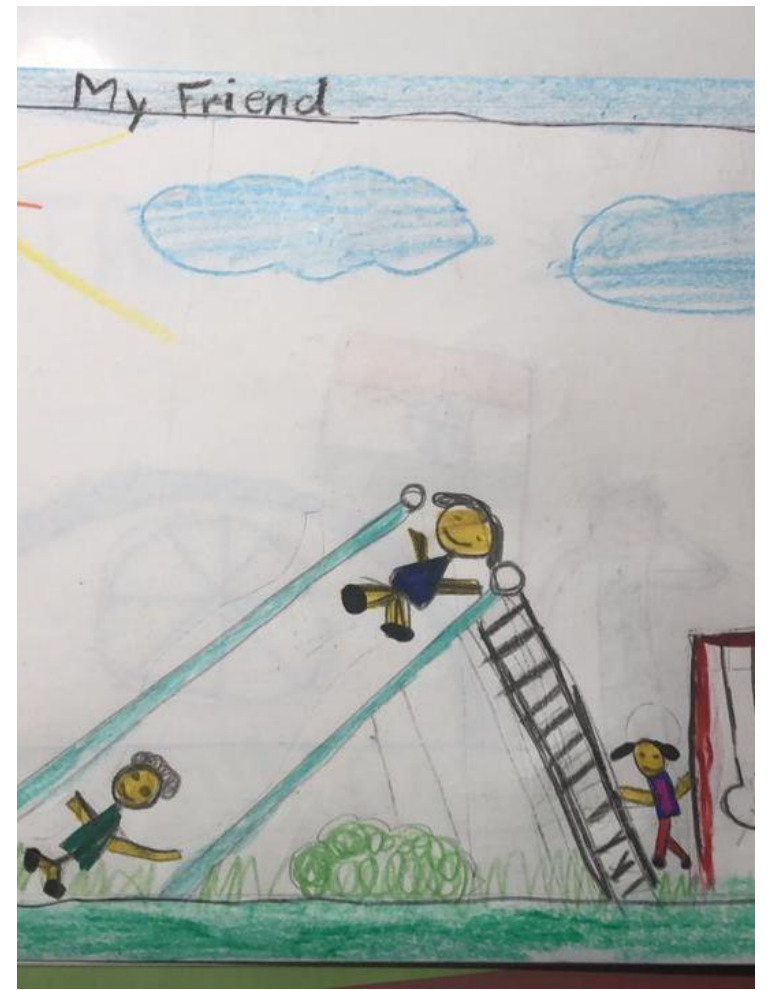
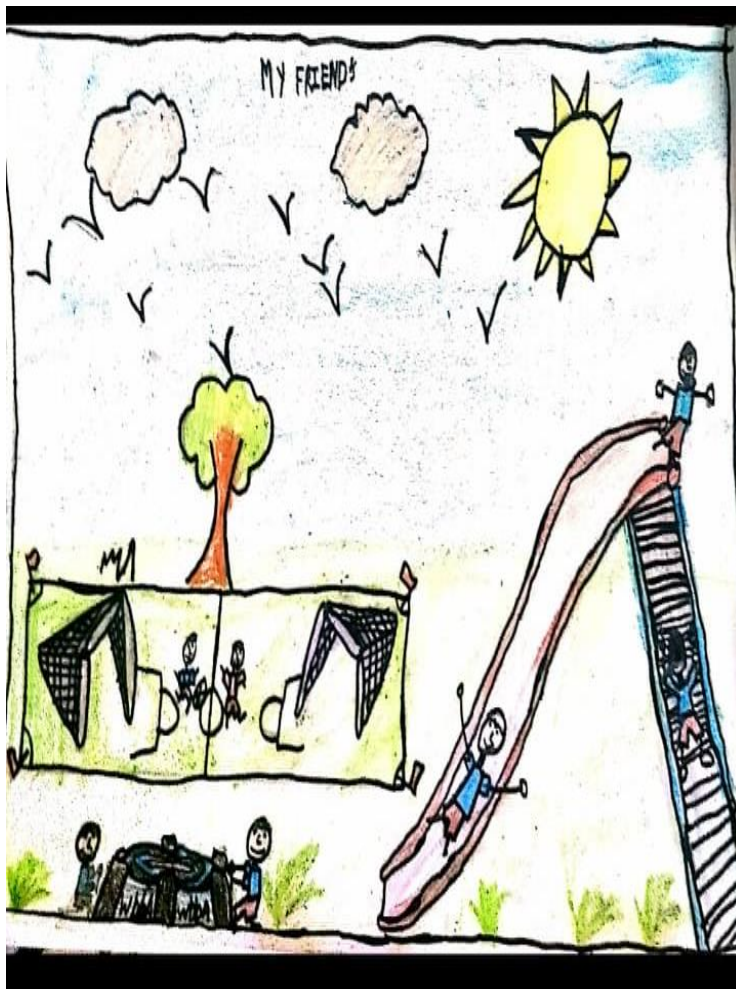
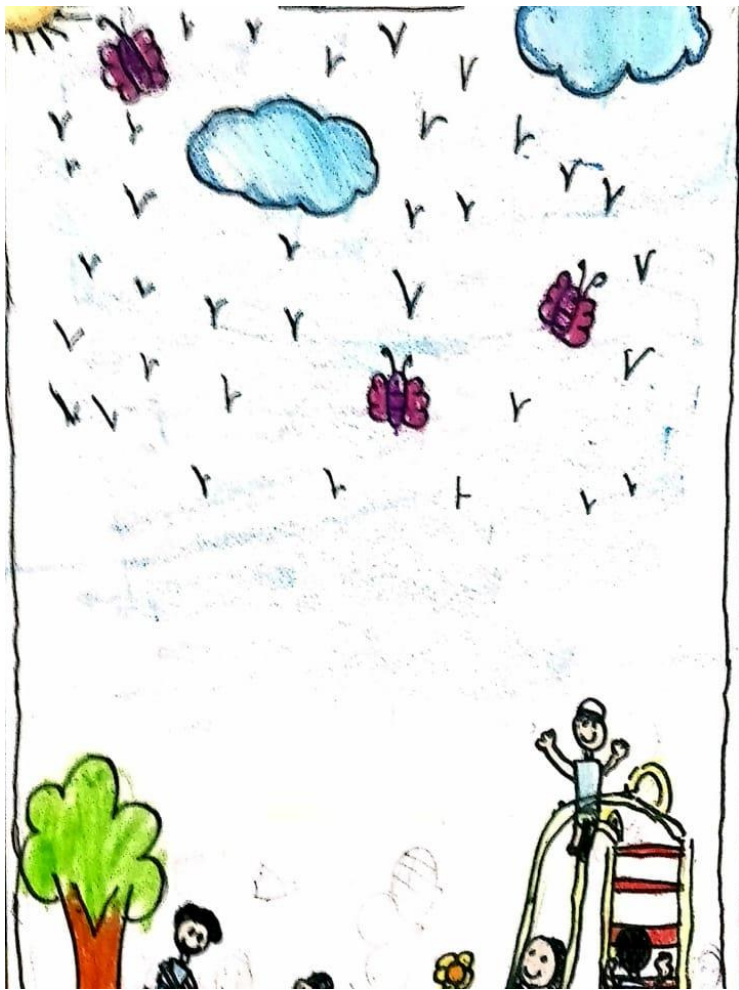
Students of Class 3 had the assessment of Hindi activity. They spoke on the topic “Barsat ka Mausam” and also made beautiful pictures related to it.



EVS Activity

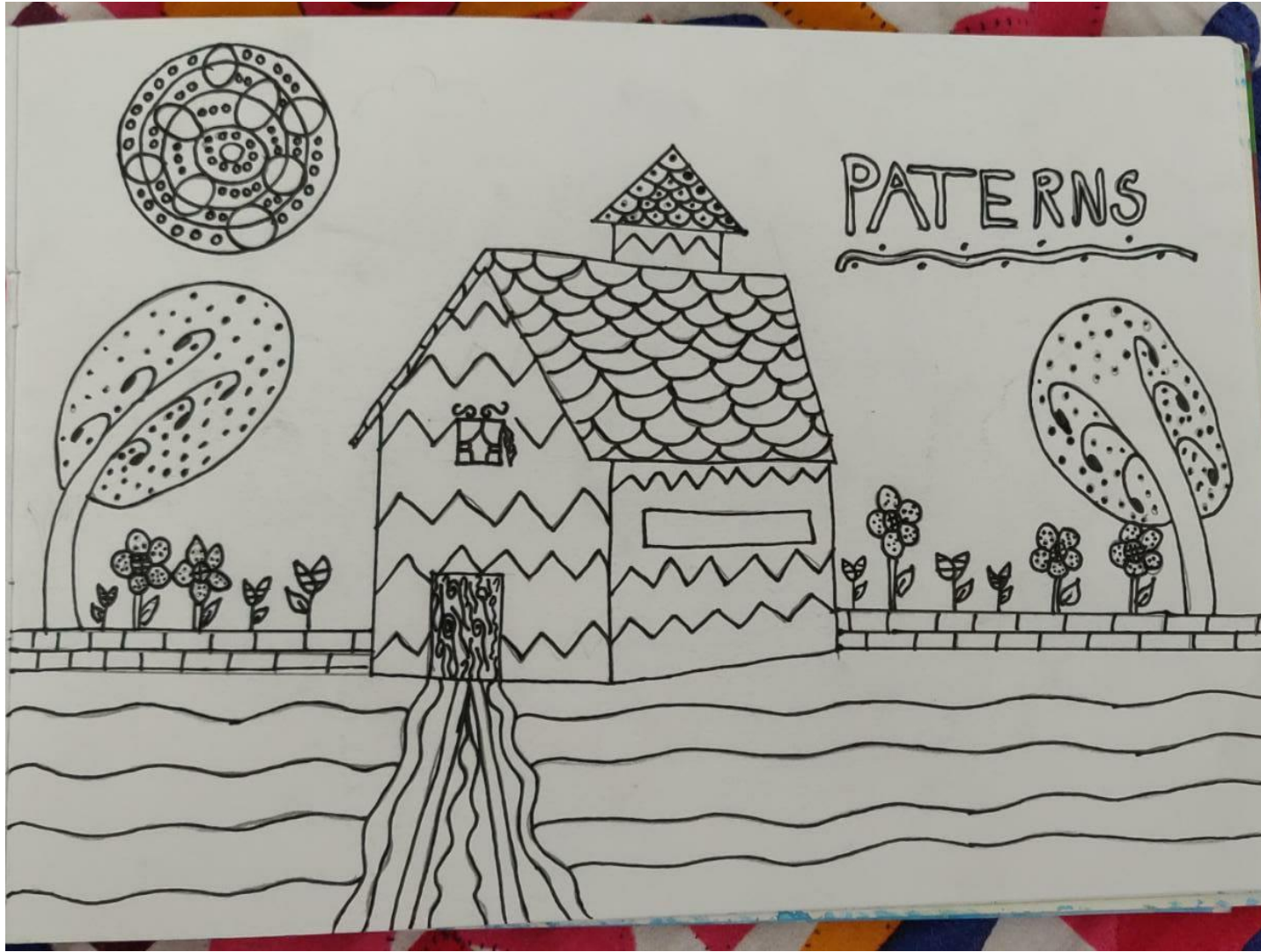
