Students of classes IX-XII are working hard to showcase their talents for the forthcoming annual function Indomitable.



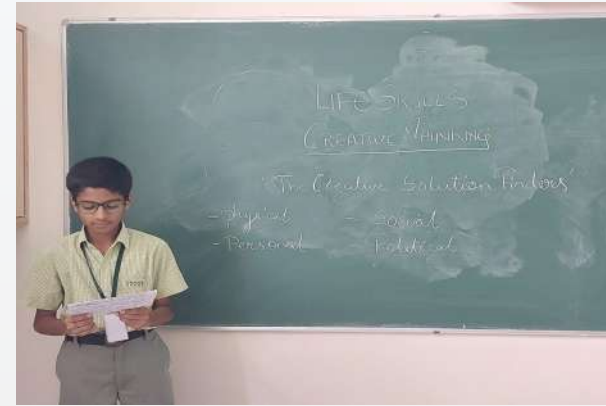
SCIENCE ACTIVITY VI

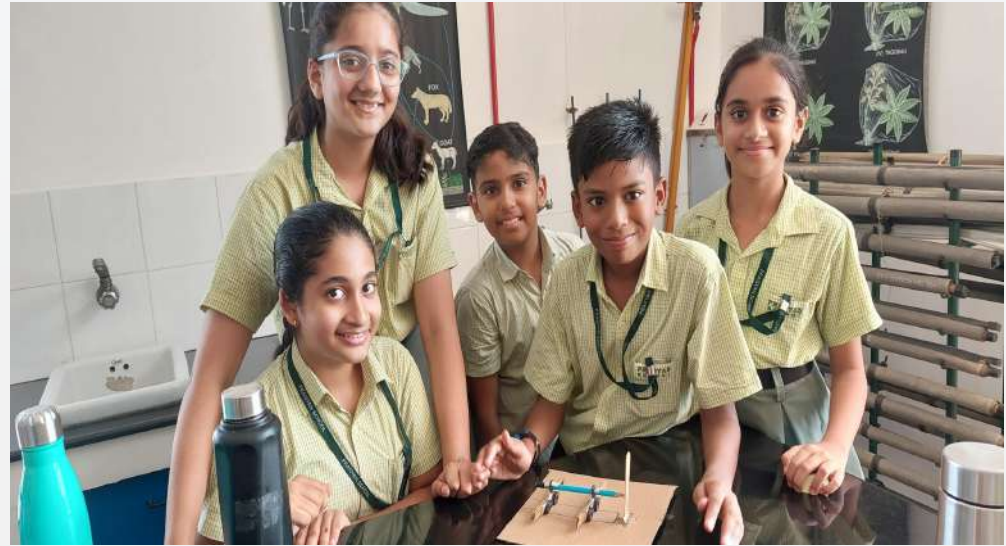
