CRAFT

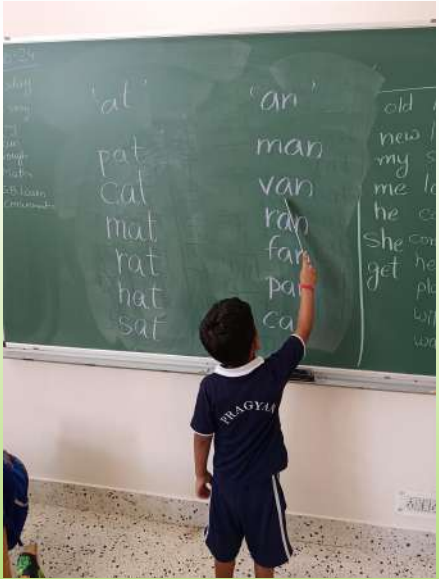

KINDERGARTEN

ENGLISH

The students revised at and an family words while learning to read them using phonics. The reading of these simple words, allows them to expand their vocabulary, which will not only improve their reading skills but also enable them to use these words confidently in their everyday conversations.



HINDI

To reinforce the revision of vyanjan, an engaging activity was organized where students actively matched each vyanjan (letter or sound) to corresponding pictures. This hands-on learning experience not only made the revision fun but also helped students visually associate the vyanjan with real-world objects, strengthening their understanding and retention.



CLAY MODELING

The students created adorable pandas and vibrant butterflies using clay, showcasing their creativity. They also made an effort to learn the art of painting the clay articles with brushes, adding color and life to them. This hands-on activity helped them to explore artistic expression while developing fine motor skills and an appreciation for detail.



GENERAL AWARENESS

An activity was conducted where students enthusiastically participated by selecting various community helpers. Each student spoke 2-3 lines about the chosen helper, describing their role and how they contribute to society. This interactive session deepened the students' understanding of the importance of community helpers in our daily lives.





MATHS

During this week students were introduced to the counting from 180-200. They practiced forward counting 160-200. Students also did the board work practice for numbers 180-200 and what comes after.

GENERAL AWARENESS

During this week students did worksheets related to festivals. They tried to read the sentence, understand and answered in the form of true and false and by filling the blanks.



CLAY MODELING

During this week, students made whale and seal with clay to demonstrate it in the exhibition on gala day. Students were also informed about their habitat as part of class discussion and they enjoyed a lot while making these articles.





In class 1, the students revisited the poem and vocabulary for the month to reinforce their learning. To revise the concept of 'Action words' and to aid in retention, an activity named "Dumb Charade" was done, which visually explained the action word concept. After the activity, the teacher asked oral questions to gauge the students' comprehension. To further solidify their understanding, the students completed a classwork assignment in their workbook based on the concept.

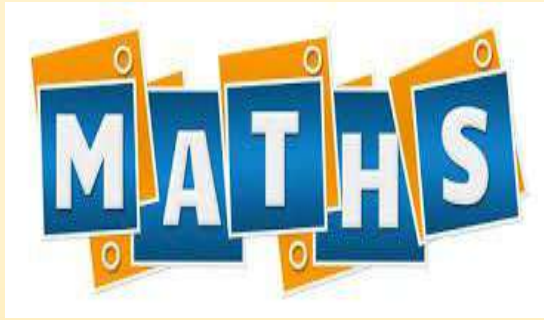




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

To further solidify comprehension, students seamlessly completed exercises related to action words, demonstrating their grasp of the concept.

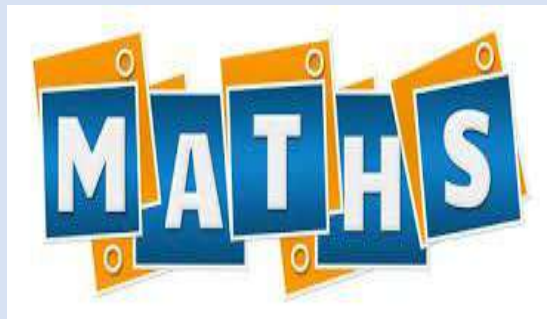




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Hand gestures can express a lot. So the students of class 2 started learning movements of arms and hands along with some new dance steps.



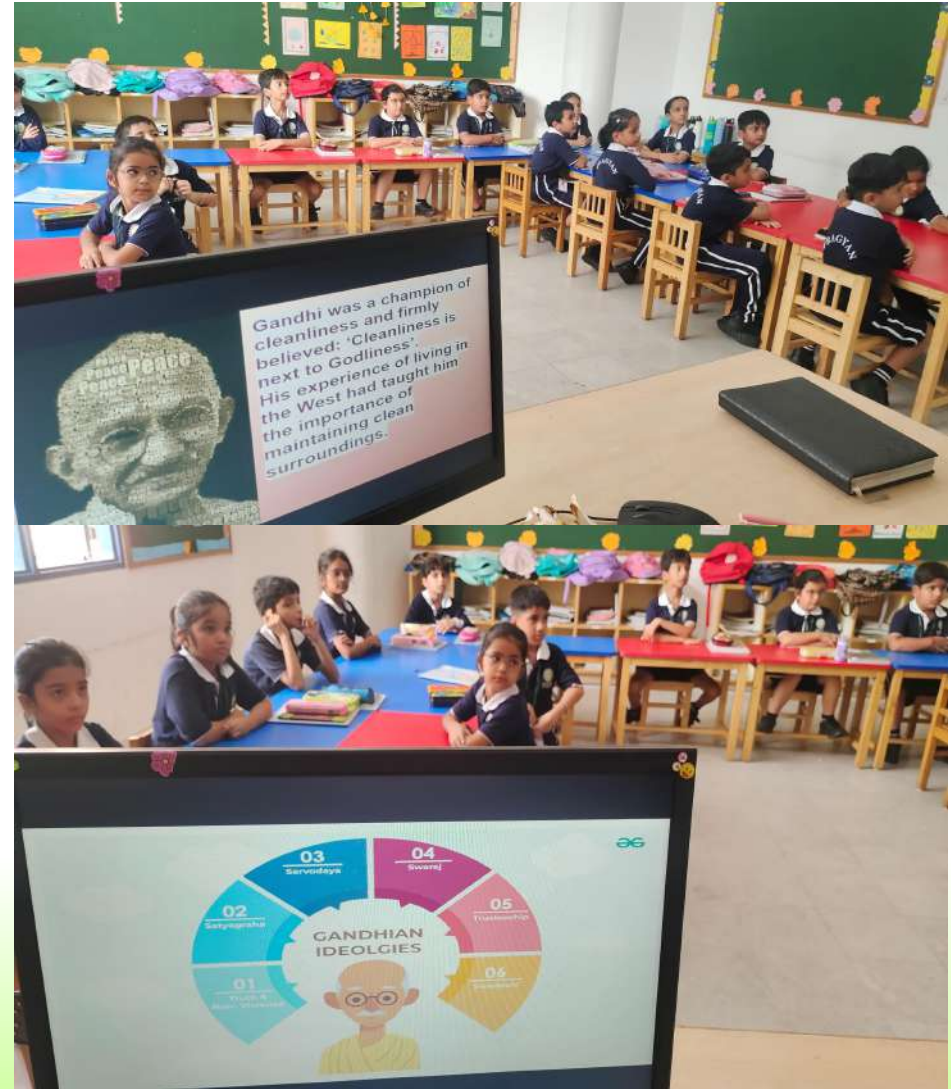
PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)
