ASSEMBLY IX-XII

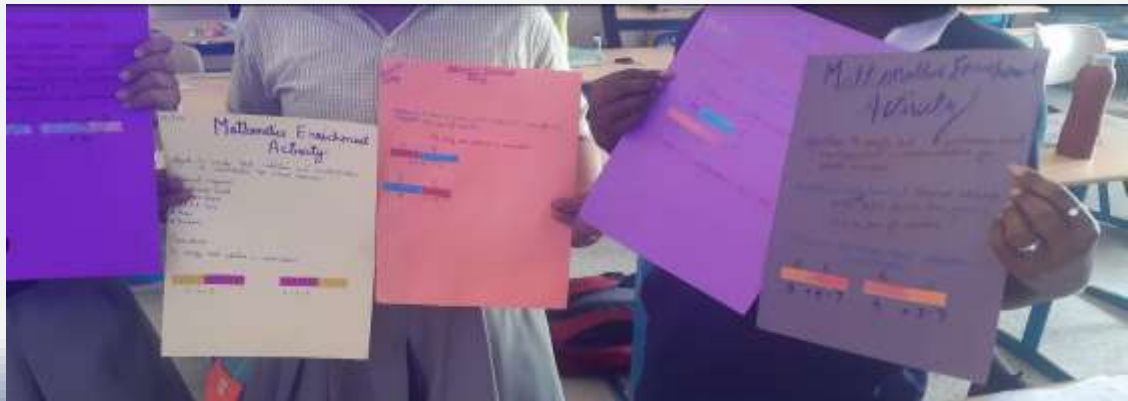

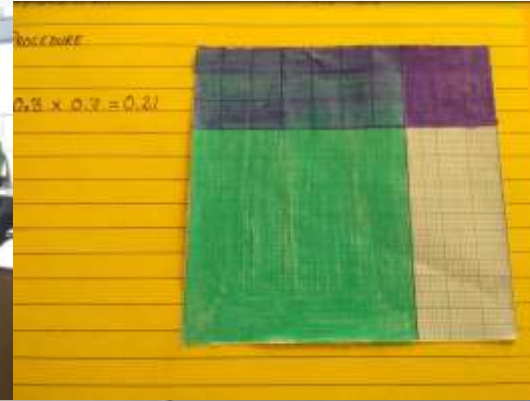
ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY VII

WORK EDUCATION VII

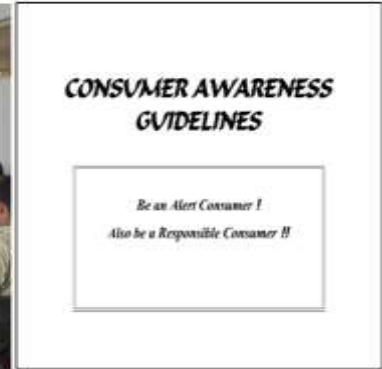

During the Atal lab session this week, students of class VI made a speedster from the machanz kit 9 plus.



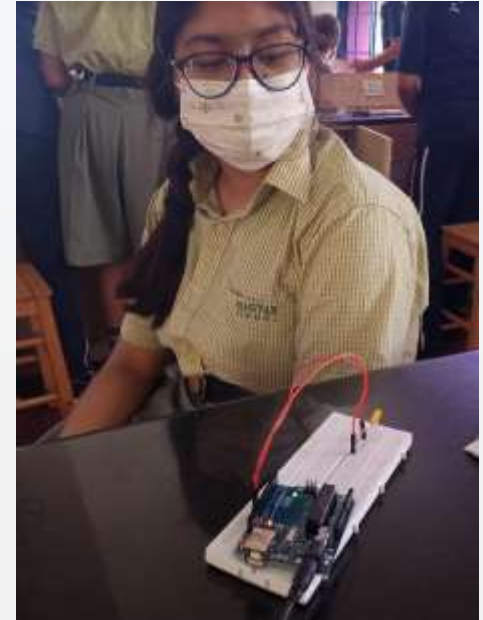
ATL SESSIONS VIII
