E.V.S: Oral revision of Insects & Birds and their habitats was done in the class.

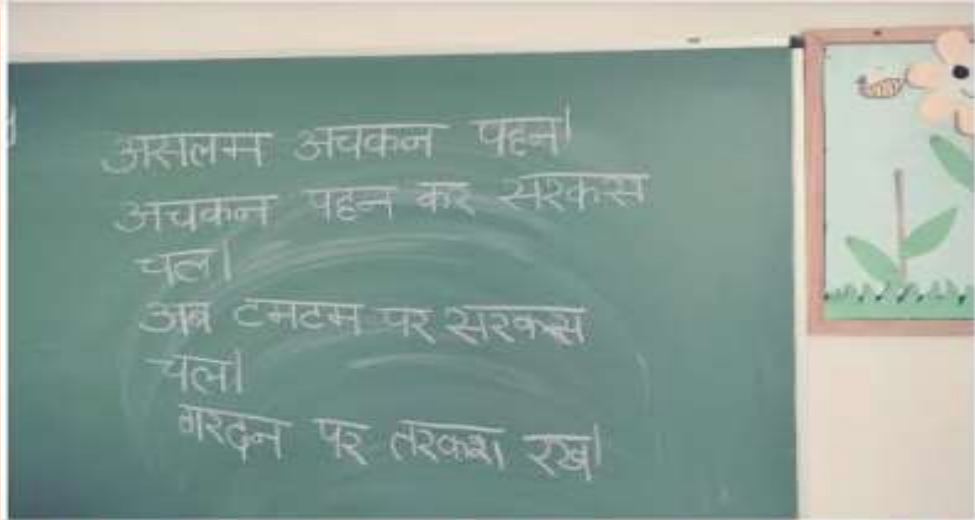
KINDERGARTEN

PHYSICAL EDUCATION (3-5)

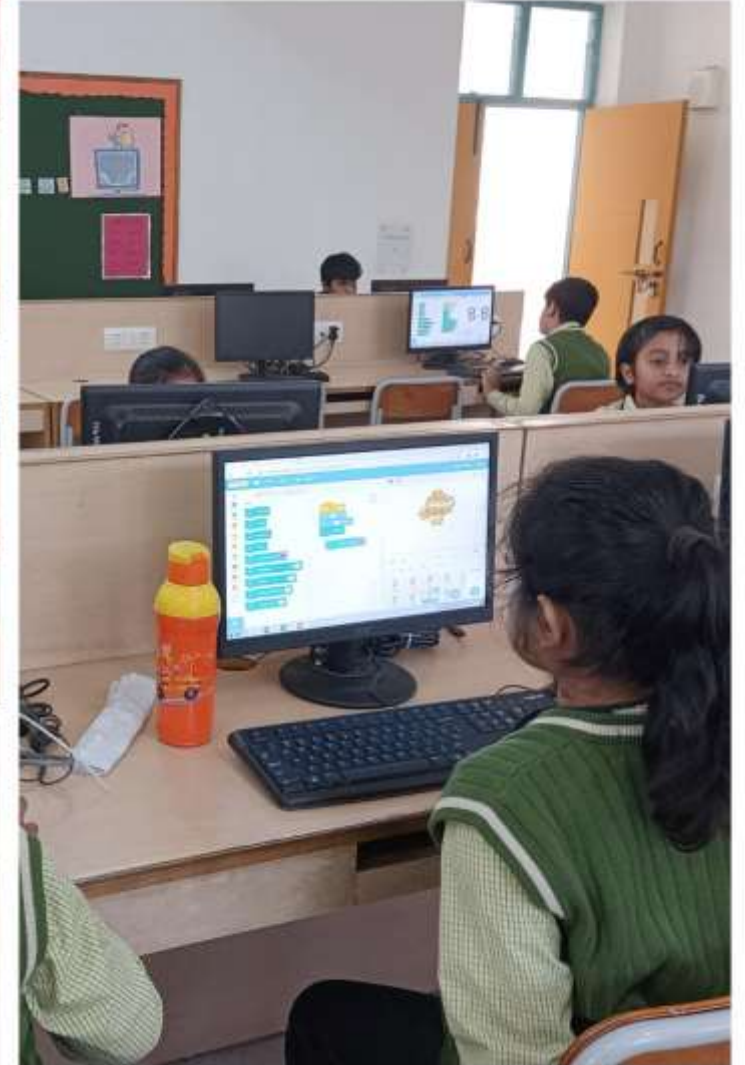
