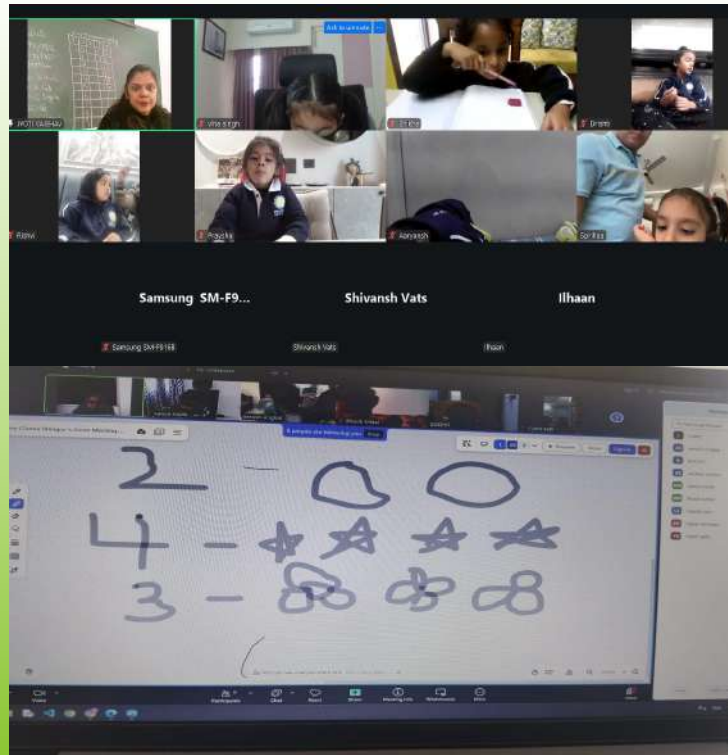


NURSERY



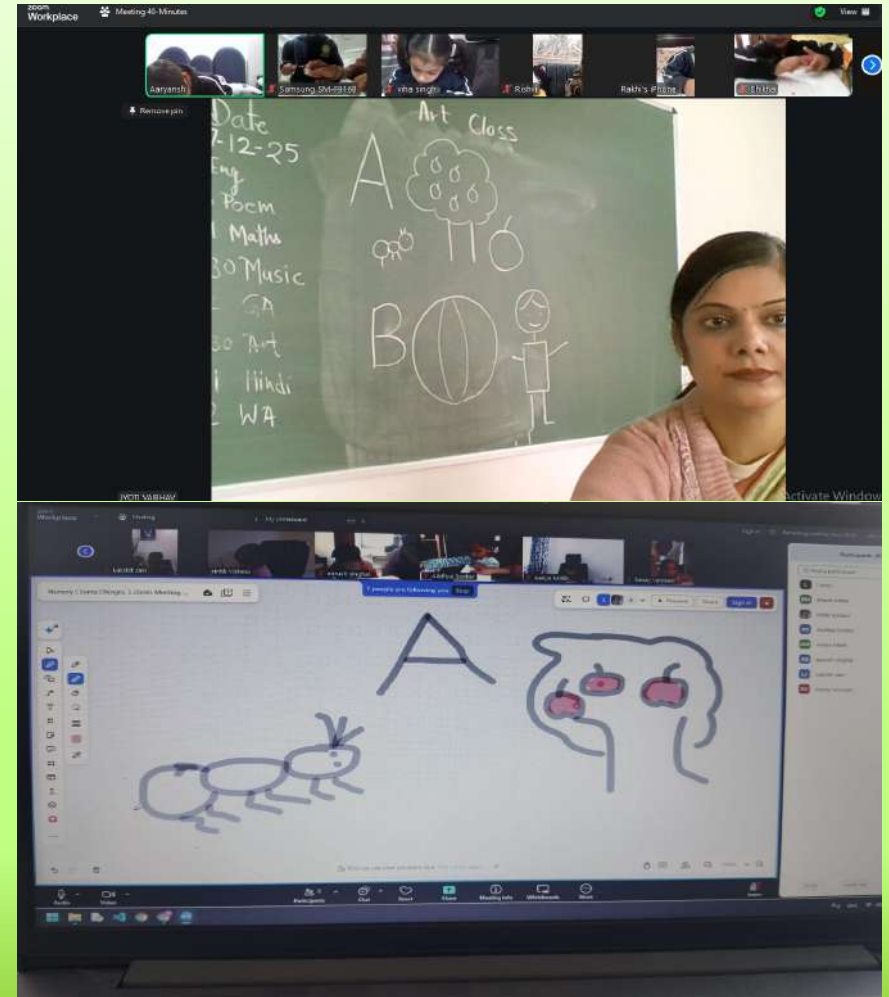
MATHS

Due to the online classes, nursery students revised numbers from 0 -10 in Maths. They practised number writing from 0 -20, oral counting from 0 - 30, and air writing activities. Revision of what comes after was reinforced as well. These engaging activities strengthened number recognition and developed a better understanding of basic numeracy concepts.



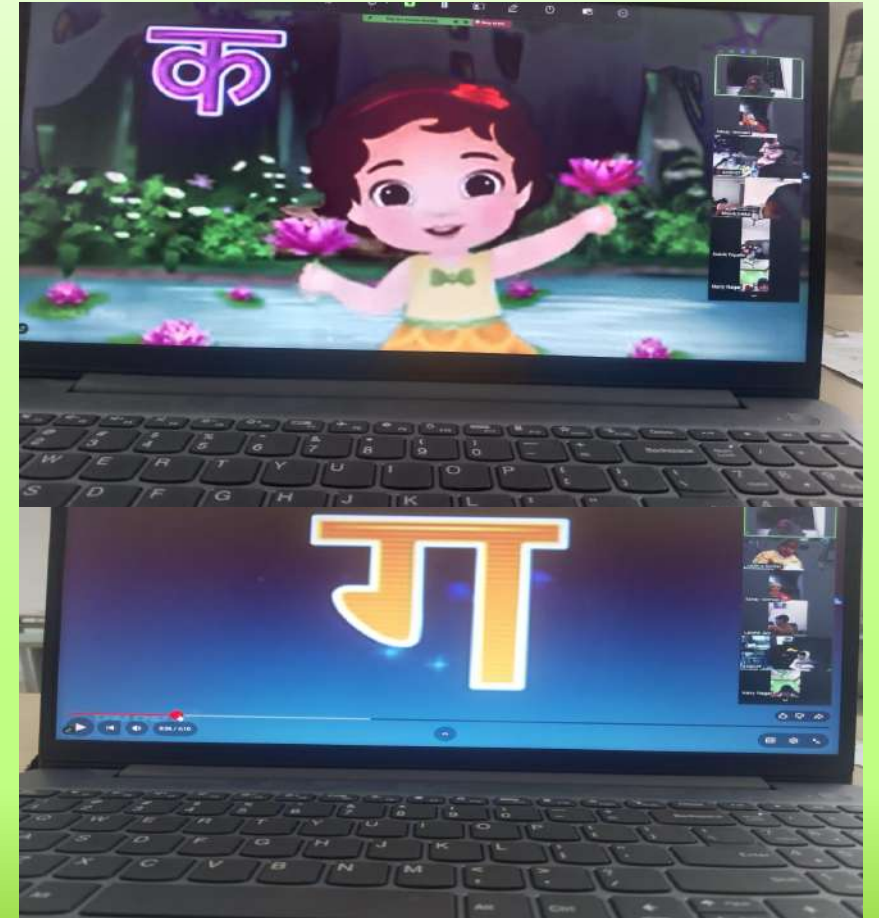
ENGLISH

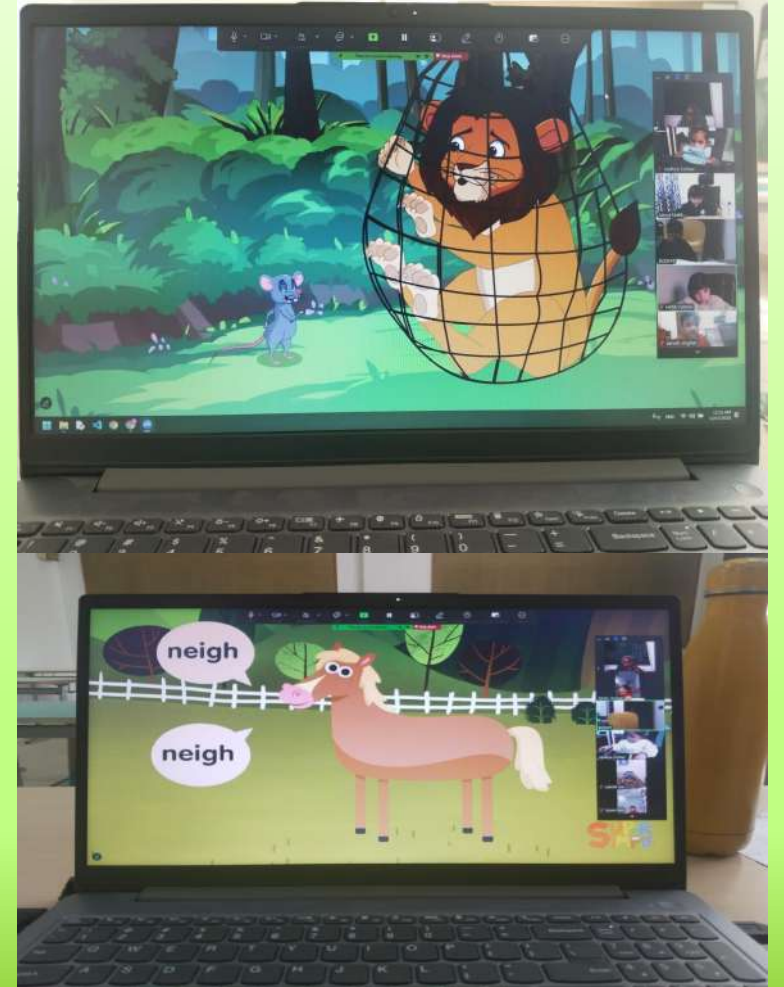
HINDI

GENERAL AWARENESS

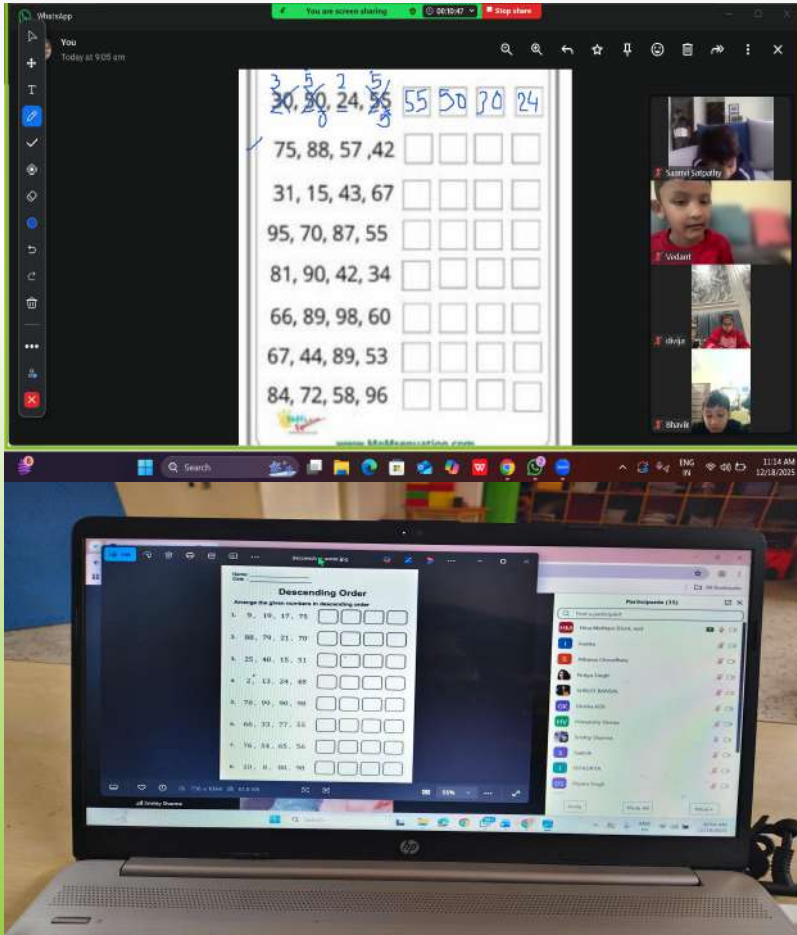

KINDERGARTEN

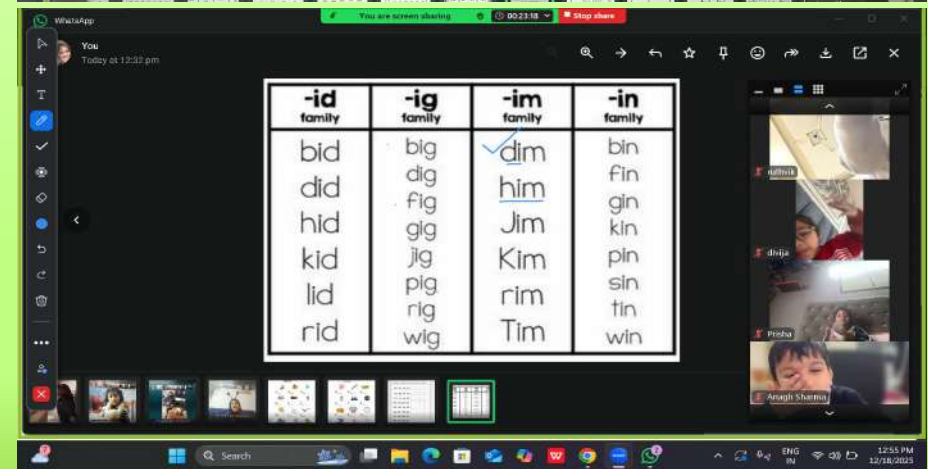
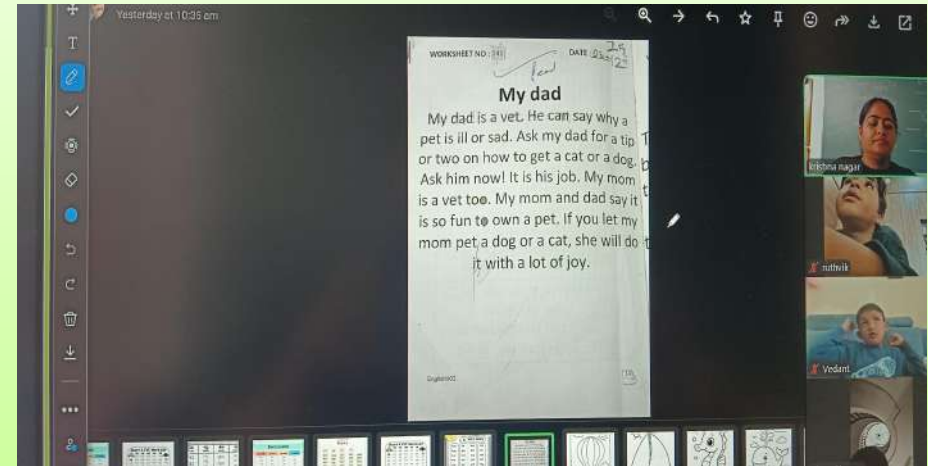
MATHS

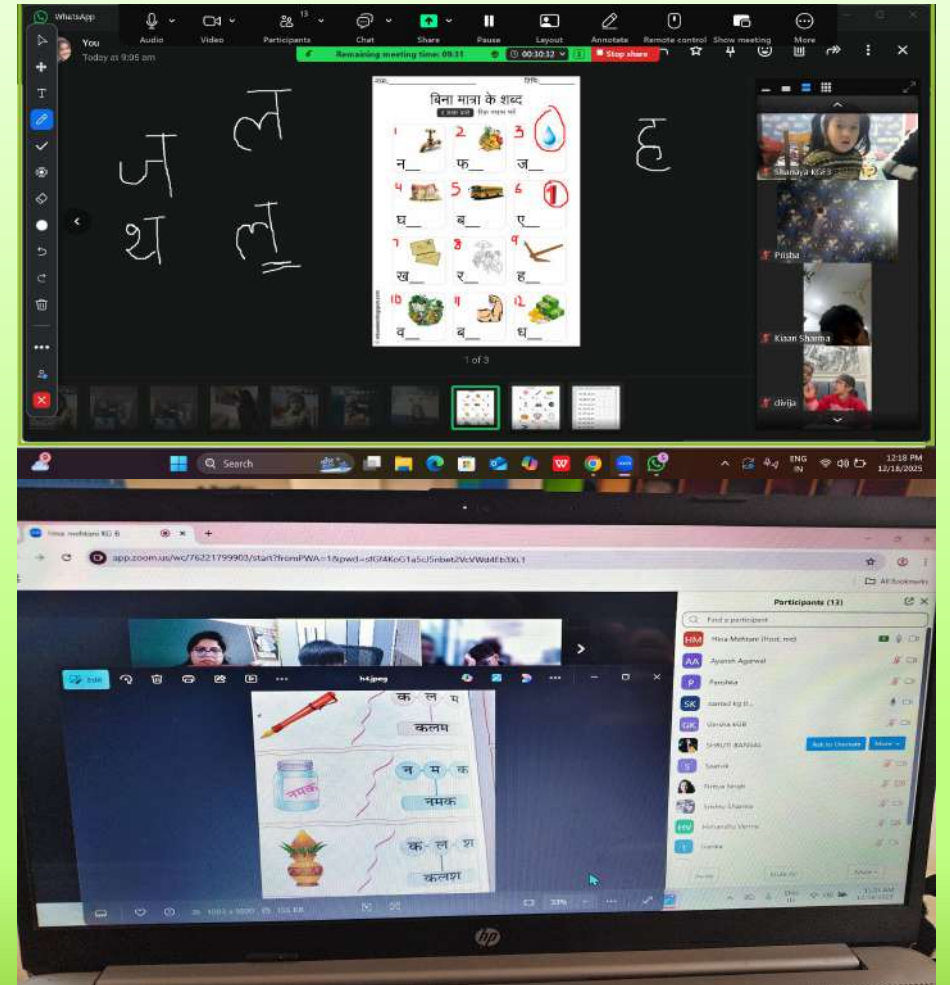
ENGLISH

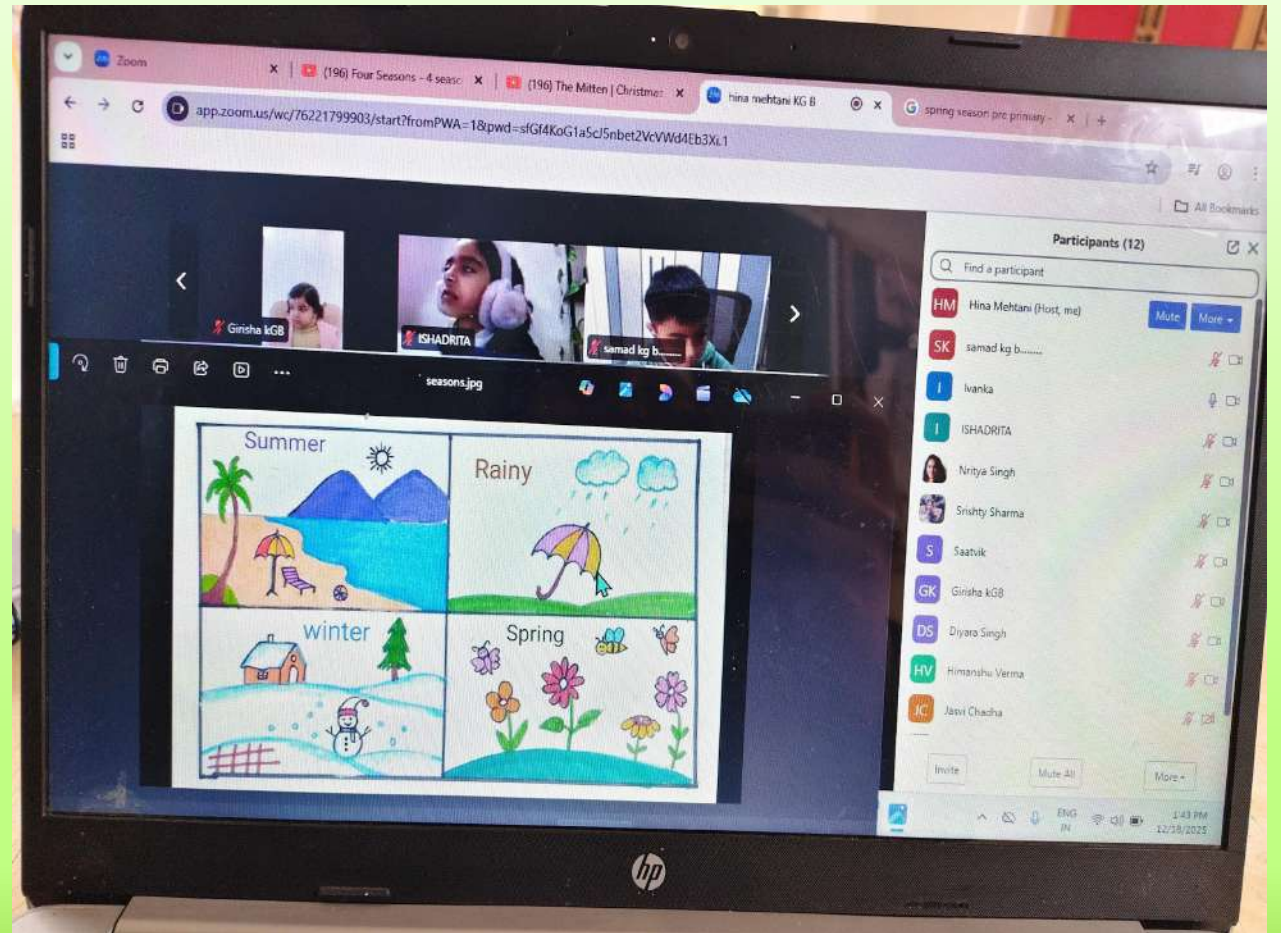
HINDI

GENERAL AWARENESS

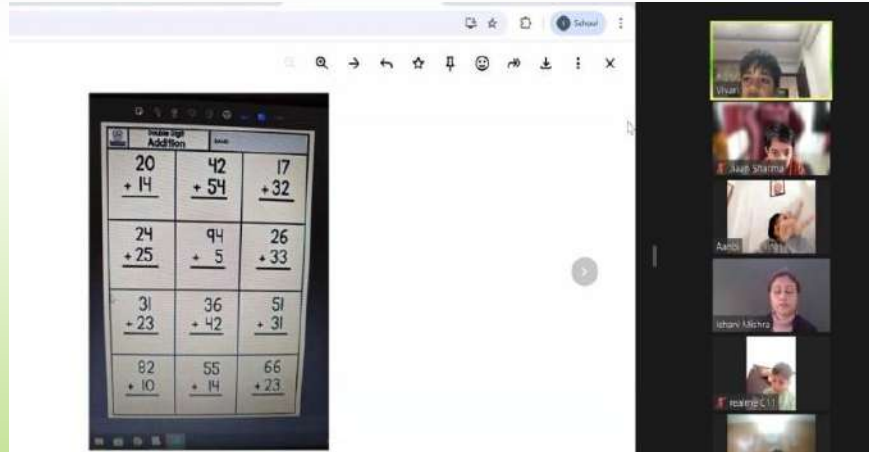

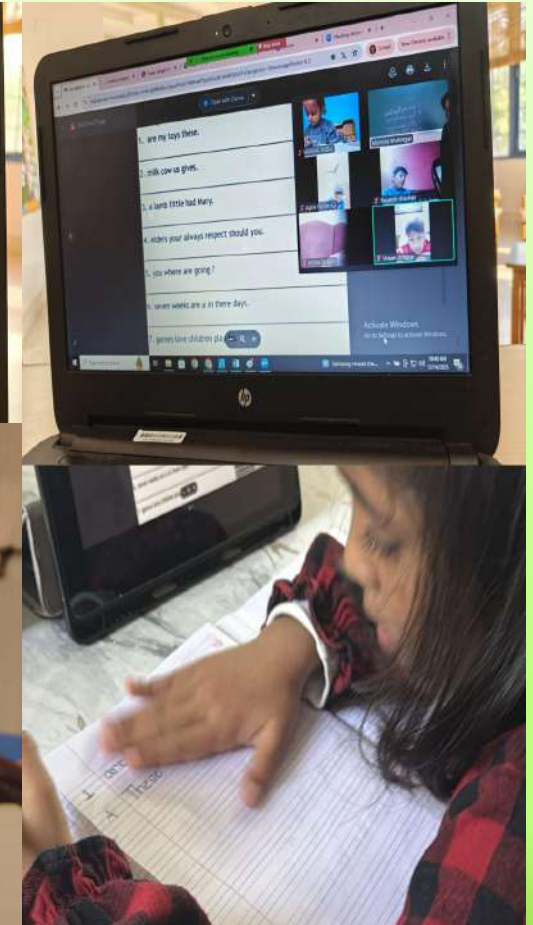
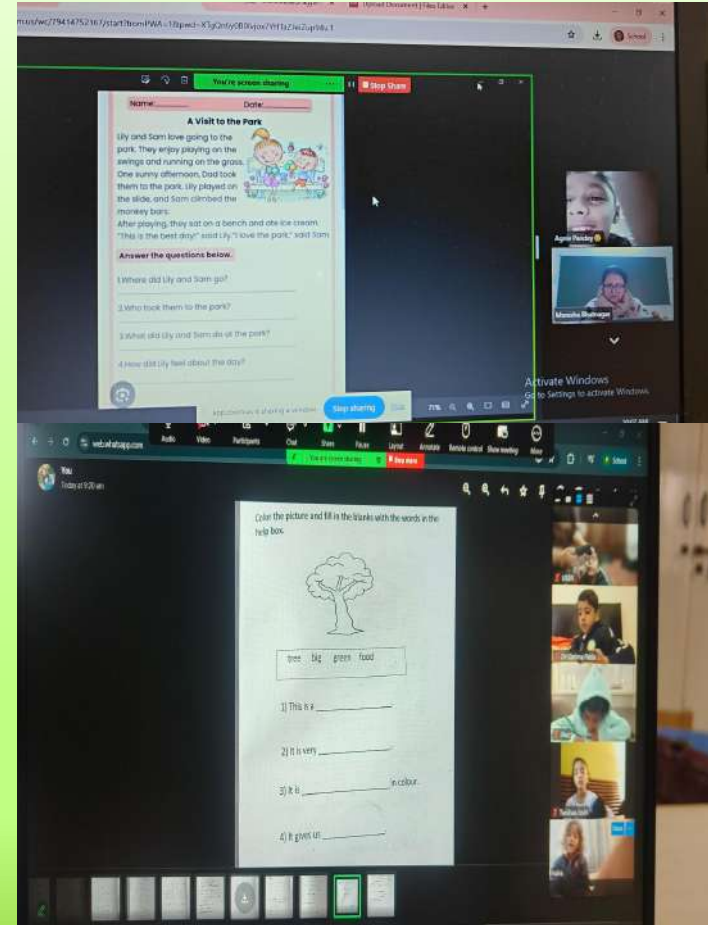

MATHS

In Maths, the students revised addition of single-digit and double-digit numbers and practiced it in the notebooks. They also revised skip counting by 2s and 3s, both orally and in writing. This practice helped to improve their confidence with numbers, speed in solving sums, and understanding of counting patterns.

ENGLISH

In English, the students read different passages and answered the questions related to them. They completed picture composition exercises and spoke and wrote 2–3 lines about the different objects shown during the online classes. They also revised the blend sounds and practiced writing them in the notebooks.



HINDI

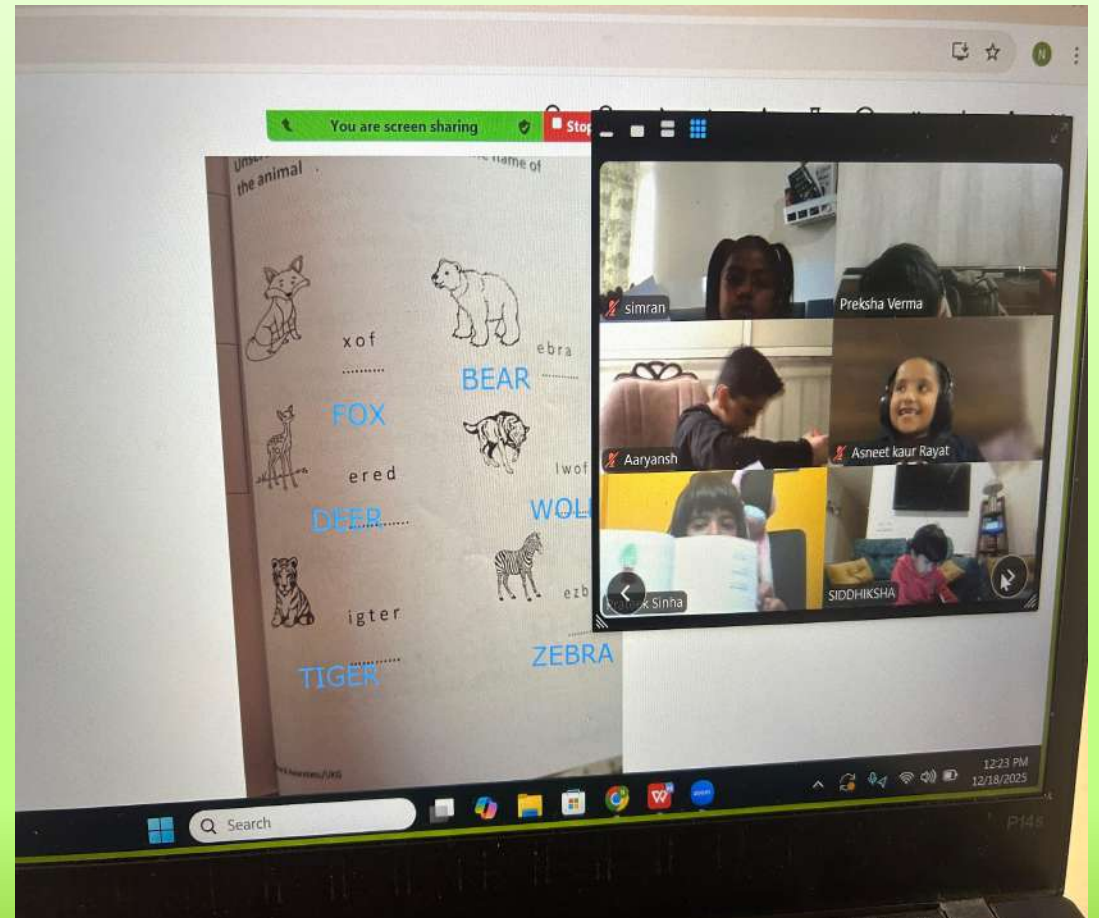

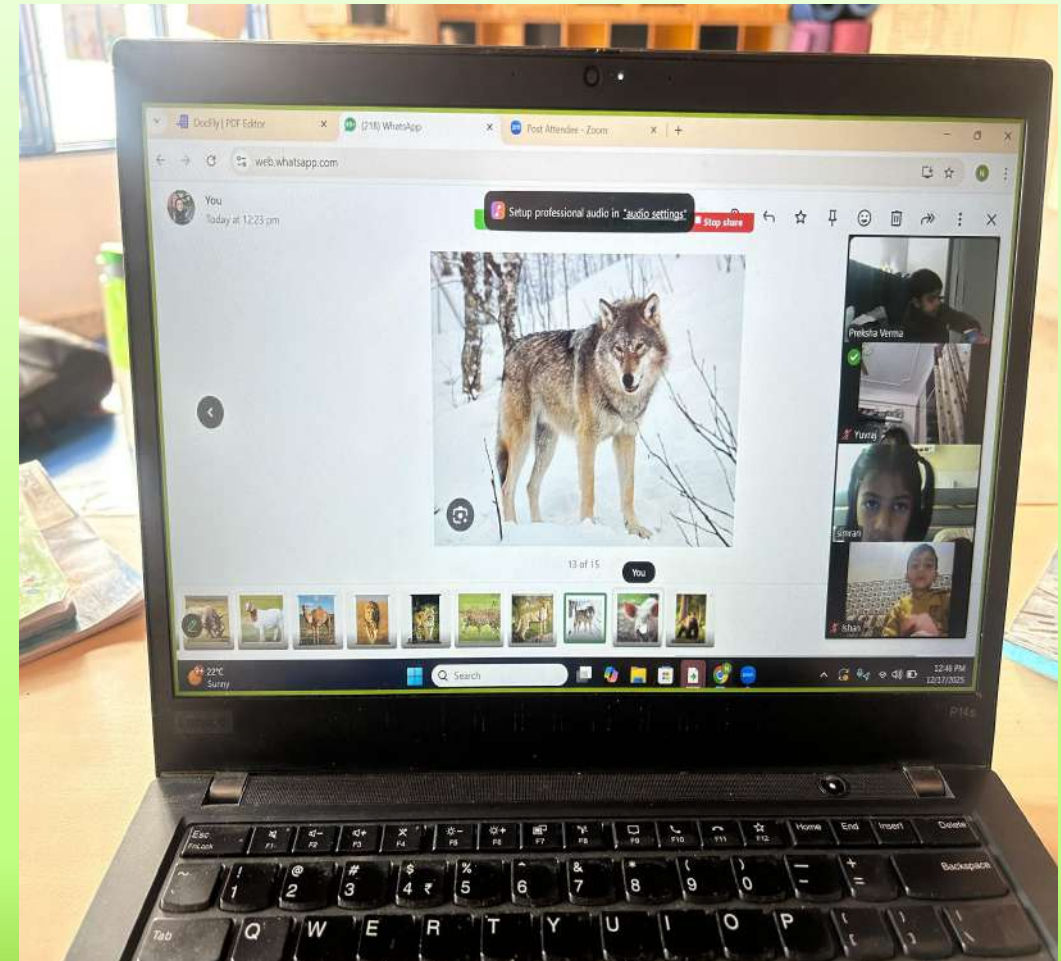
INTER CLASS ACTIVITY: BOOK CHARACTER

As part of the Inter class activity, Book Character was conducted online on 17th December, 2025. Students were supposed to speak a few lines on characters from the stories that were narrated in class or of their choice. The students of Nursery, Kindergarten and Upper Kindergarten chose a character and enacted the character with enthusiasm, using proper props. It was a participative activity, where all the students participated actively, expressed themselves confidently, and enjoyed bringing the stories and characters to life.



CONVERSATION TIME

During conversation time, the students were introduced to the terms herbivores, carnivores, and omnivores. Students were explained the meaning of each term and discussed the differences between them. To reinforce their understanding, pictures of different animals were shown and questions were asked. The students actively participated and identified animals that belonged to herbivores, carnivores, or omnivores categories.





This week, the New Words and Poem of the Month activities were conducted with a focus on the chapter “Friends in Need.” The chapter was introduced through interactive discussion and reading sessions to help students understand the theme of friendship and kindness. Children practiced related book exercises to strengthen their reading and comprehension skills. They also wrote a few lines about their best friend, which encouraged self-expression and creative thinking. Revision activities on describing words and action words were carried out to reinforce language concepts. Overall, the students participated actively and showed enthusiasm throughout the learning process.

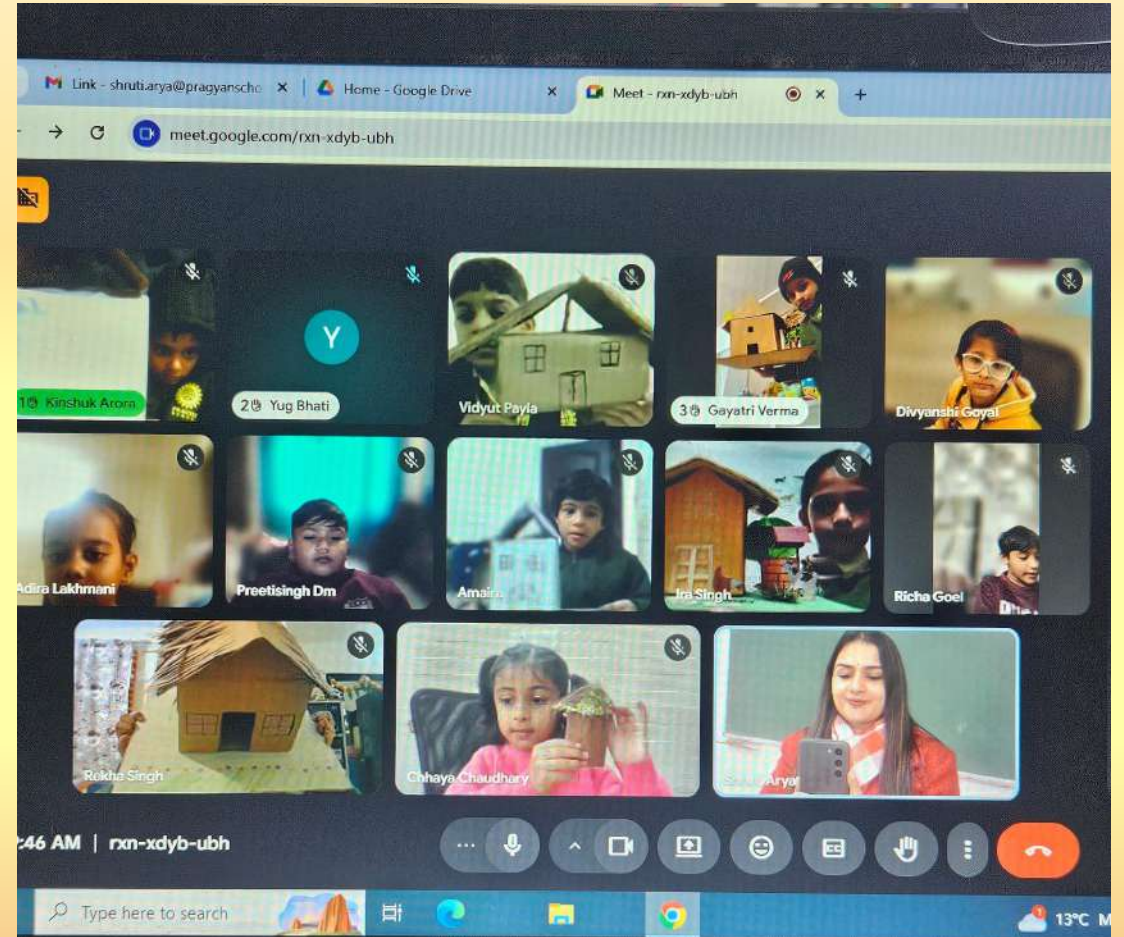




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

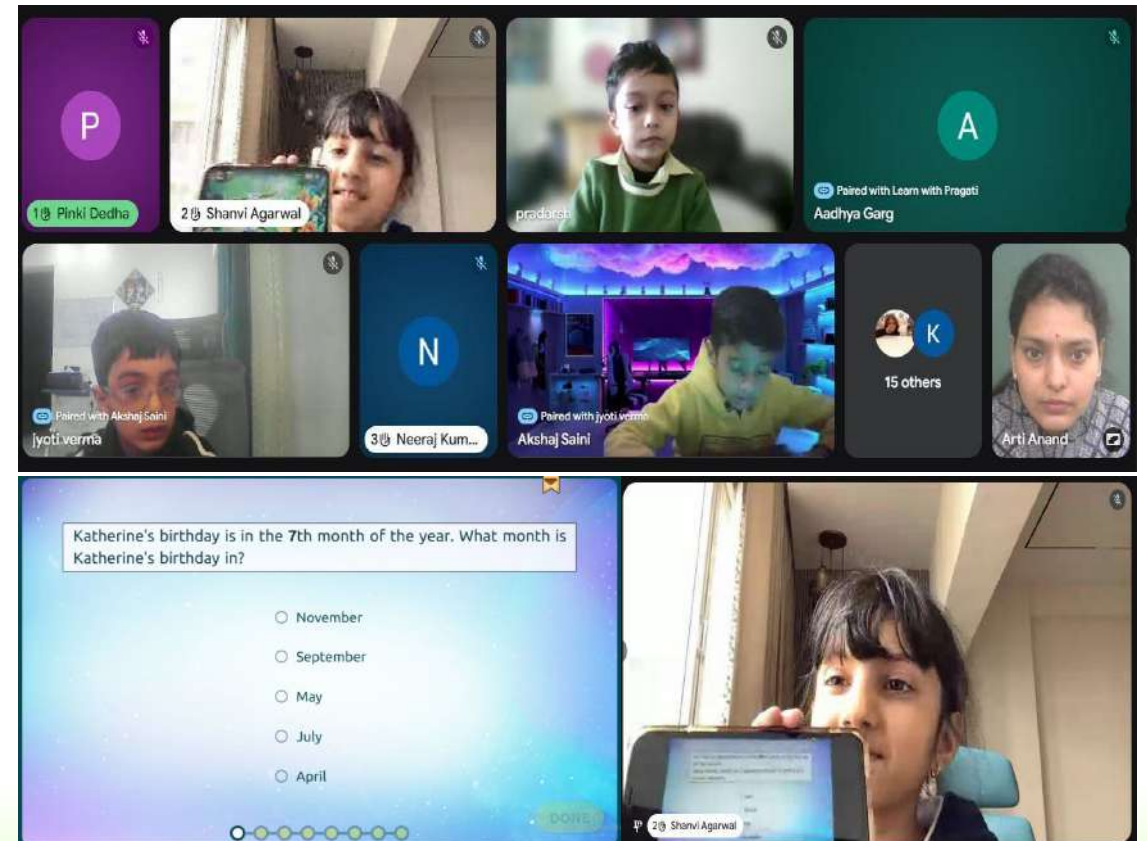
ART & CRAFT (1&2)

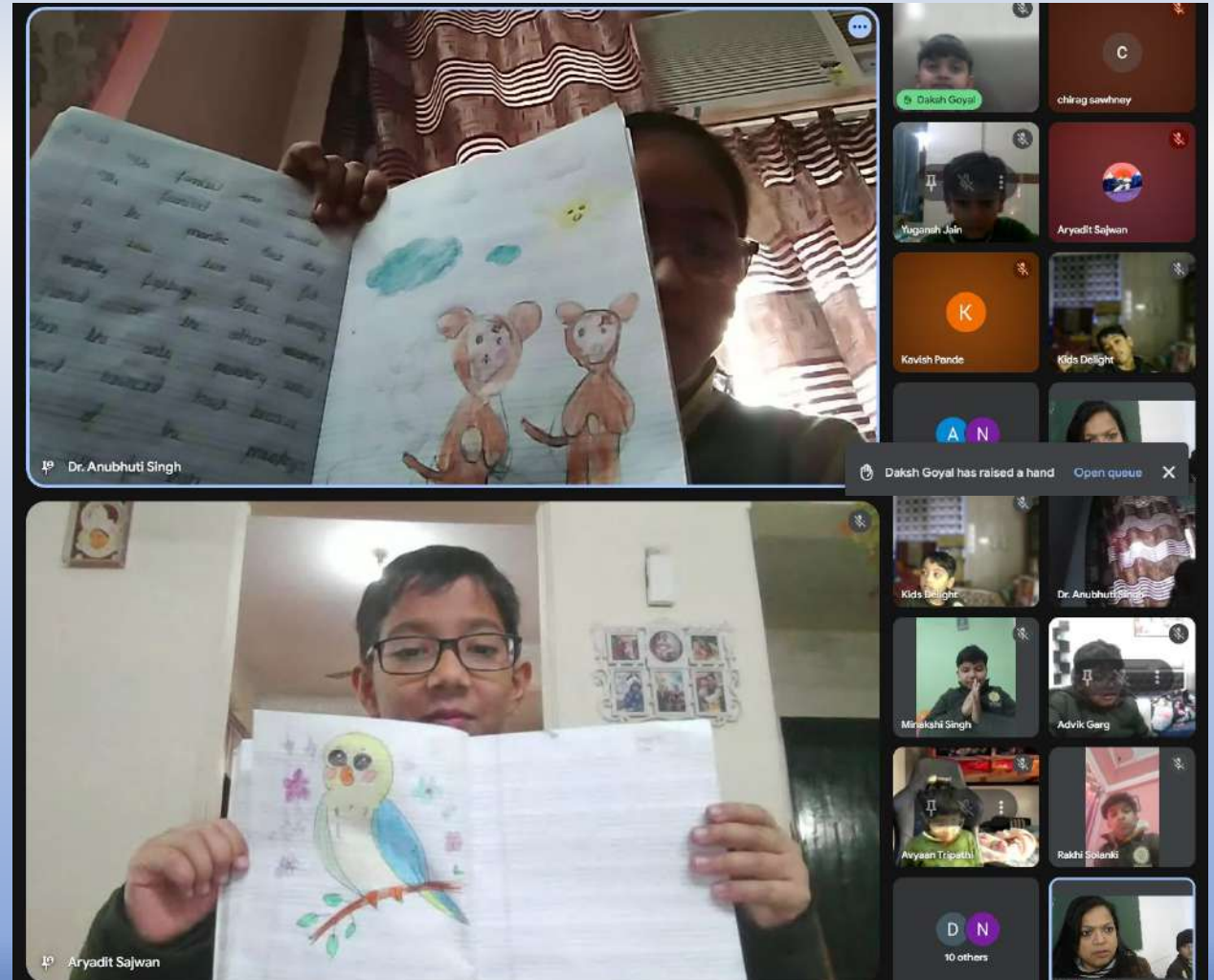
LIBRARY (1 & 2)

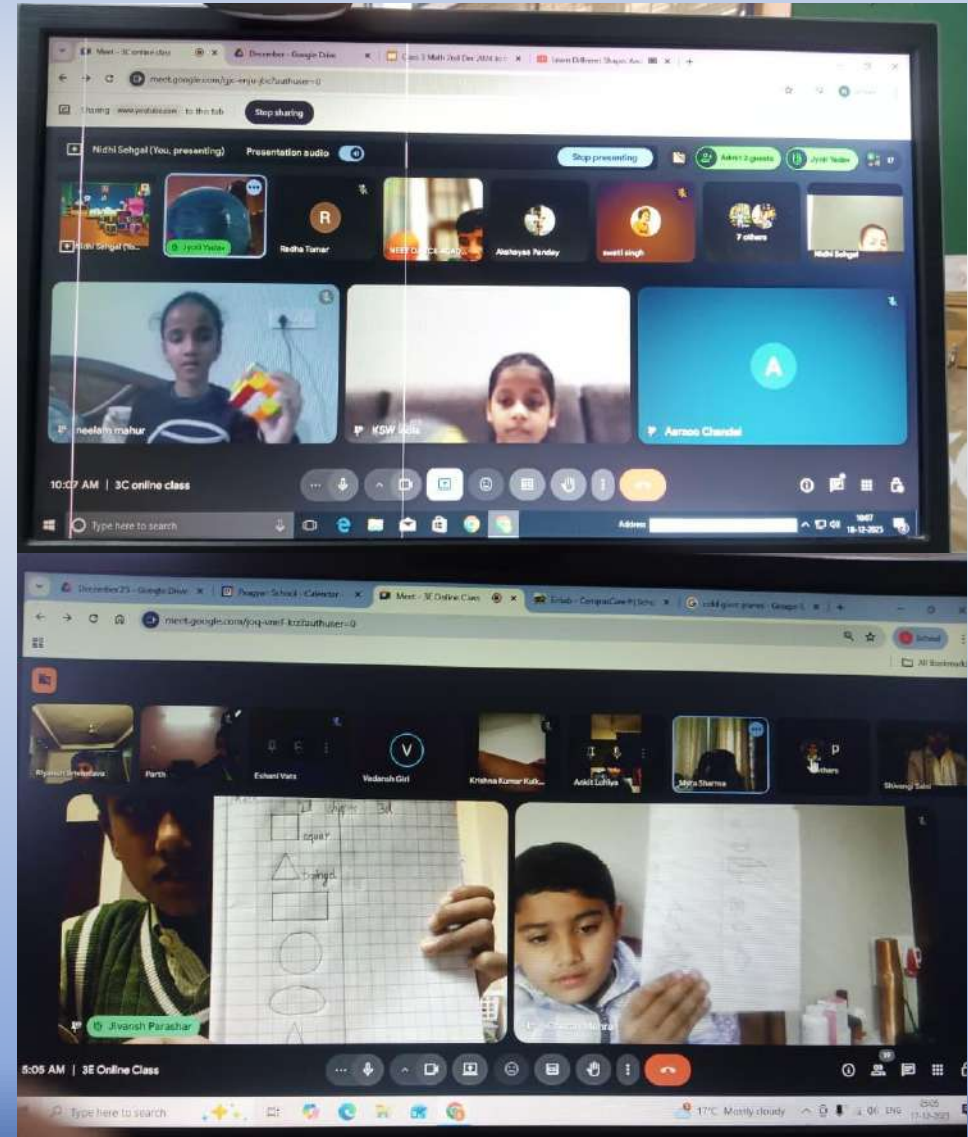

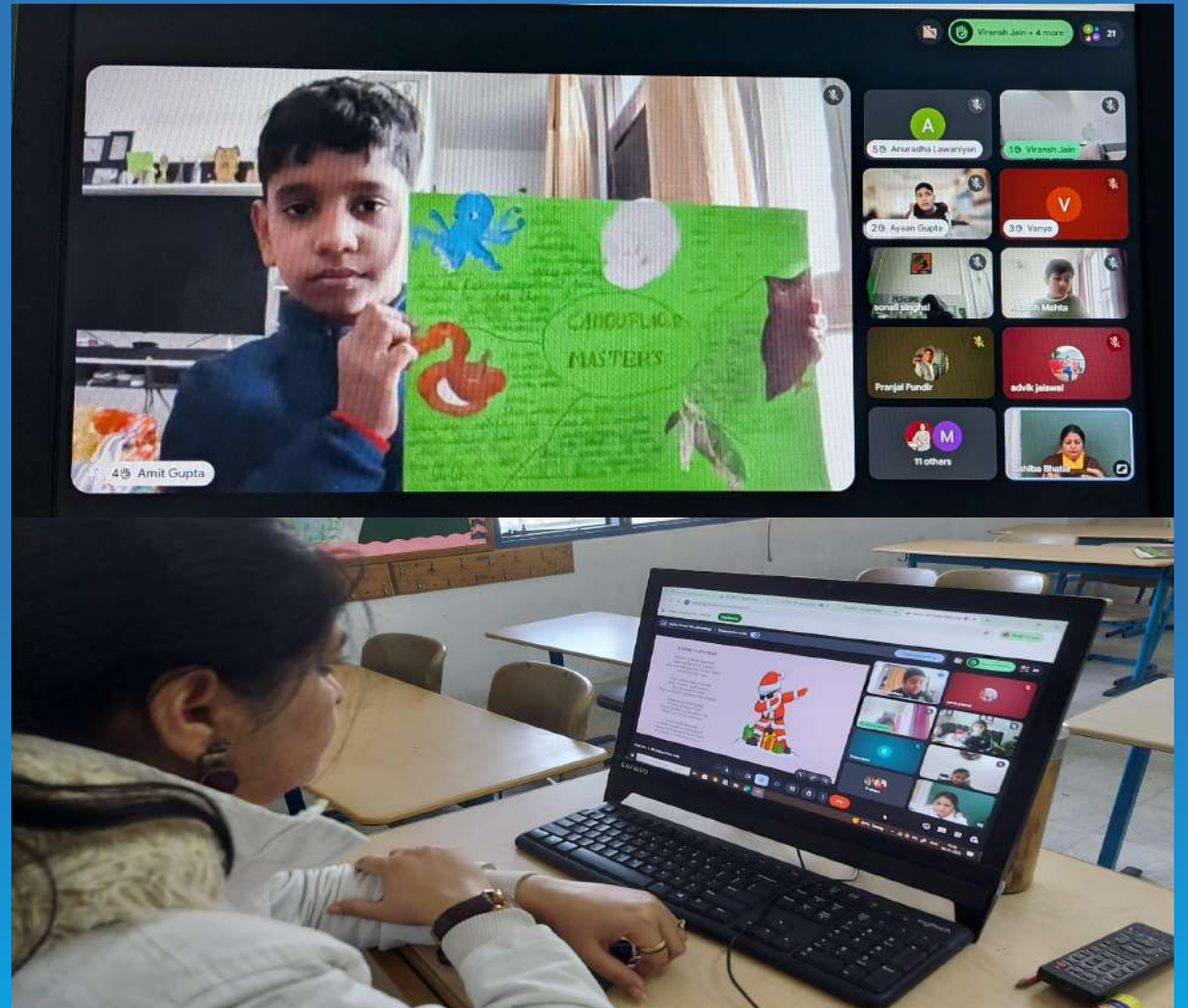
ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

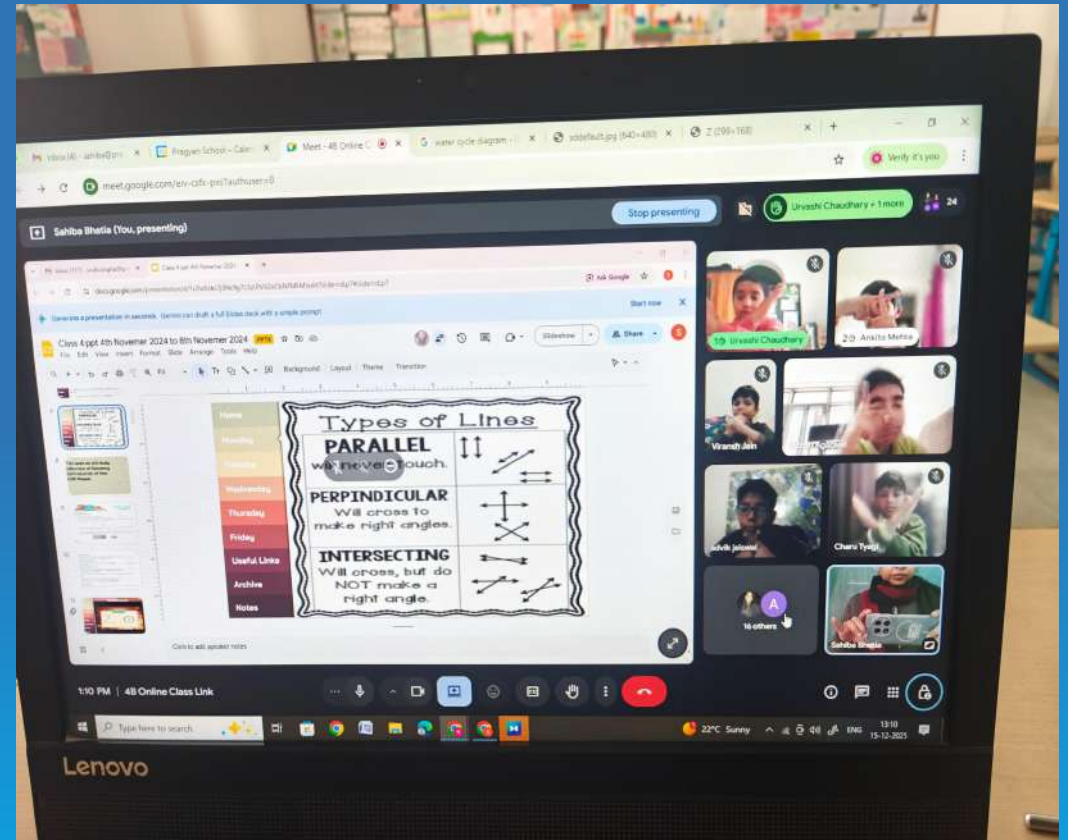

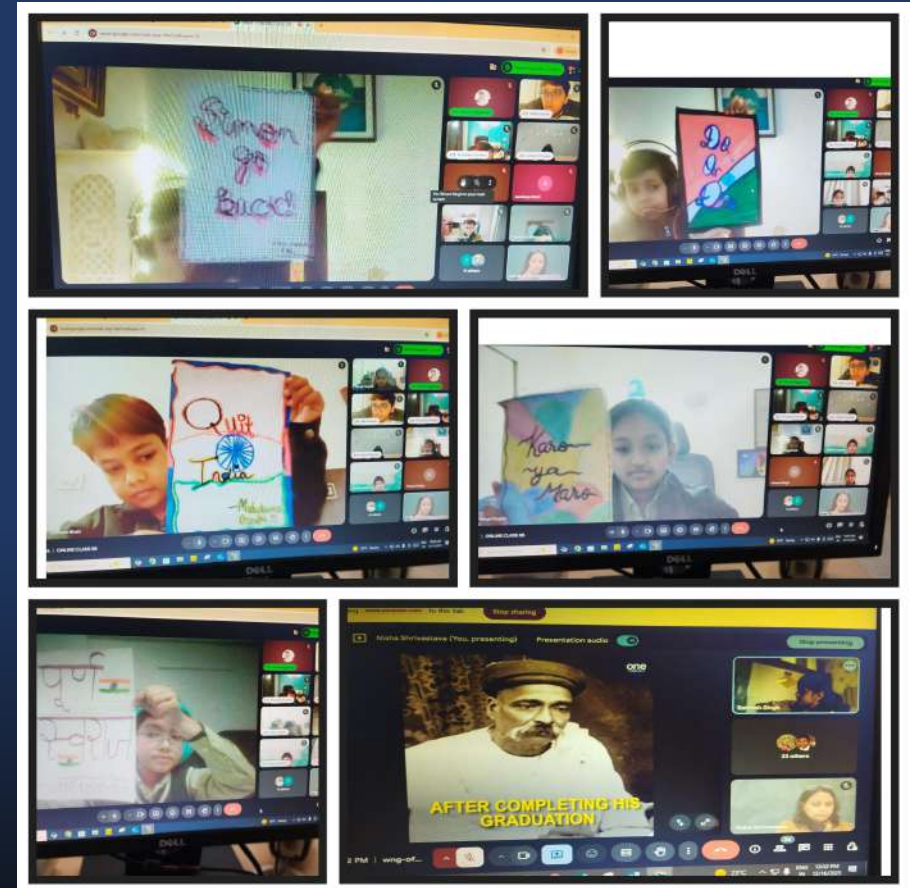

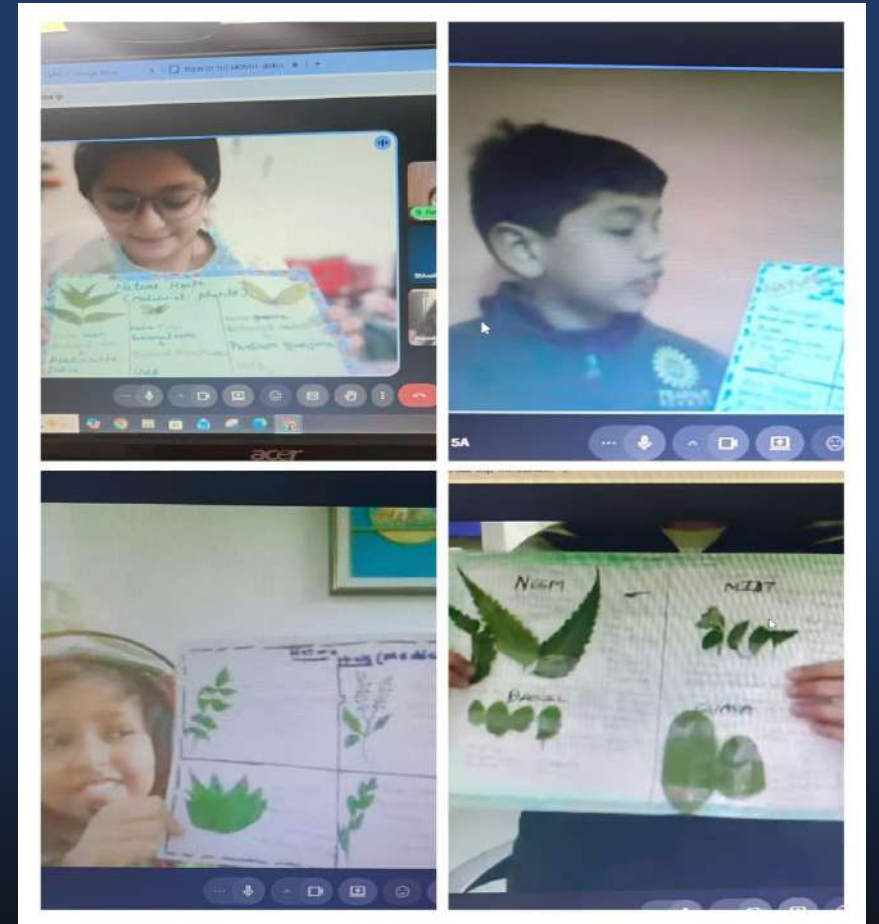
ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Grade 5 students studied the chapter “Our Leaders” in their online EVS classes. They learned about great leaders such as Rani Lakshmi Bai, Bal Gangadhar Tilak, and Sarojini Naidu. The students were taught about the contributions of these leaders to the freedom struggle and their major achievements. They also wrote and presented the famous slogans given by these leaders during the class and recited English poems written by Sarojini Naidu. Videos related to the lives and work of the leaders were shown to the students to enhance their understanding.





The students of Class 5 prepared an Art Integrated project titled “Nature Heals” based on medicinal plants. They were guided to collect leaves with medicinal value from their surroundings. The children collected a variety of leaves such as neem, holy basil (tulsi), hibiscus, aloe vera, and many more. Each student created a detailed project by researching the uses and health benefits of the collected leaves. They also included the biological names of the plants in their work. Along with this activity, the students reinforced their understanding of conjunctions and their types by using them appropriately in examples, successfully integrating language learning with the project.

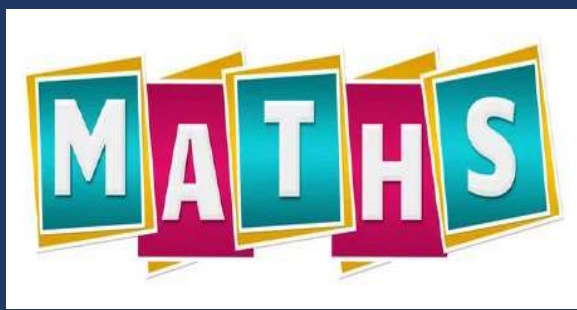




हिन्दी
