Evs- Students of KG learnt about fish and enjoyed colouring worksheets also.



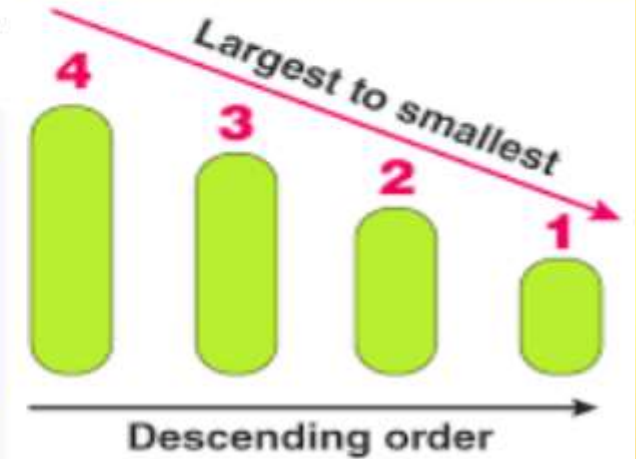

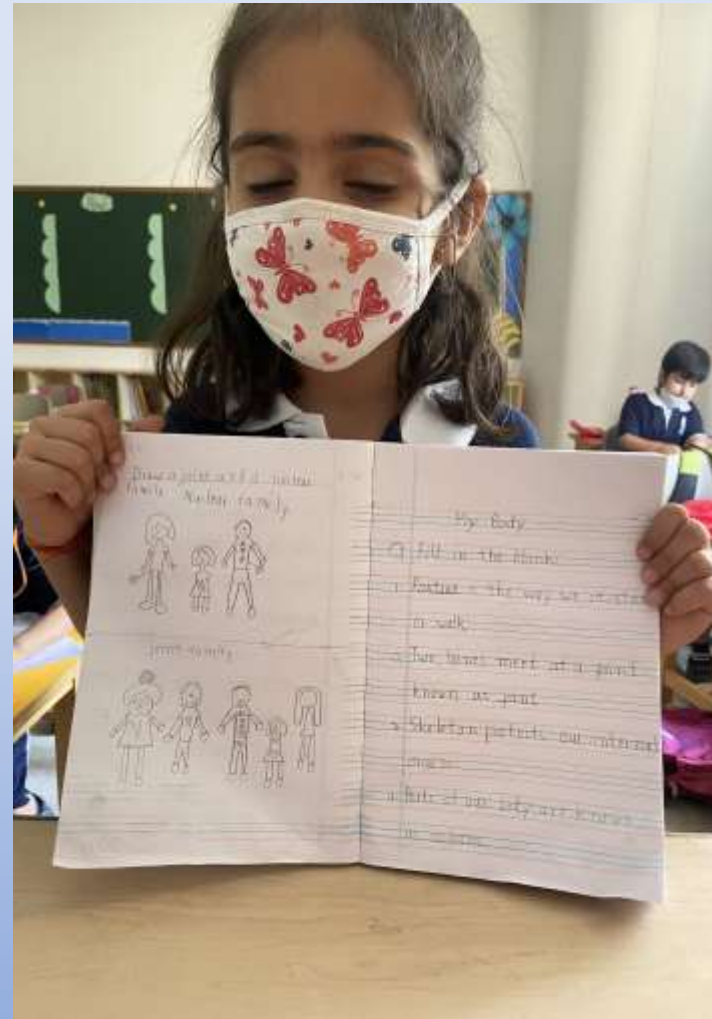

# YOGA SESSION(3-5)

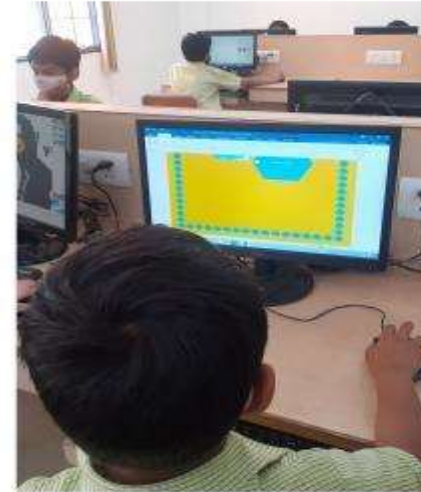
