**Science Demo** - Rough & smooth activity was done by showing various things like sponge, soft toys, scotch brite, sand paper etc.

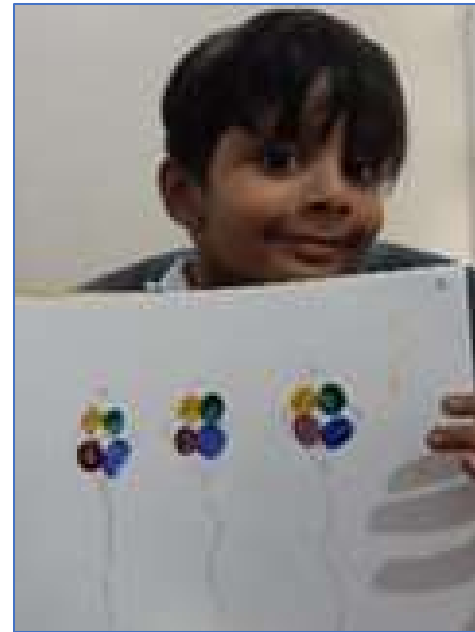

**Maths** - Introduction and Recognition of. 0-30 was done with help of no cards. Written practice of numbers was done in notebook and workbook.

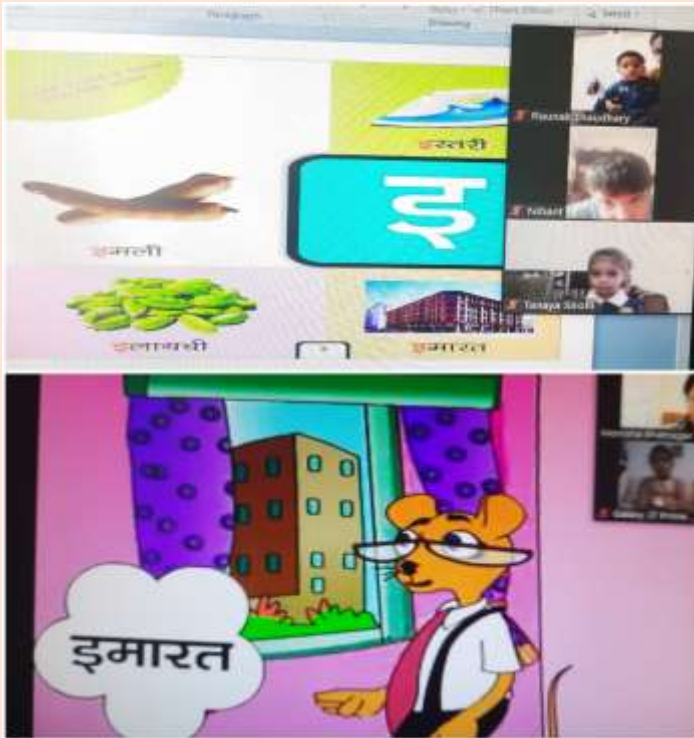

Evs - Rabbit' was introduced in class, students learnt few facts on rabbit. Students enjoyed watching rabbit and tortoise story

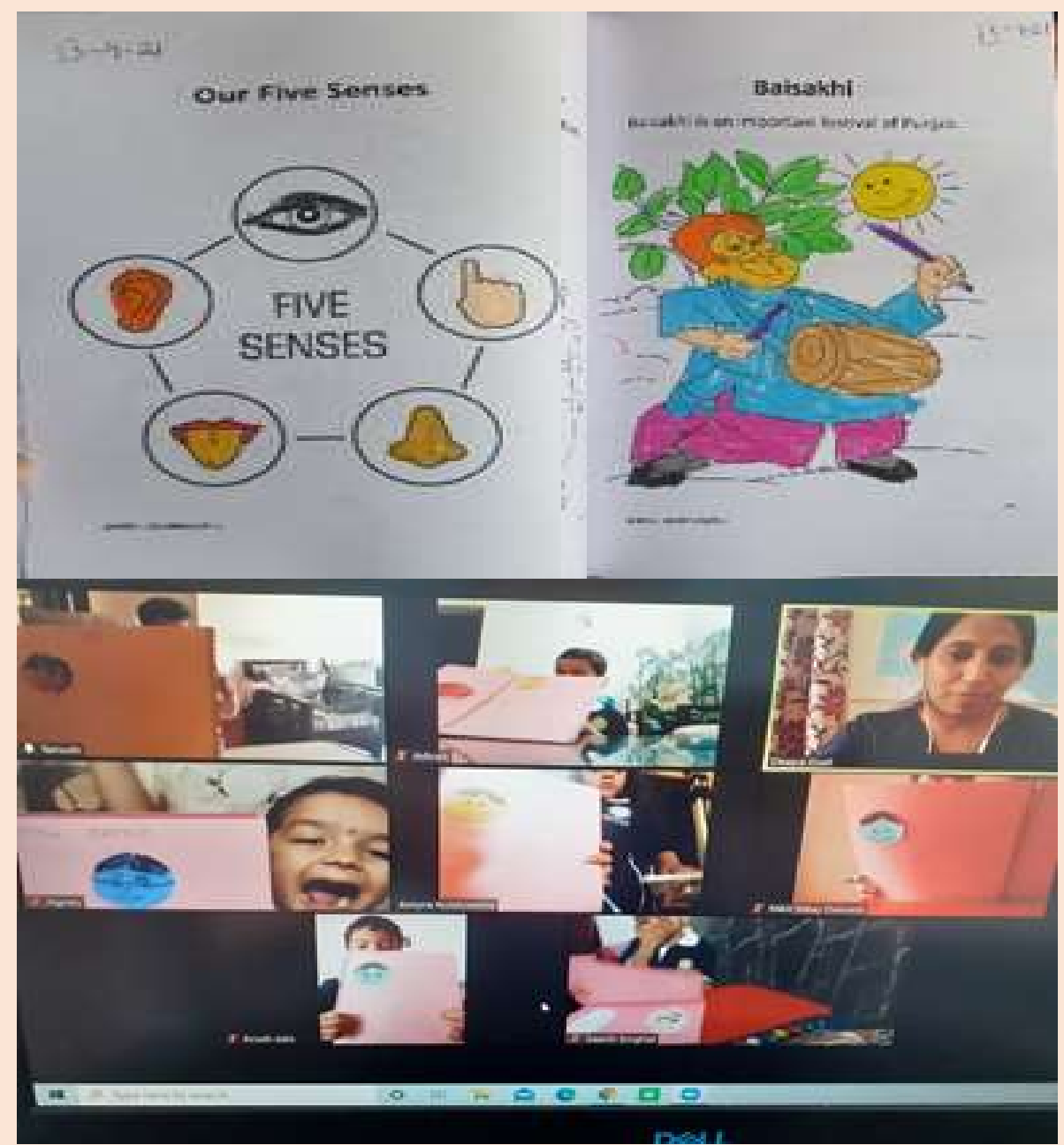
Music - Students enjoyed singing 'Hum bache Pyare Pyar'e in the class .

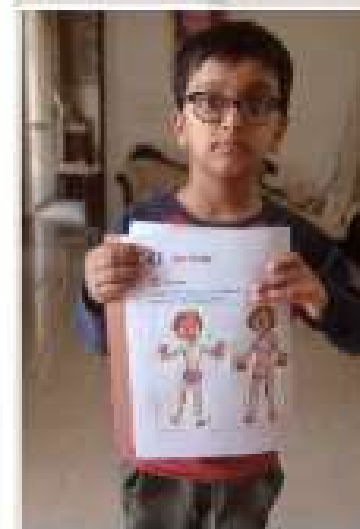

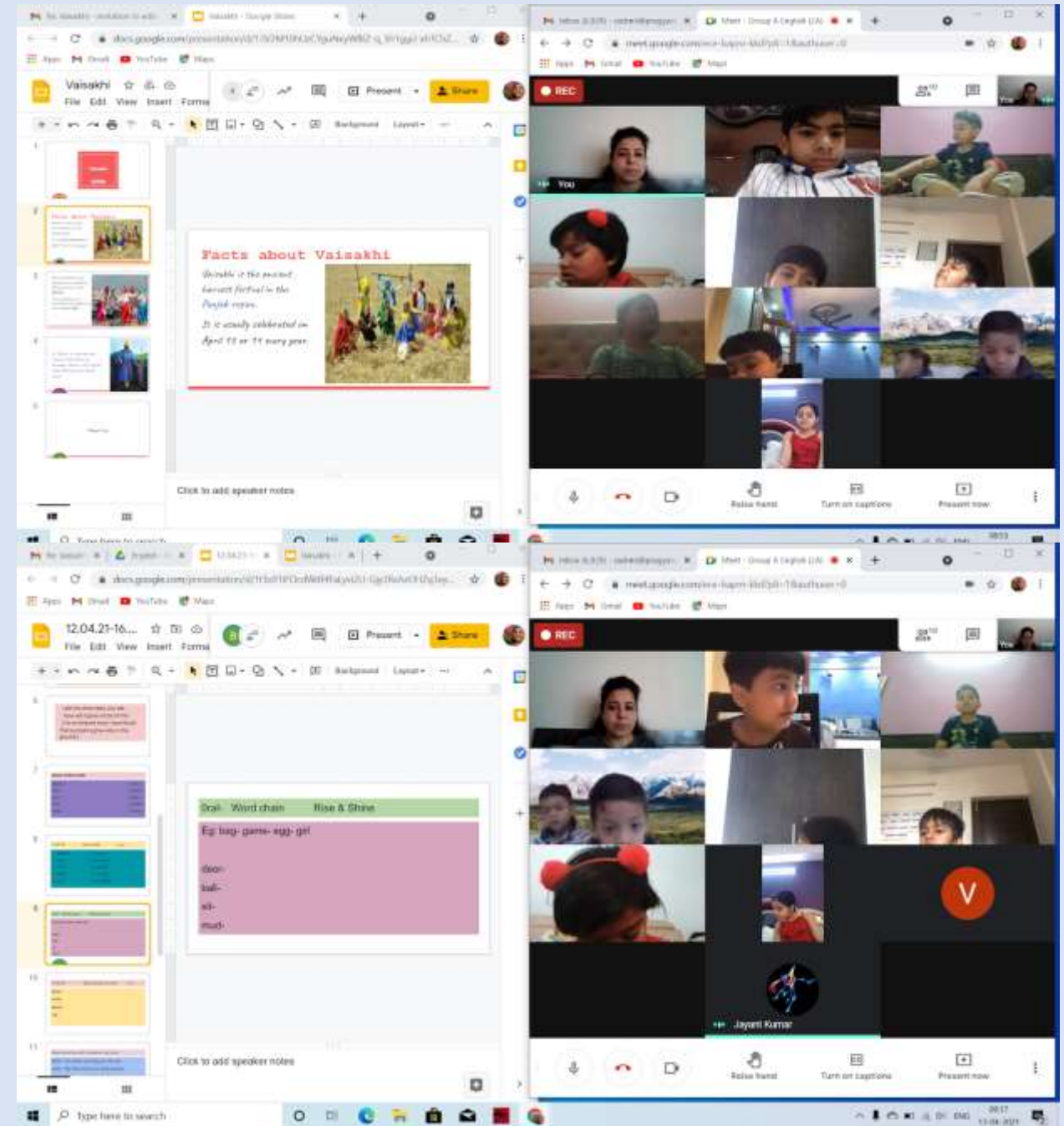

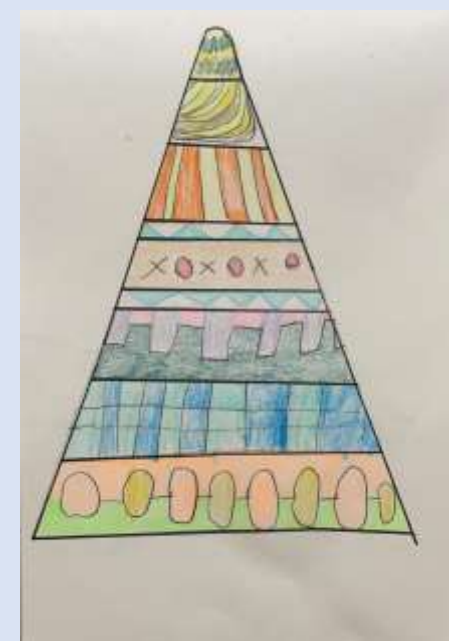

Students of class 2 were taught to make patterns using different lines and shapes through a story. All the students created their patterns on their own and used in making a tent. They enjoyed the activity.





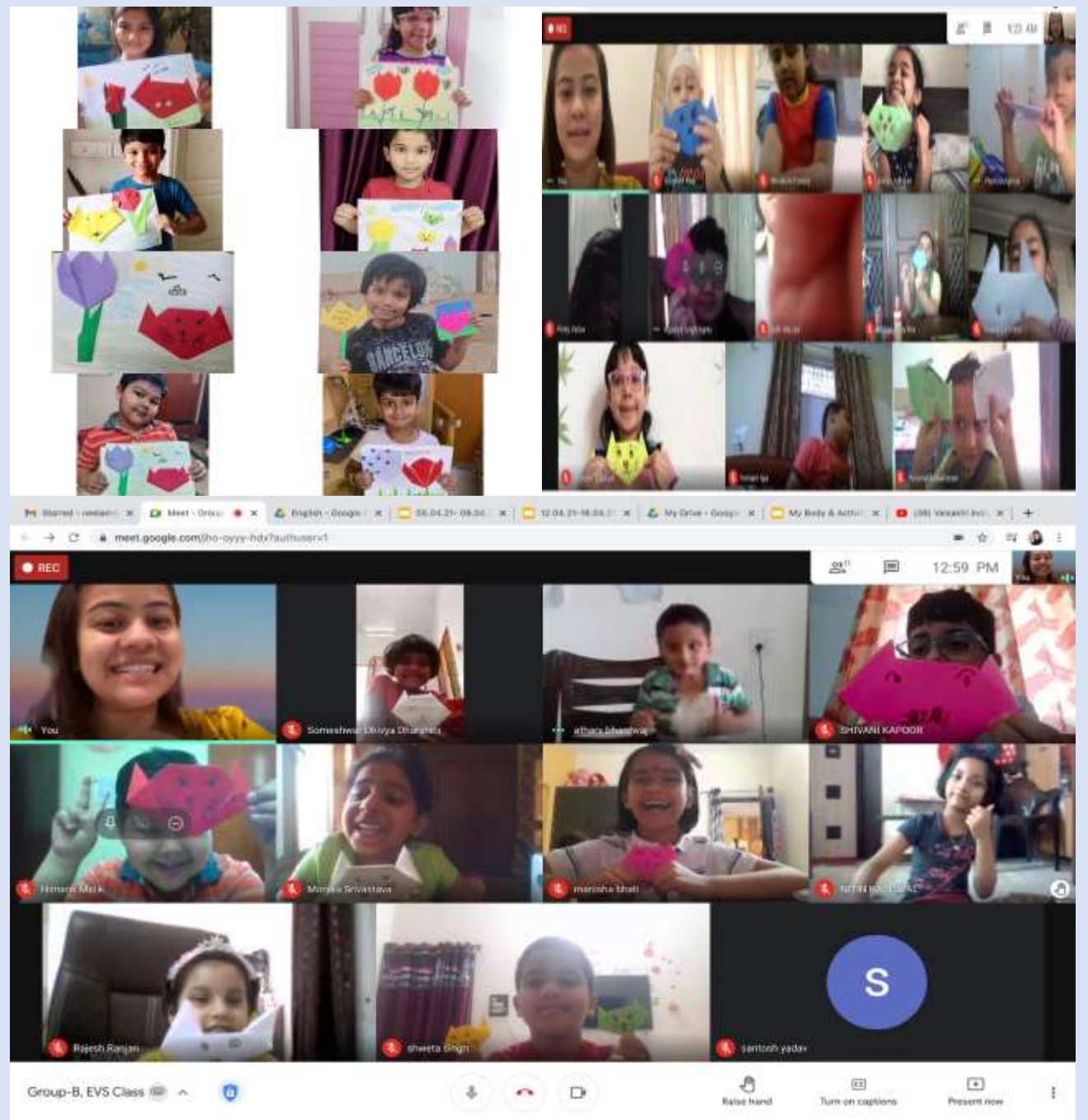
Students of class 2 learnt simple foot steps i.e. one beat one step. They also learnt a very small dance sequence and then applied these sequences on a story.





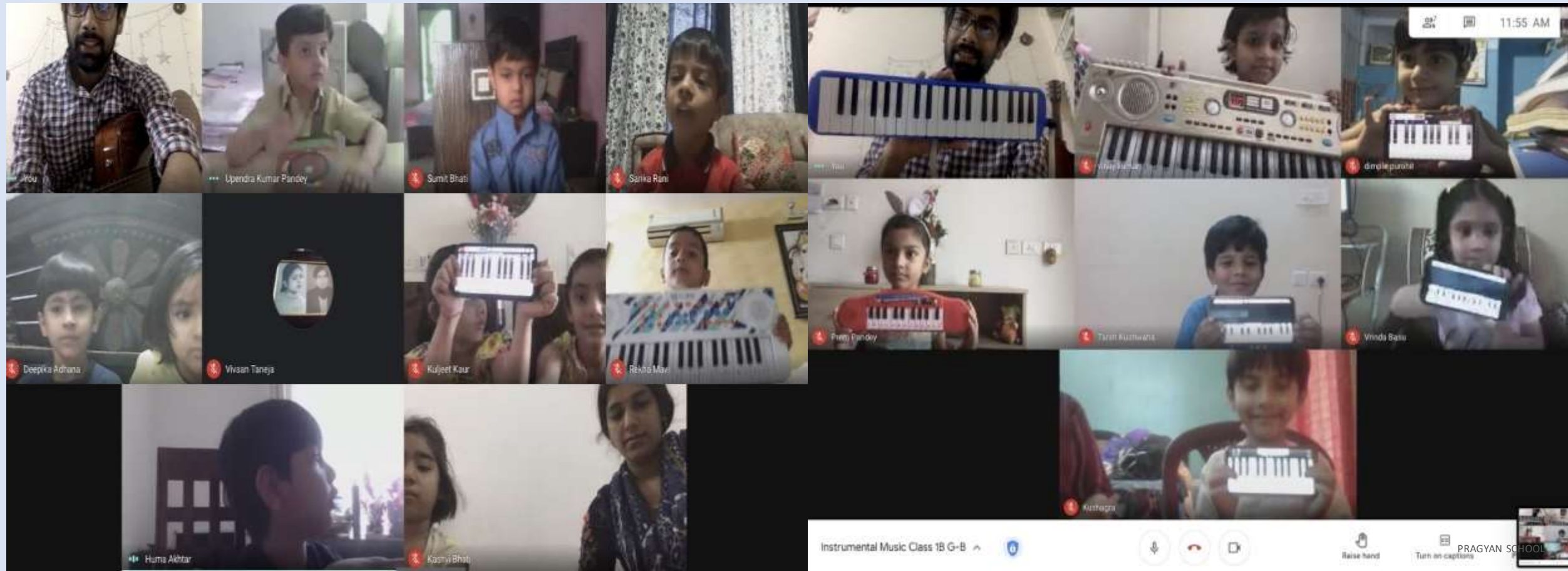
# ORIGAMI WITH SCENE

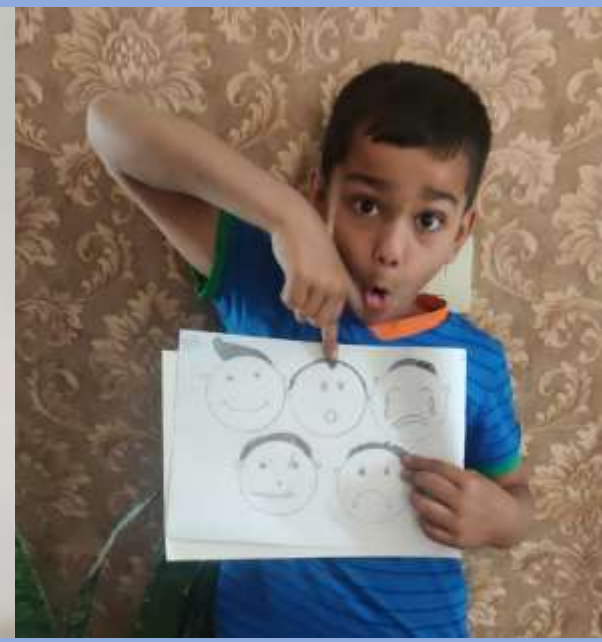
Students of class 3 enjoyed art integrated learning with Warli art and Mathematical book mark making activity.





# Grade 3 ART CLASS

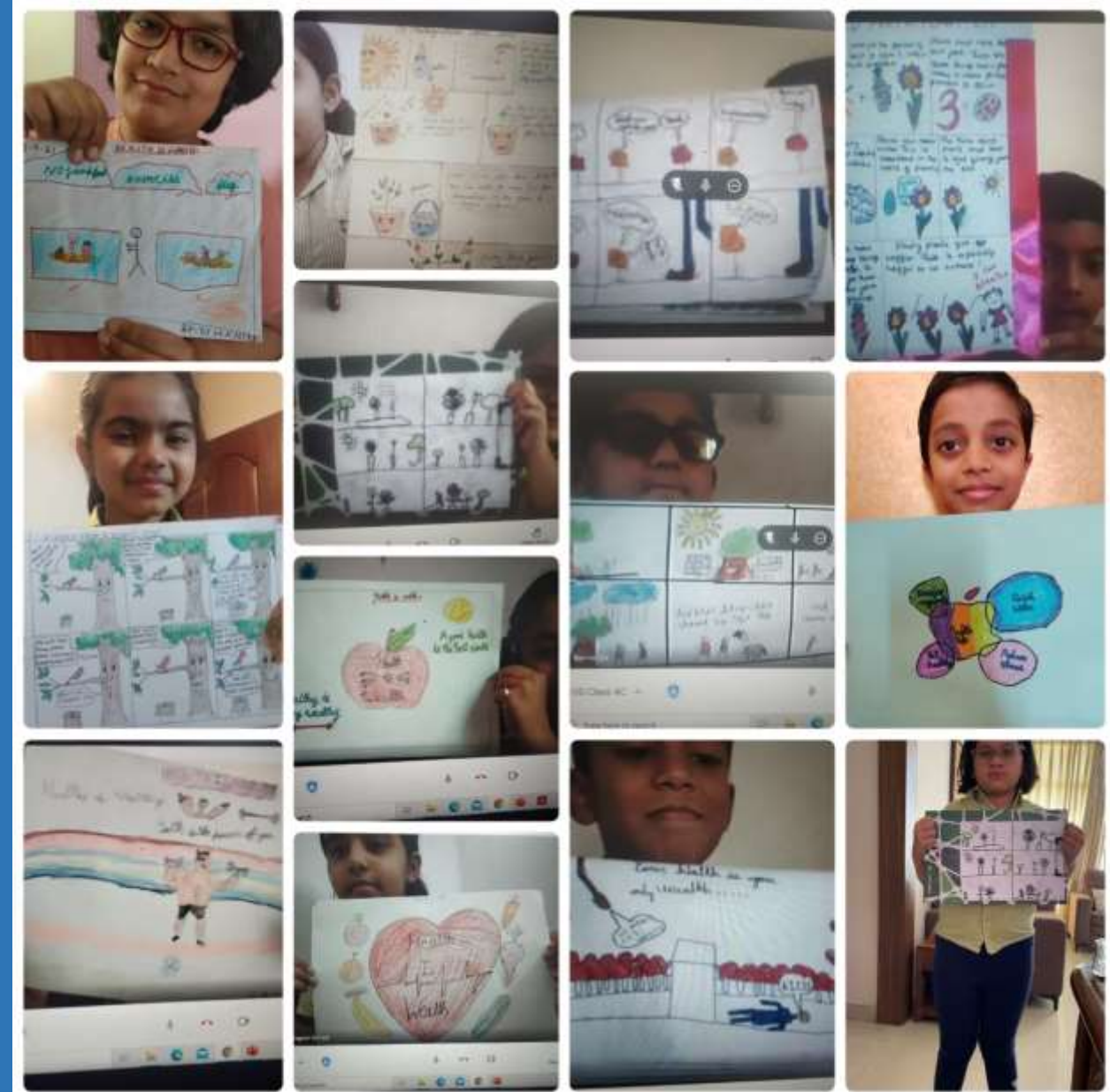
Students of class 3 had fun in learning about expressions through their art class. They enjoyed creating different expressions.





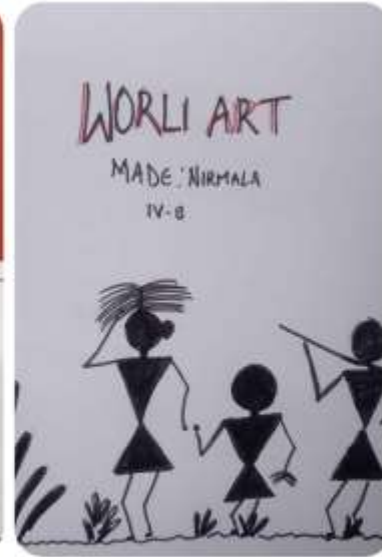
# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

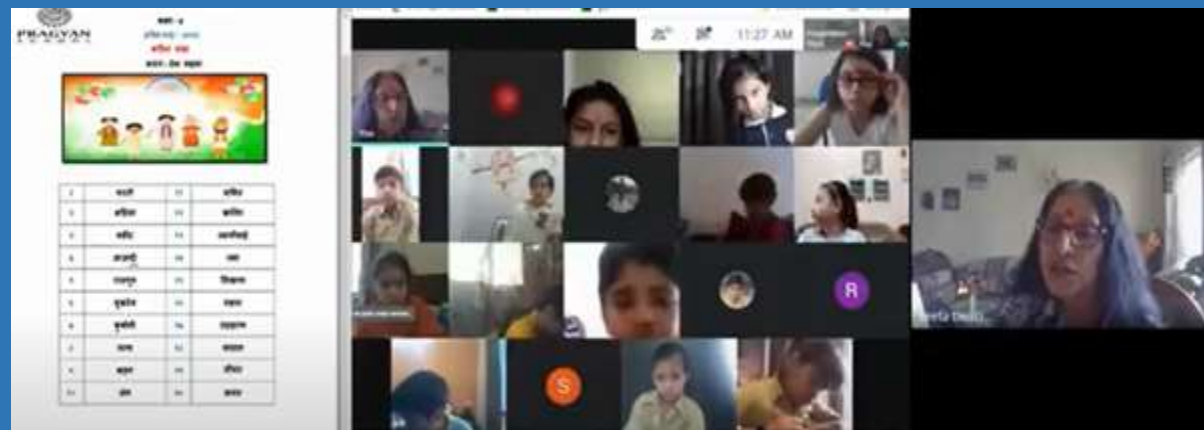


Class 4 students enjoyed Warli art activity during their math class. They used different geometrical shapes such as triangles, circles, squares, rectangles and lines to make Warli art.

# Grade 4 ART CLASS

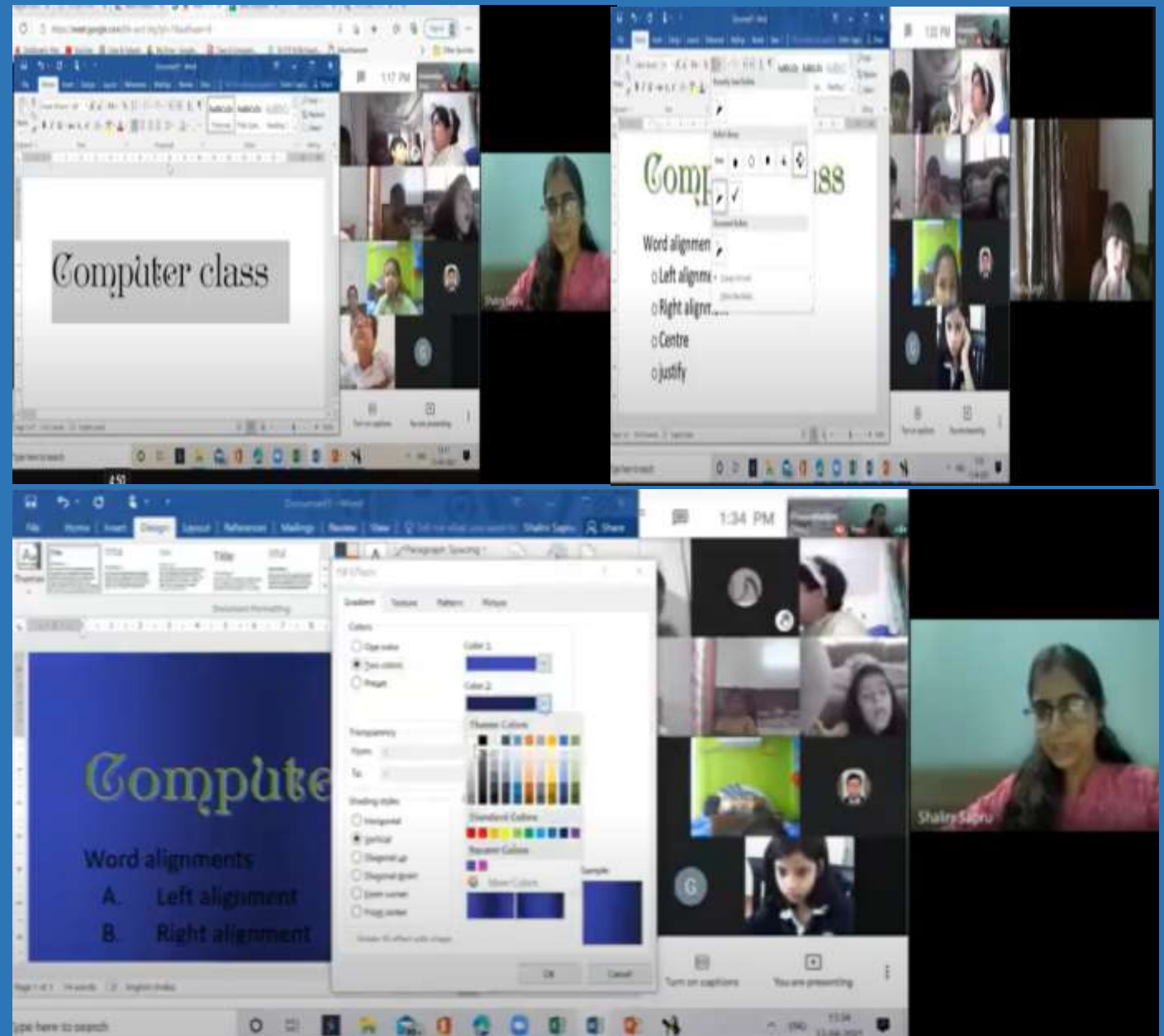


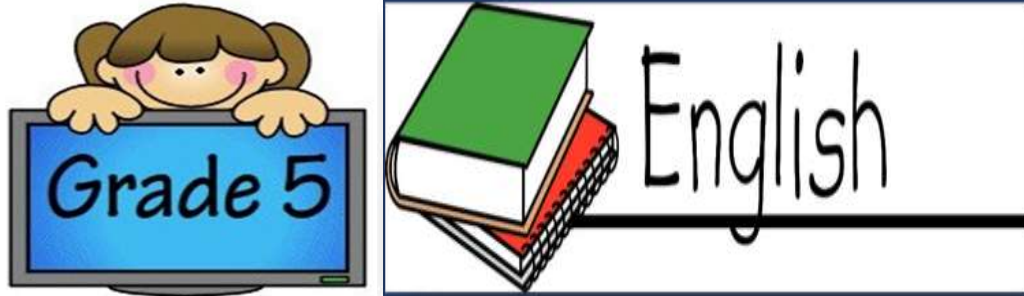
Students of class 4 learnt the technique to do shading using a stencil and they created single colour and rainbow colour hearts through it.



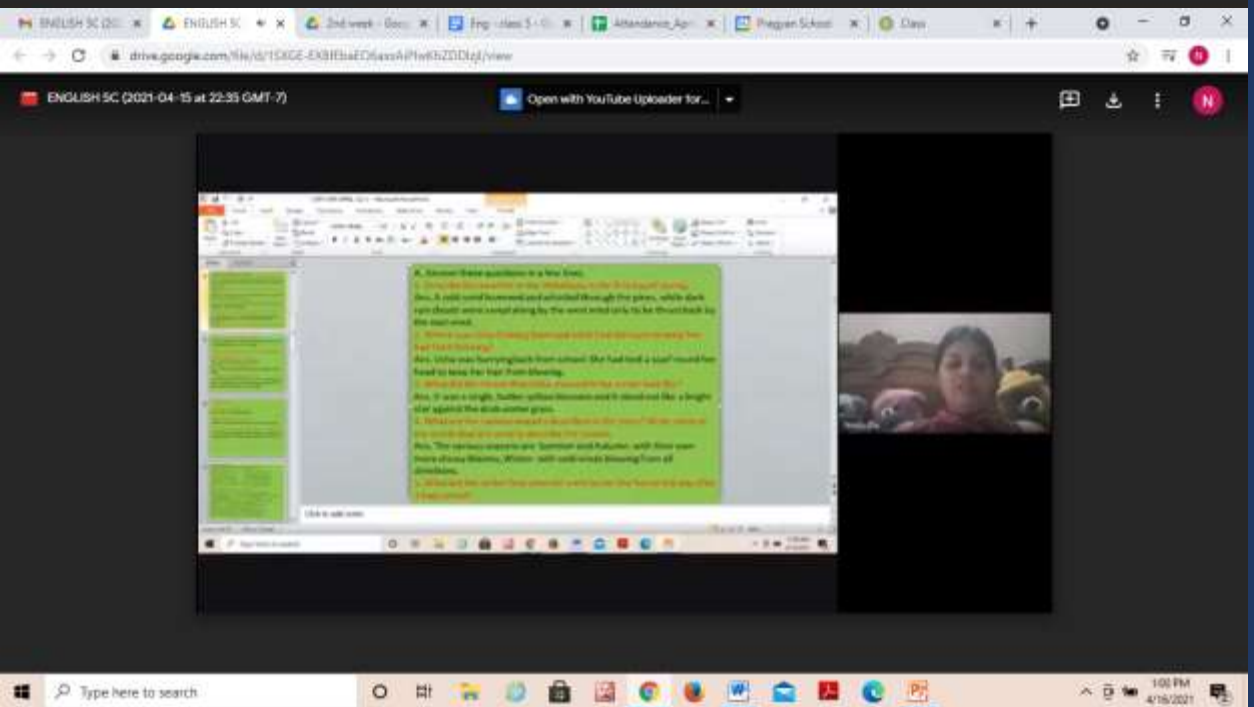
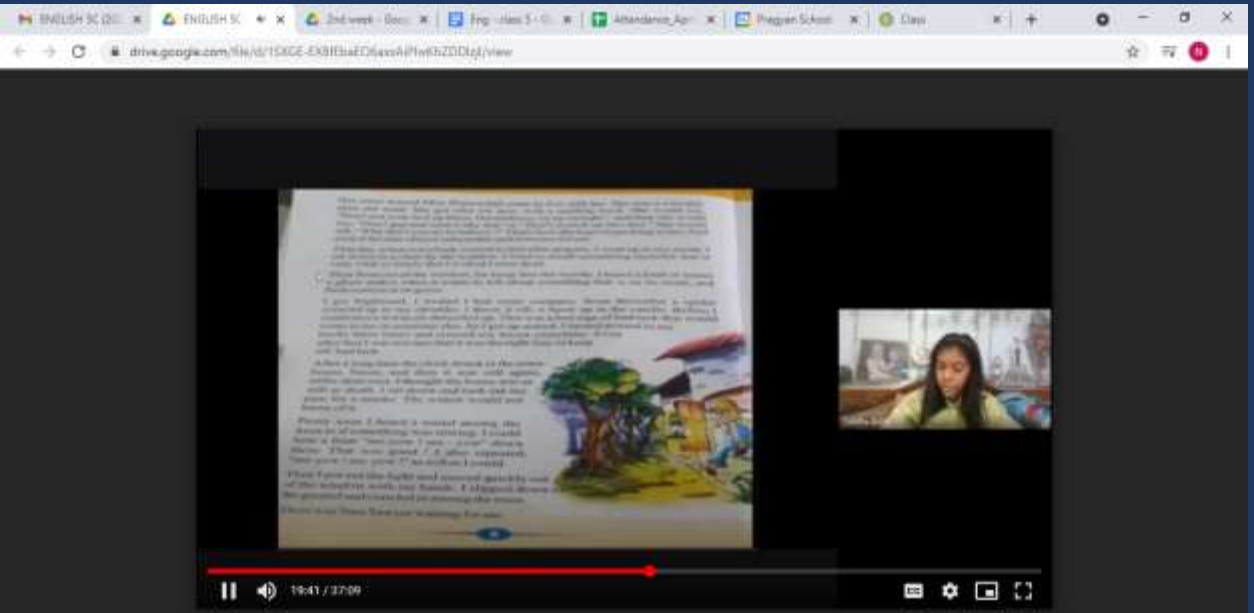

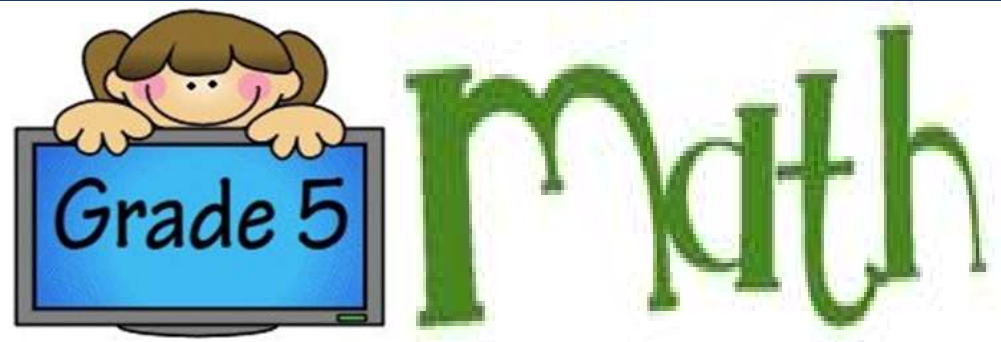




# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

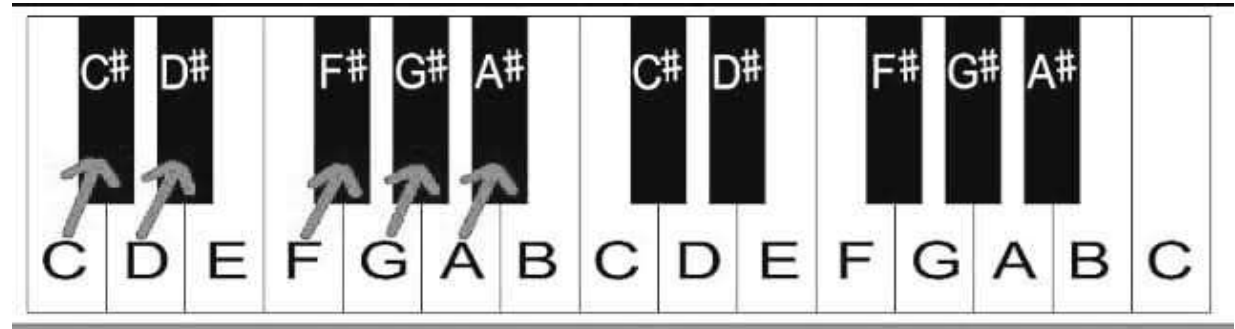


Students of class 5 enjoyed doing doodle art in a heart shape. They learnt to make patterns through it.

It was shared in the class that how one can be caring by doing small acts of kindness, being helpful and sharing. How compassion lies in lending ears to one in difficult times and wanting to help. The week concluded by invoking an awareness amongst the students about the environment around us, how we are interdependent on each other and the adverse effects of pollution on the environment which is creating a worsening situation for life on earth.
