NURSERY



ENGLISH

MATHS

ENGLISH

EASP (NUR & KG)

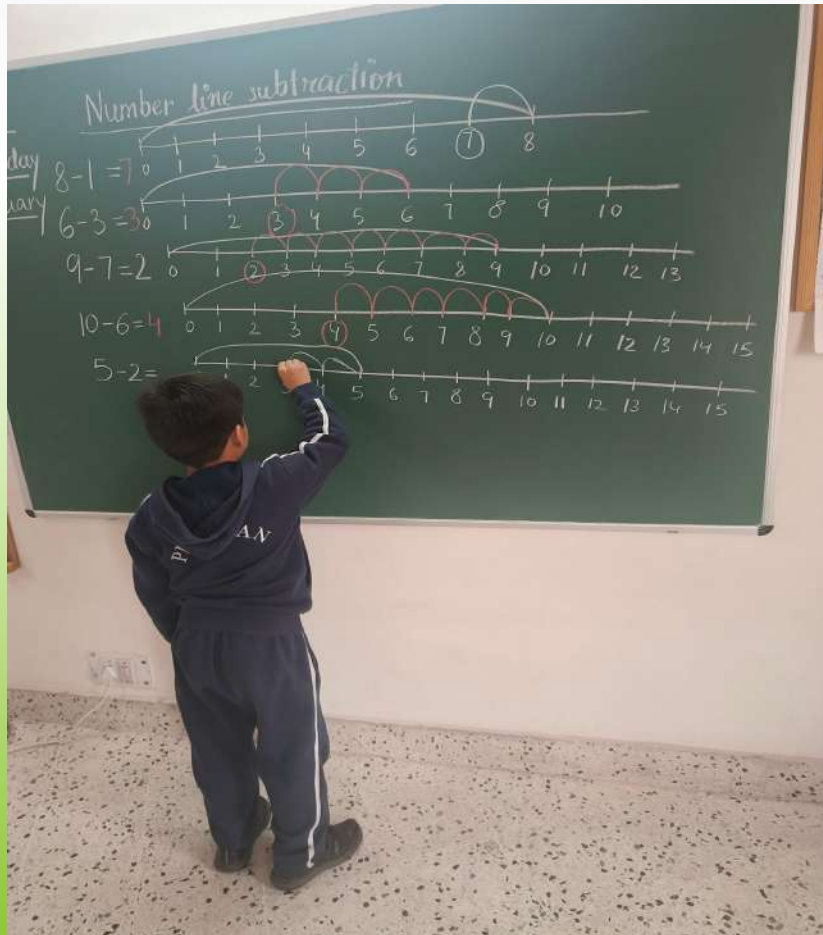

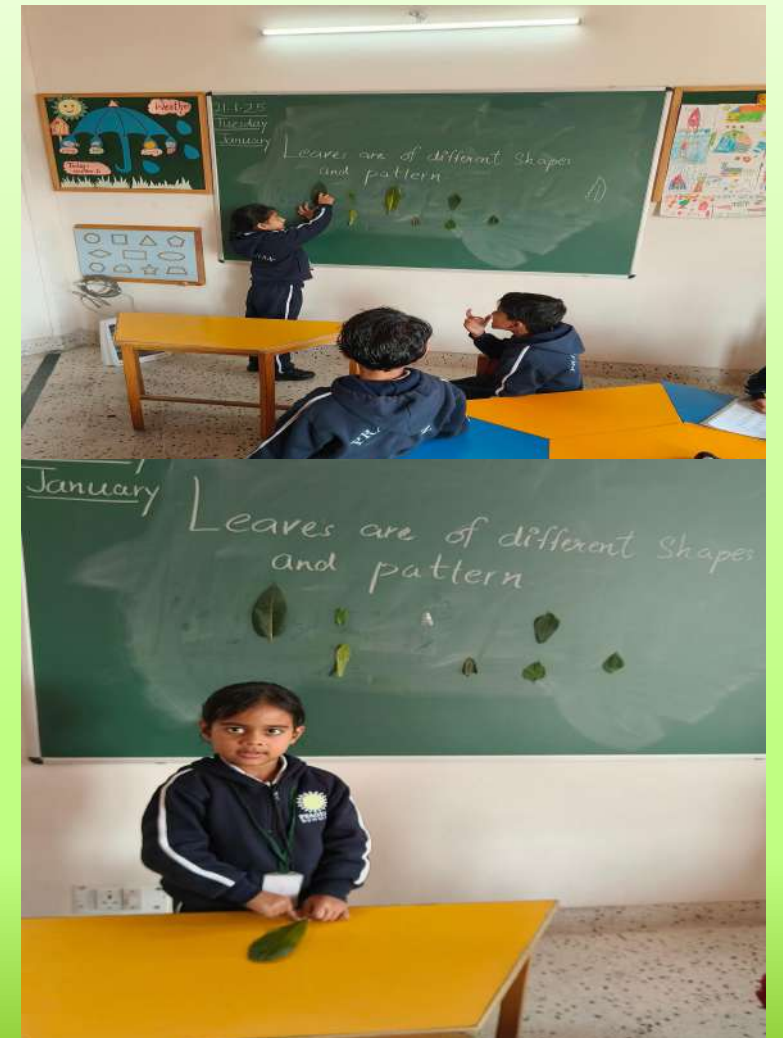
MATHS

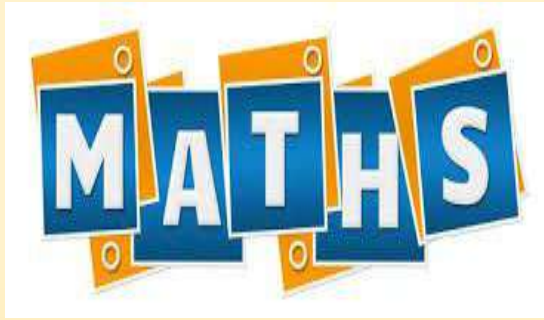




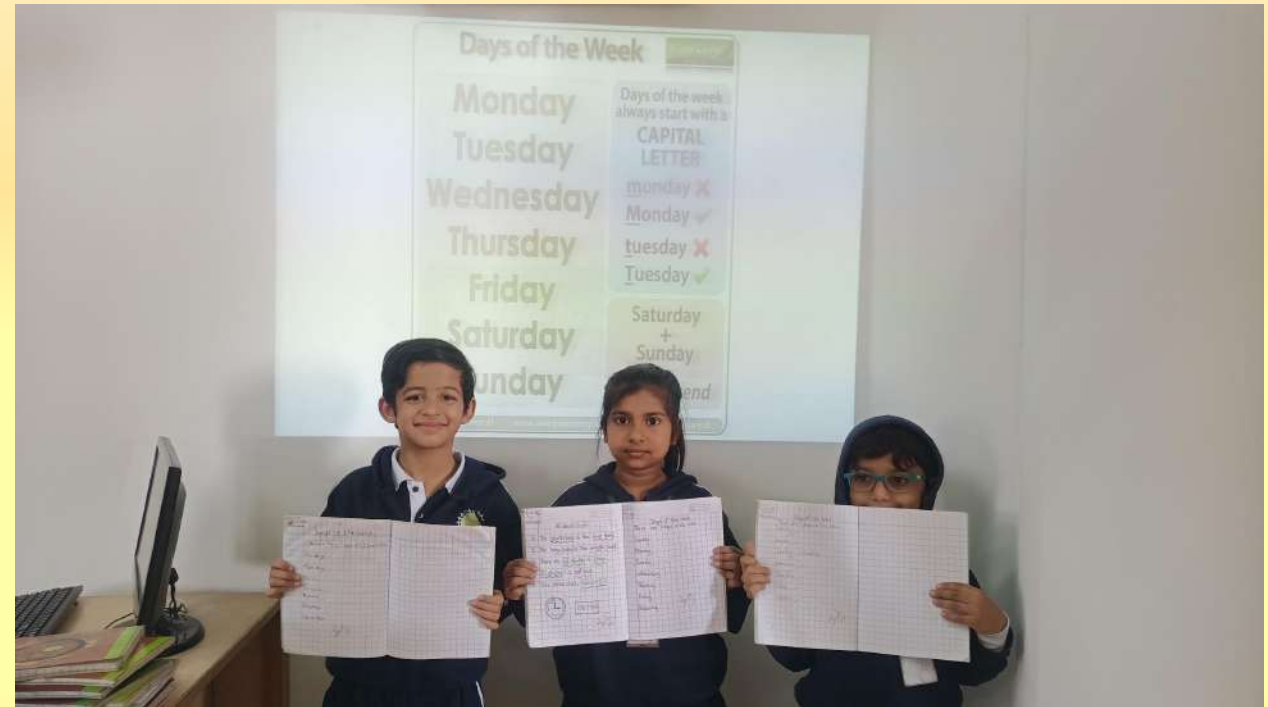
ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

They also had a discussion on the edible part of plants. Students also visited the school farm and gathered information related to various plants. Worksheets related to the chapter were also done in the class which includes application based questions related to the knowledge gained on the topic taught in the class. The chapter “Universe” was also introduced during the week.





This week, our Grade 2 students explored the exciting world of patterns. They were introduced to the concept of patterns and learned how they can be created using alphabets, numbers, shapes, and colors. WESTERN VOCAL CLUB

Turnips and beetroots get ready when their tops sprout out of the soil and are about 2–3 inches wide. They were shown how to gently pull them by their greens or loosen the soil with a garden fork to avoid breaking the roots, ensuring a fresh and clean harvest.

SCIENCE CLUB

The students of Science club went out for a nature walk in the school premises and they also explored the structure of a flower. They learnt about the different parts of the flower through a model of the structure of a flower. It was an enriching experience for the students of Science Club.
