NURSERY



ENGLISH

Students were engaged in A to Z writing practice and completed worksheets. Revision of all letters, phonics sounds, and letter formation was reinforced through letter skip and fill-in-the-correct-letter worksheets, enhancing their learning experience. These activities promoted phonetic awareness and vocabulary building.

MATHS

During the week, nursery students were introduced to the numbers 29 and 30 in Maths. They practised writing numbers from 0 to 30 and completed worksheets related to the new numbers. Revision of previously learned numbers was carried out along with activities on before and after numbers. Through engaging and hands-on activities, students strengthened their number recognition, sequencing skills.



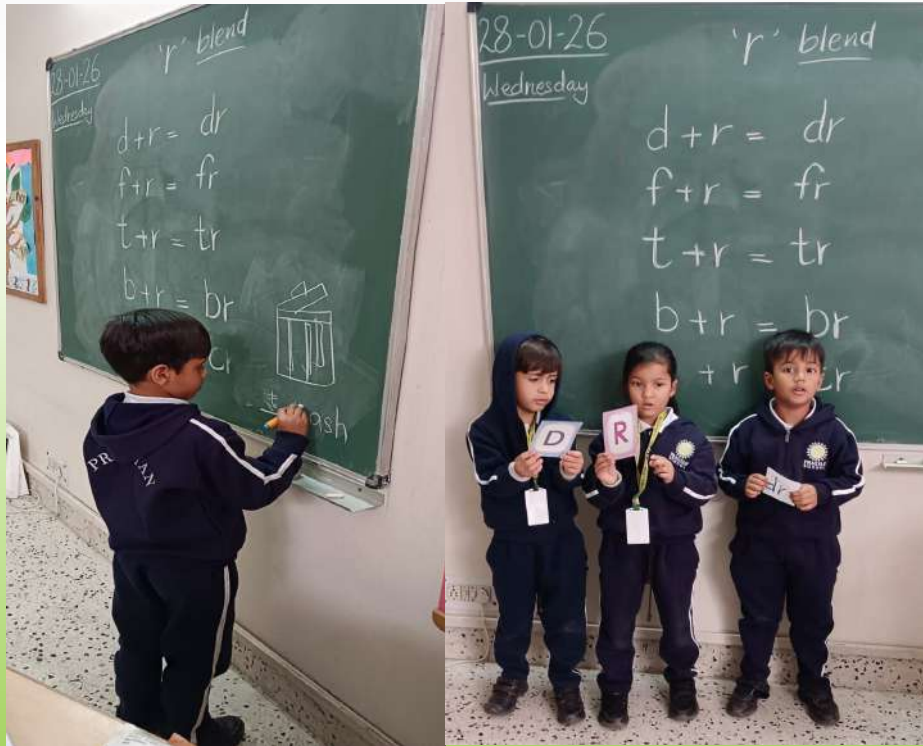
HINDI

In Hindi, students learned the letters स and ह. They explored and discussed words related to these letters and tried colouring worksheets based on them. Through recognition activities, children discovered new words and revised previously learned letters. Students participated enthusiastically, showing keen interest while improving their letter recognition, vocabulary, and pronunciation skills in an engaging and enjoyable learning environment.



KINDERGARTEN

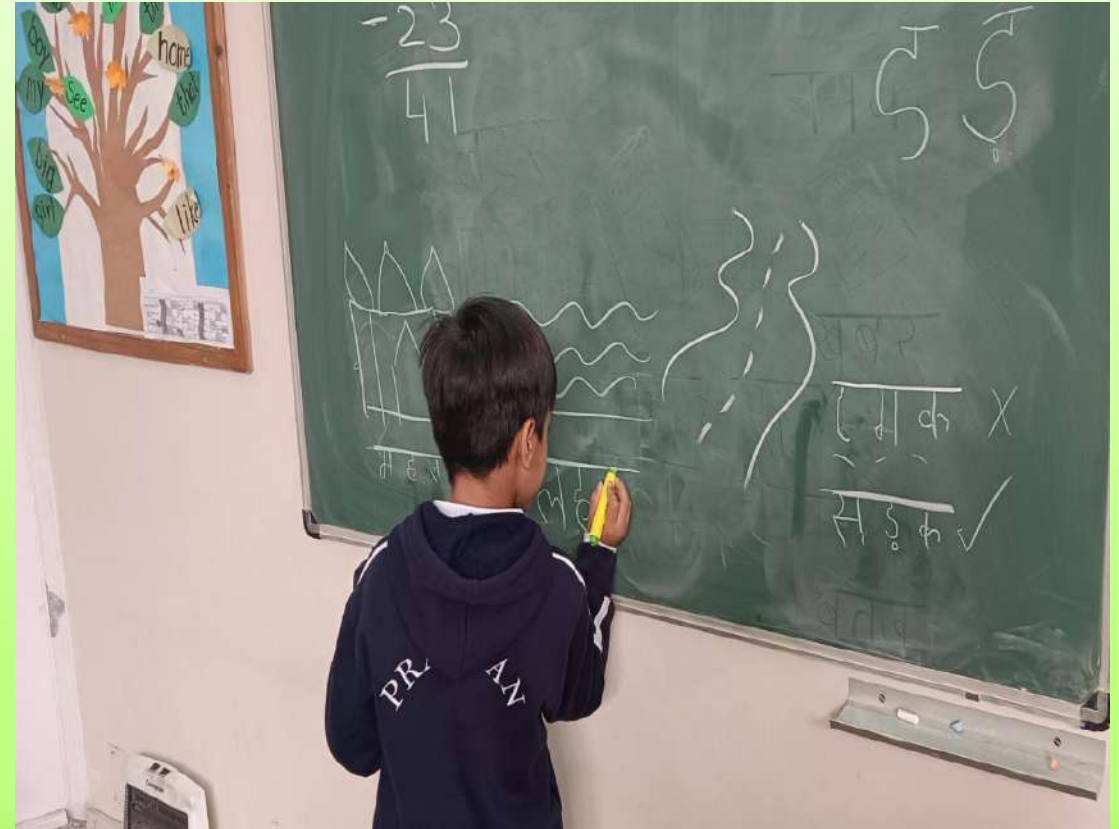
ENGLISH



During the literacy session, the children practiced R-blend words using flash cards and worksheets. This activity helped them improve their reading skills and recognize blended sounds with better clarity and confidence.

HINDI

The Hindi lesson focused on introducing the new vyanjan 'त्र' to the students. Along with this, they learned and practiced three-letter words through reading and writing activities, which helped improve their language skills and confidence.





ENGLISH

In English, the students did a worksheet related to picture composition. Each student was given a flash card and had to form three to four sentences based on the picture. This activity improved their sentence formation, vocabulary, and creative thinking skills. It also helped to develop their observation skills, imagination, and confidence in expressing ideas.

HINDI

In Hindi, the students learnt एक - अनेक through flash cards and were introduced to चित्र वर्णन, where they spoke a few lines in the given picture. This activity helped improve their speaking skills, vocabulary, and sentence formation. It also developed their confidence, observation skills, and clarity of speech. By expressing their thoughts, the students improved their understanding of the language and their communication skills.



MATHS

In Maths, the students practiced three-digit subtraction with regrouping on the board. Each child got a turn to solve a sum. This activity helped the students understand subtraction and regrouping better. It improved their place value knowledge and thinking skills. Solving sums on the board also helped the students become more careful and active in class.



GENERAL AWARENESS

In General Awareness, the students did worksheets related to the topic of clothes. A new topic, parts of plants and different types of plants, was introduced to the students. They also completed worksheets related to these topics. A discussion was held in which the students shared their views and talked about their observations on plants. This activity improved their awareness, observation skills.



JADUI PITARA

In Jadui Pitara, the students took part in different activities. In Hindi, the students picked a flash card from the box and spoke a few lines on it. In English, they picked a flash card and described it in three to four sentences. In Mathematics, the students took out number flash cards from the box and did two-digit addition with regrouping. In General Awareness, the students took out different clothes from the box and told which season the clothes were used in. These activities helped improve the students' speaking skills, confidence, thinking skills, and understanding of different subjects.



INTER CLASS ACTIVITY

An inter-class Origami activity was held on Wednesday, 27th January, 2026 where students beautifully showcased their creativity and fine motor skills. Nursery children delighted everyone by making simple origami objects like cats and tulips. Kindergarten students explored imagination by creating an underwater scene with fishes and boats, while Upper Kindergarten students designed a colourful garden scene using origami dogs, houses and tulips. The activity encouraged creativity, focus, and joyful learning across all classes. Students will soon be awarded with the certificates of merit.

GRANDPARENTS' & SPORTS DAY

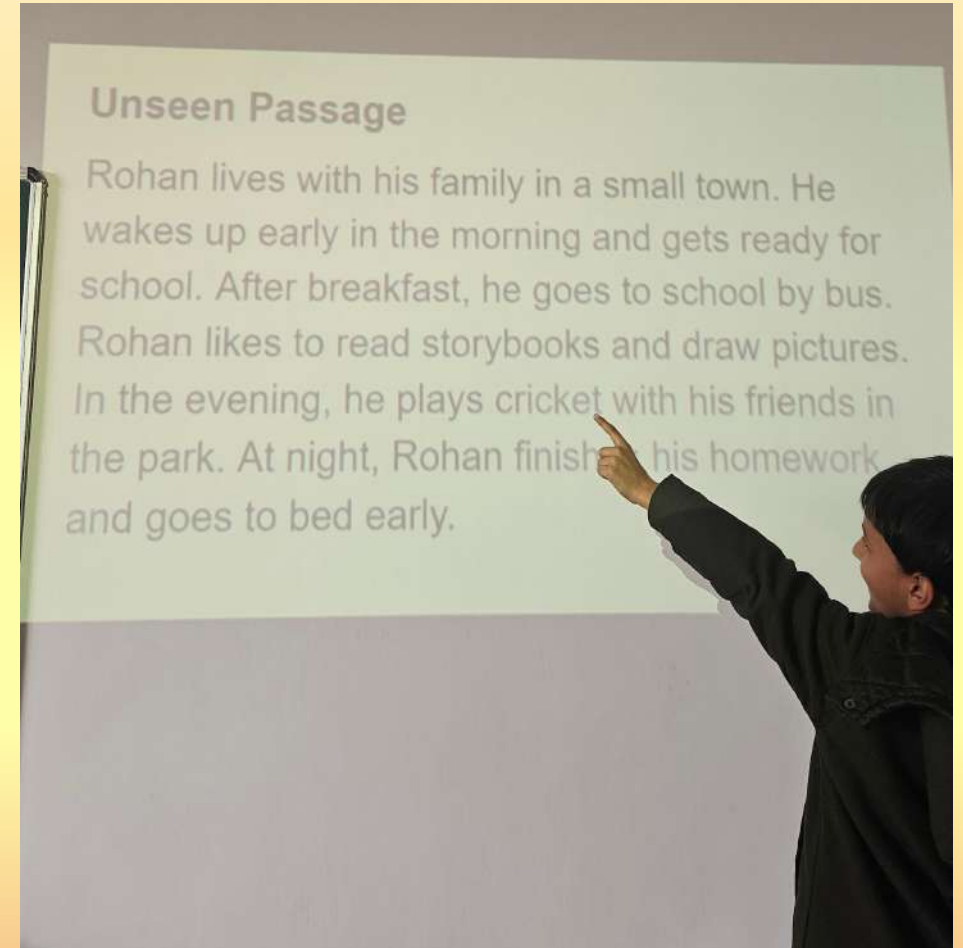

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Children of Class 1 revised Air, Water, and Weather, where children recalled the importance of air and water in daily life and discussed different types of weather through simple explanations and activities. Along with this, a revision of chapter Animals was also done, covering domestic and wild animals, their homes, and food habits. The revision helped reinforce concepts and improved the children's understanding in an engaging manner.





Children in Class 1 enjoyed learning shapes in the last week. During this period, an introduction to 2D and 3D shapes was done through explanations and examples from their surroundings. Children also completed related work in their notebooks and practiced workbook pages to reinforce their learning. 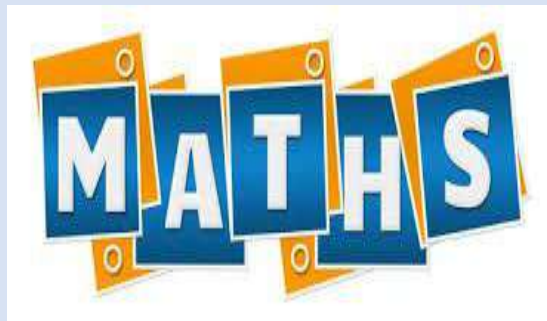
इस सप्ताह कक्षा में भाषा संबंधी गतिविधियाँ रुचिपूर्ण ढंग से कराई गईं। बच्चों ने माह की कविता “हमारे रंग-बिरंगे त्योहार” का सस्वर वाचन किया। अपनी शब्दावली को समृद्ध करने के लिए माह के नए शब्दों का अभ्यास कराया गया। सीखे गए शब्दों में से कुछ शब्दों का प्रयोग बच्चों ने अपने वाक्यों में भी किया। इसके साथ ही अनेक शब्दों के लिए एक शब्द लिखने का अभ्यास कराया गया। इन गतिविधियों से बच्चों की भाषा समझ और अभिव्यक्ति क्षमता में सुधार हुआ।





The chapter “Plants” was taught through detailed classroom discussions, supported by visual aids and interactive explanations to ensure a clear understanding of the concepts. To reinforce learning, students completed related worksheets, revising key ideas such as types of plants, parts of a plant, their functions, and the things we get from plants. In addition, the students visited the school garden, where they explored and identified different types of plants such as herbs, shrubs, and trees, making learning more practical and engaging.





This week, the students of Class II revised the topic “Metric Measures” during the class. The purpose of the revision was to reinforce the concepts already taught and help students gain confidence in using standard units of measurement related to length, weight, and capacity, along with their units (cm, m, g, kg, and L). The revision sessions included oral work, written practice, and classroom activities, making the learning process engaging and meaningful.





The students of Class 2 revised the New Words of the Month and practised the Poem of the Month with rhythm and expression. They also revised prepositions through notebook work to strengthen their understanding of sentence structure.

To further enhance reading skills, the students are now being guided towards comprehension, where they independently read the passages, understand the text, and attempt to answer the questions on their own. This step has helped build confidence, focus, and independent thinking among the learners.



VOCAL MUSIC



This week, during the music class, the students of Classes 1 & 2 were taught the first, second, and third verses of the song “Hum Honge Kamyab.” The session was filled with positivity and musical energy. The children participated actively, followed the rhythm and lyrics with keen interest, and sang with great enthusiasm and confidence, making the class lively and joyful.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)

Children of classes 1 and 2 participated in games activities last week. The session focused on the importance of regular exercise for staying healthy and active. Children also took part in an Obstacle Race, which helped improve their physical fitness, coordination, balance, and team spirit. The activities were conducted in a fun and safe manner, encouraging active participation from all students.

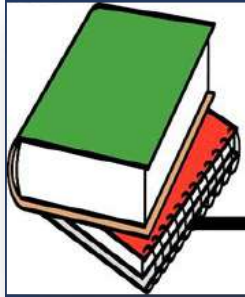




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

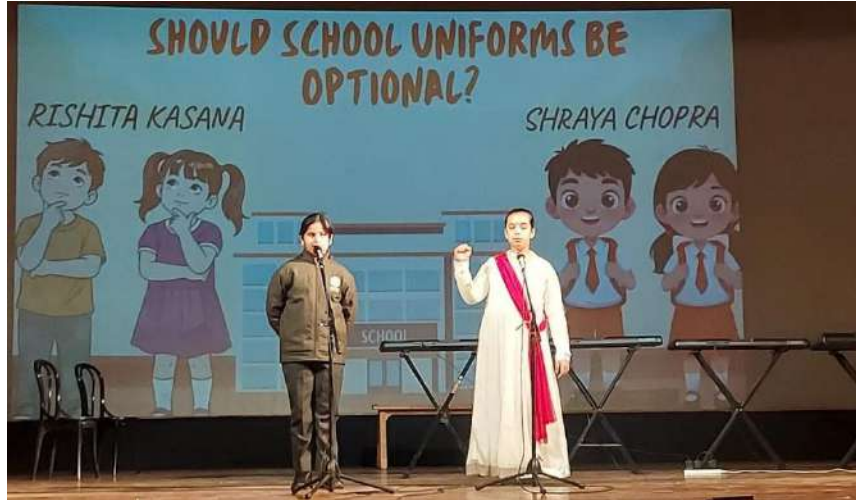
