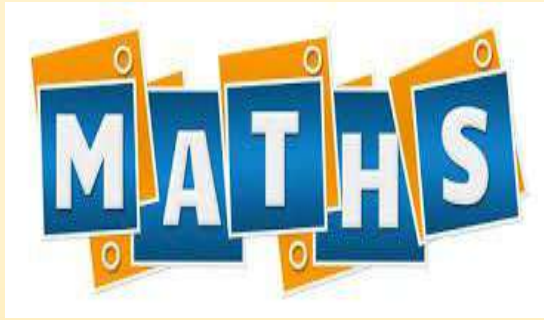




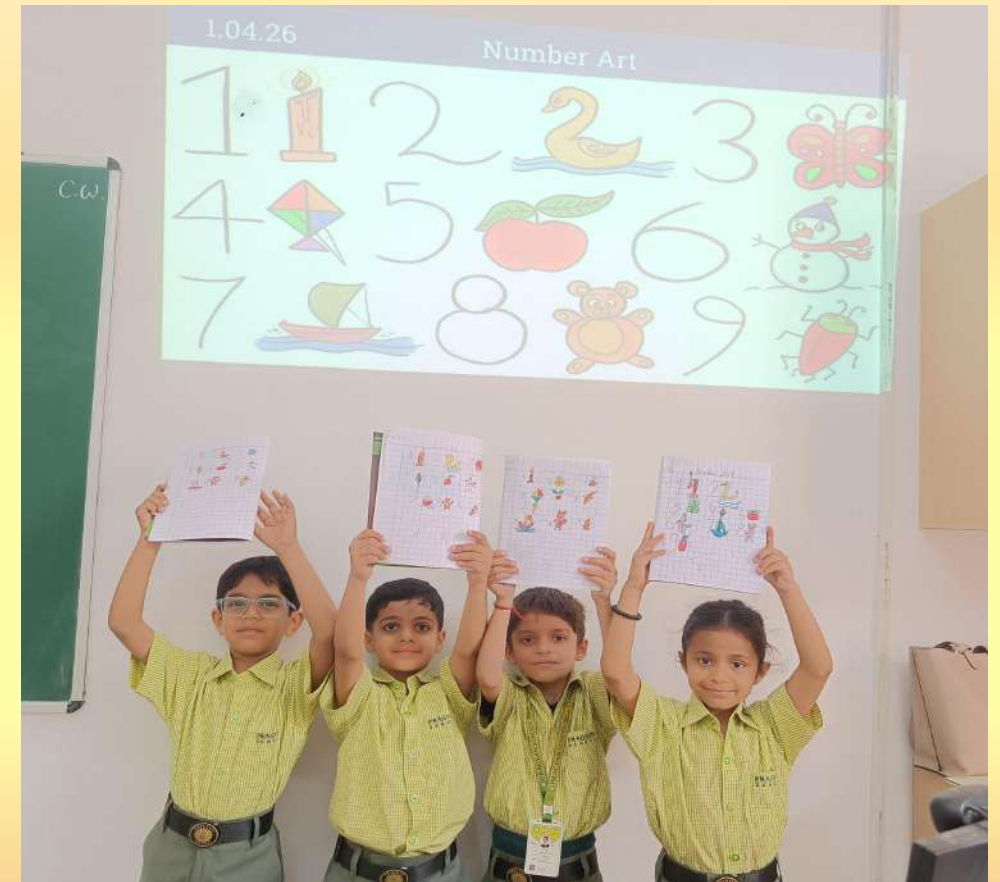
ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

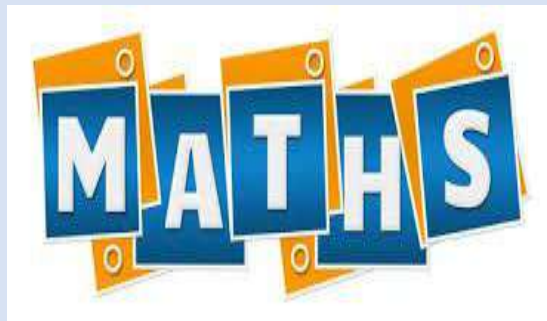

COMPUTER (1&2)



Students of class 1 were introduced to the basics of using a computer. They thoroughly enjoyed a fun activity in the GCompris software, where they practiced move the mouse activity.

Students of class 2 were introduced to creative tools in Tux Paint. They explored the Waves and Wavelets feature, which allowed them to experiment with digital art in an engaging and imaginative way.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)

This week, students of Classes 1 and 2 actively participated in Physical Education activities, including regular exercises, running, and obstacle training. These sessions helped enhance their physical fitness, stamina, and balance. The students performed all activities with great enthusiasm and also displayed good teamwork and coordination.



LIBRARY (1 & 2)

Books play a vital role in shaping young minds with knowledge, imagination, and wisdom. To nurture a love for reading, students of Class 2 visited the school library, where their eyes sparkled with curiosity and excitement as they explored books of their choice. They also practised reading aloud, which helped improve their understanding and pronunciation.

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The students of class 3 revised the concepts of living and non living things and were guided based on their basic awareness of plants, animals and things around them. A discussion based activity was held in the class which emphasized the importance of taking care of our Mother Earth. Students also drew beautiful posters related to the theme in their notebooks.

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

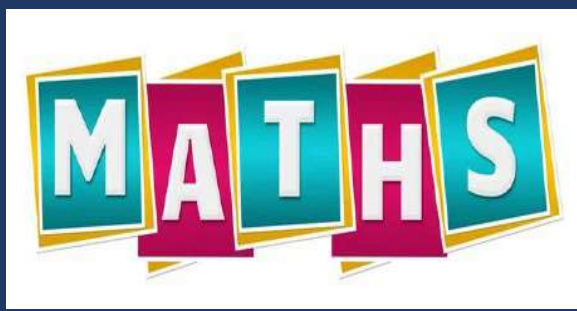




हिन्दी
