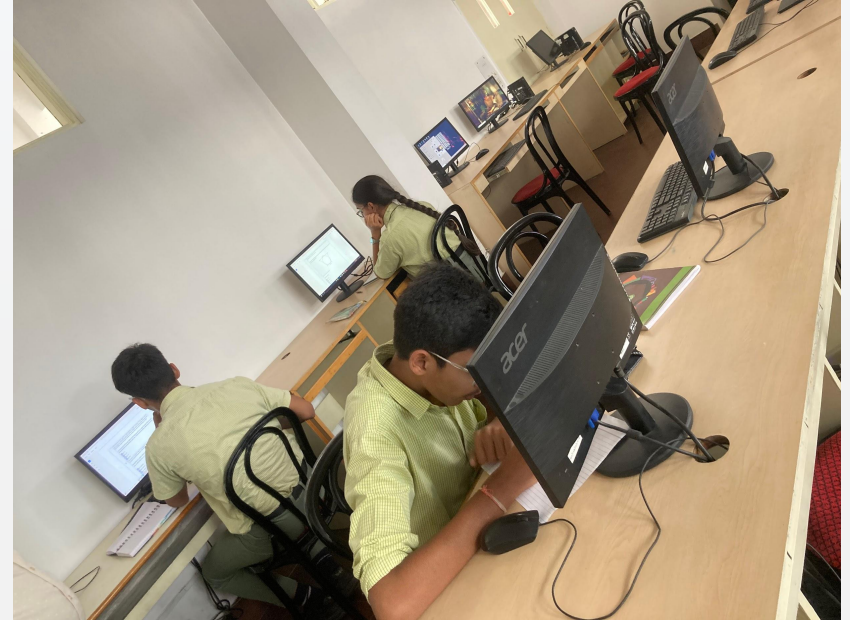
ATL SESSION VI
