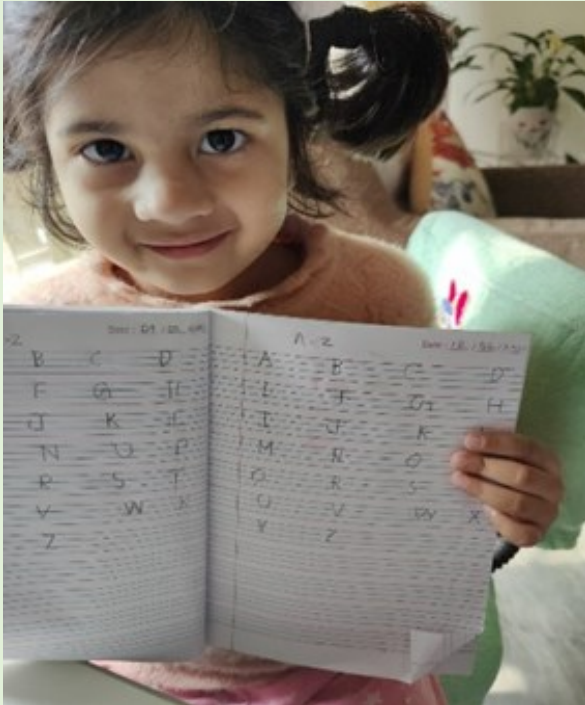

General Awareness- Revision of home and shelter was done in the class.

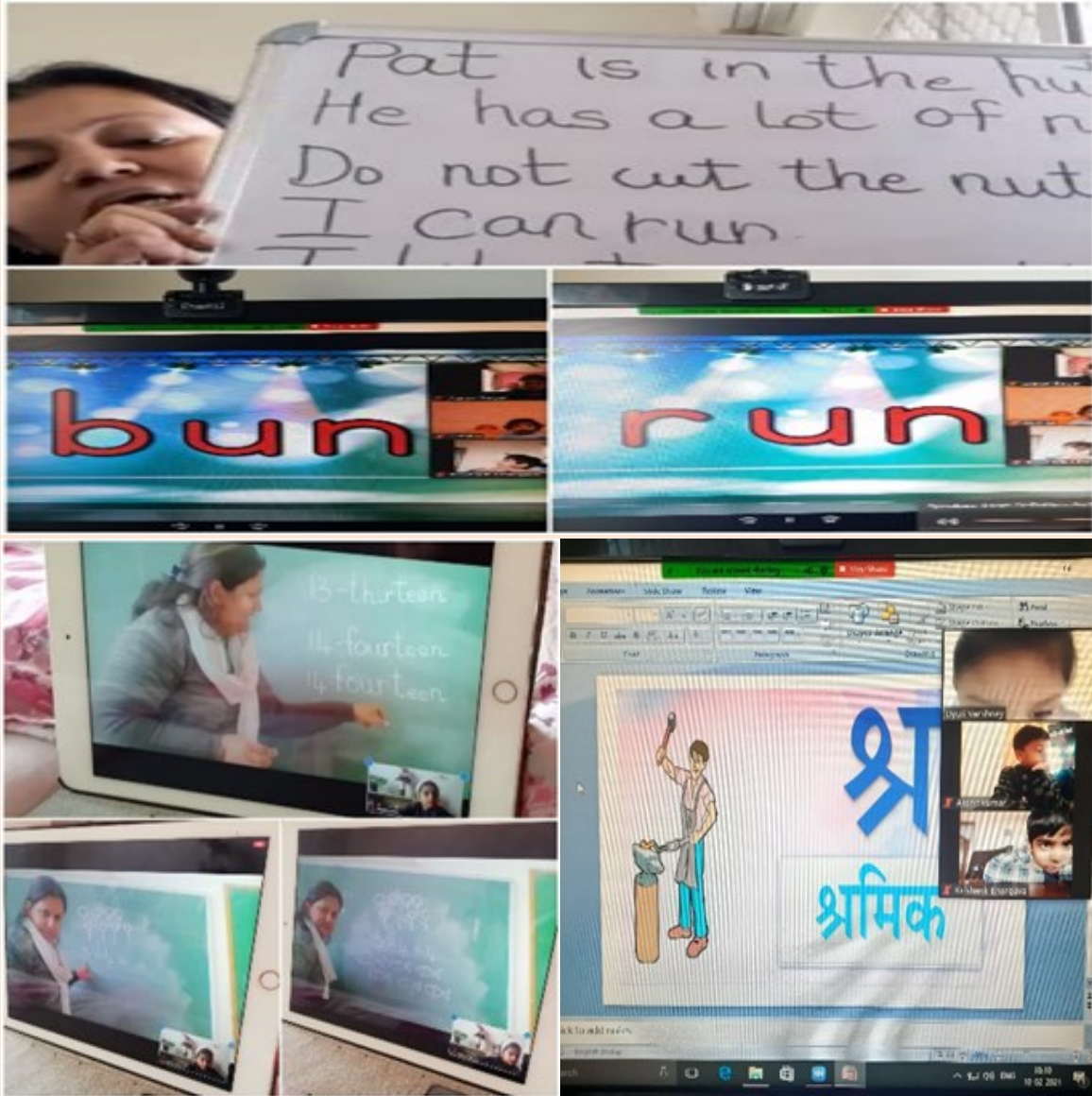
**EVS** -Revision of 'ostrich' and 'Parrot' was done in the class.

**Fitness** - Running around bowling pin, zig zag running, double leg side ward jump, sideward jogging, double leg jump and double leg hop were done in the class.

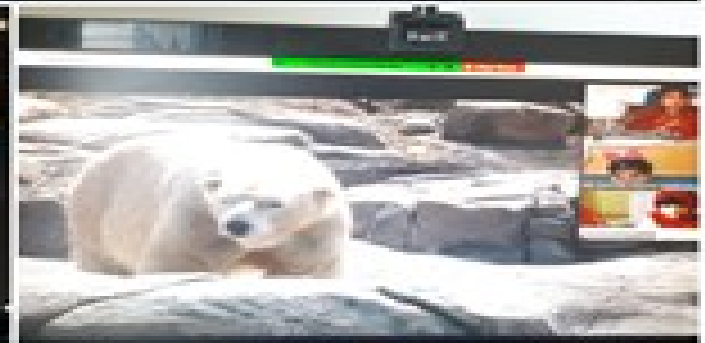
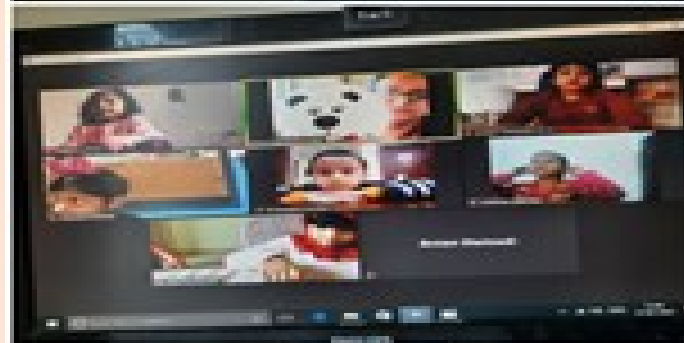
# KINDERGARTEN

Music - Students enjoyed singing patriotic "ped lagao "song "in the class .





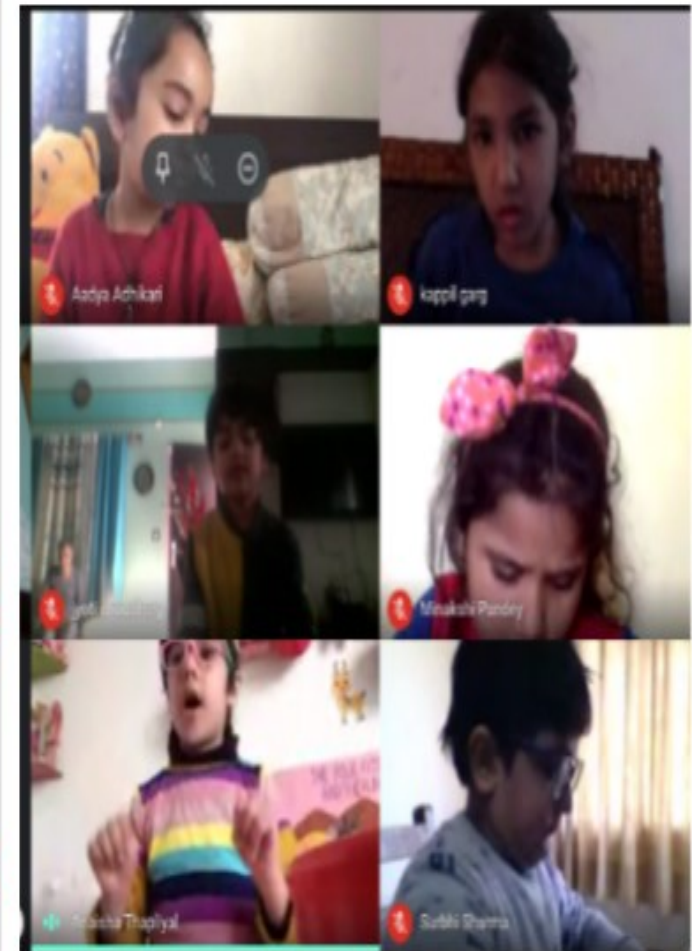
Class 1 students were introduced with Poem of the month - Sea Song during their english class. Students enjoyed learning and singing the song with proper pronunciation and modulation.

sacrifices of their parents.

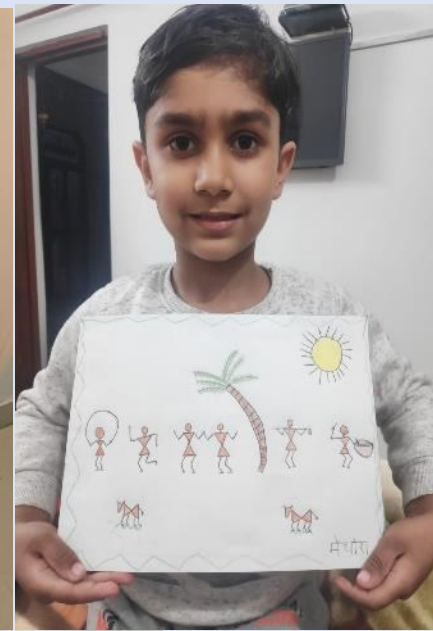
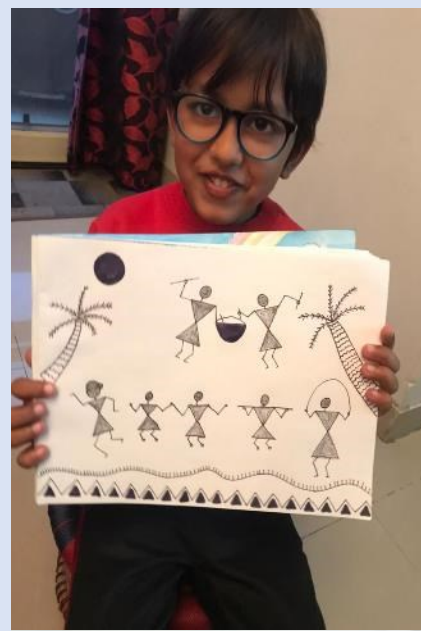




Students of class 2D enthusiastically drew a snowman and they did paper tearing and pasting activity in it using white and coloured papers. They enjoyed this activity a lot.

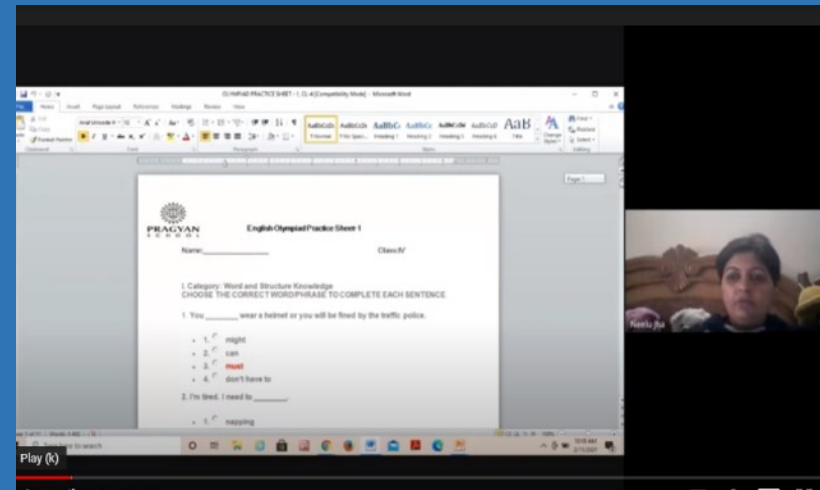
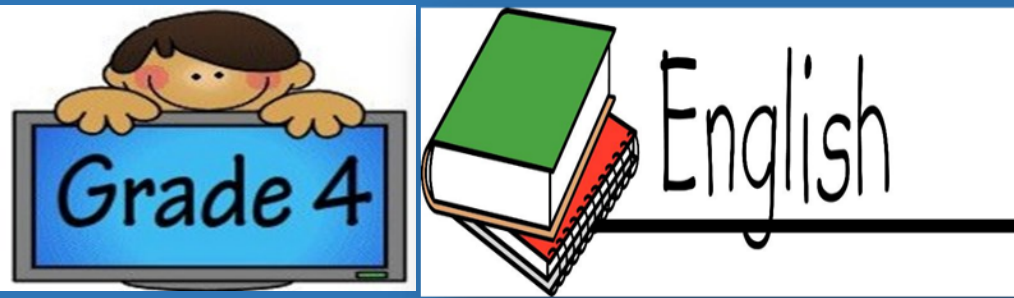




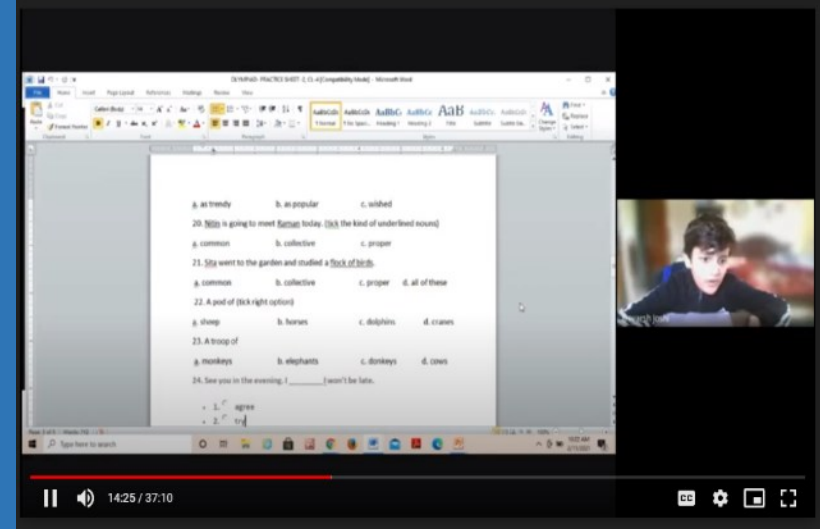
# Grade 3 ENVIRONMENT SCIENCE

Inge: It is drawing me down! Help me! Help me!

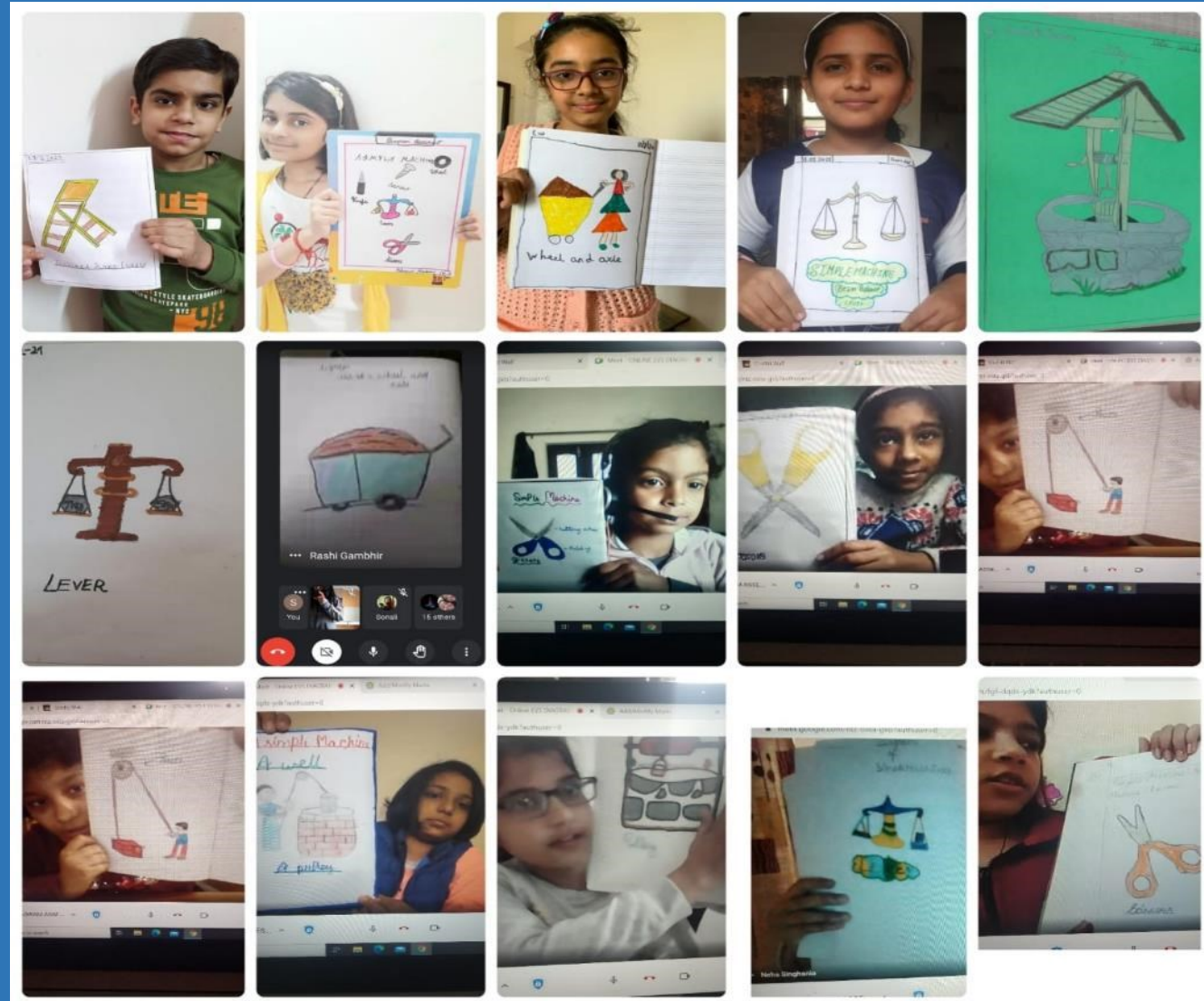

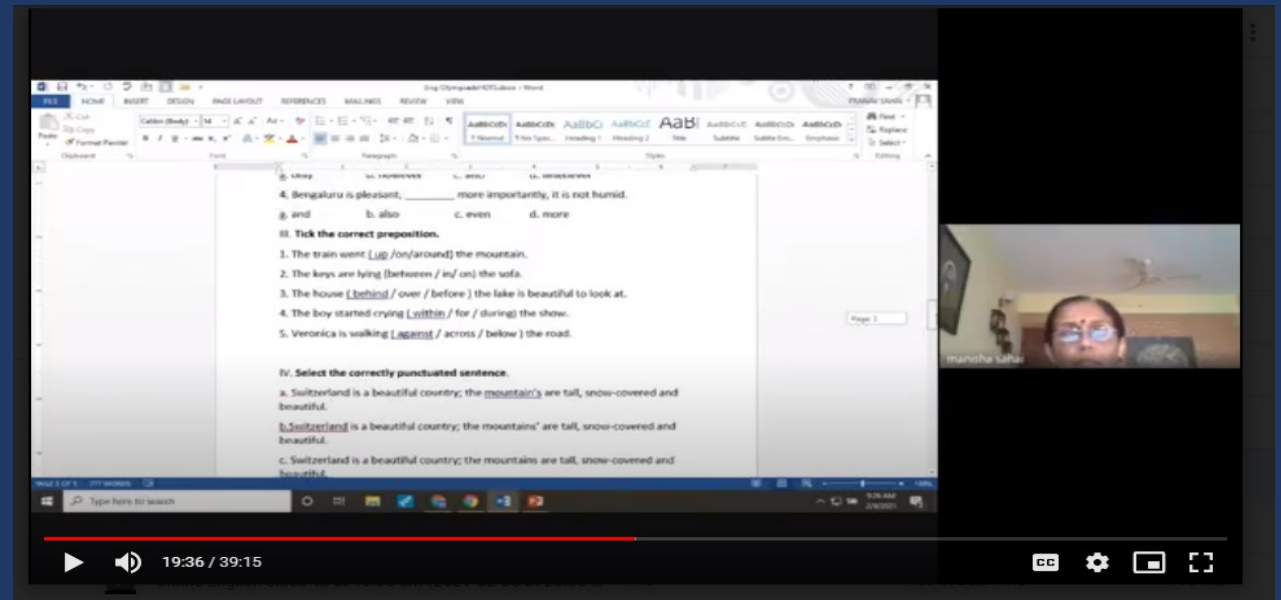
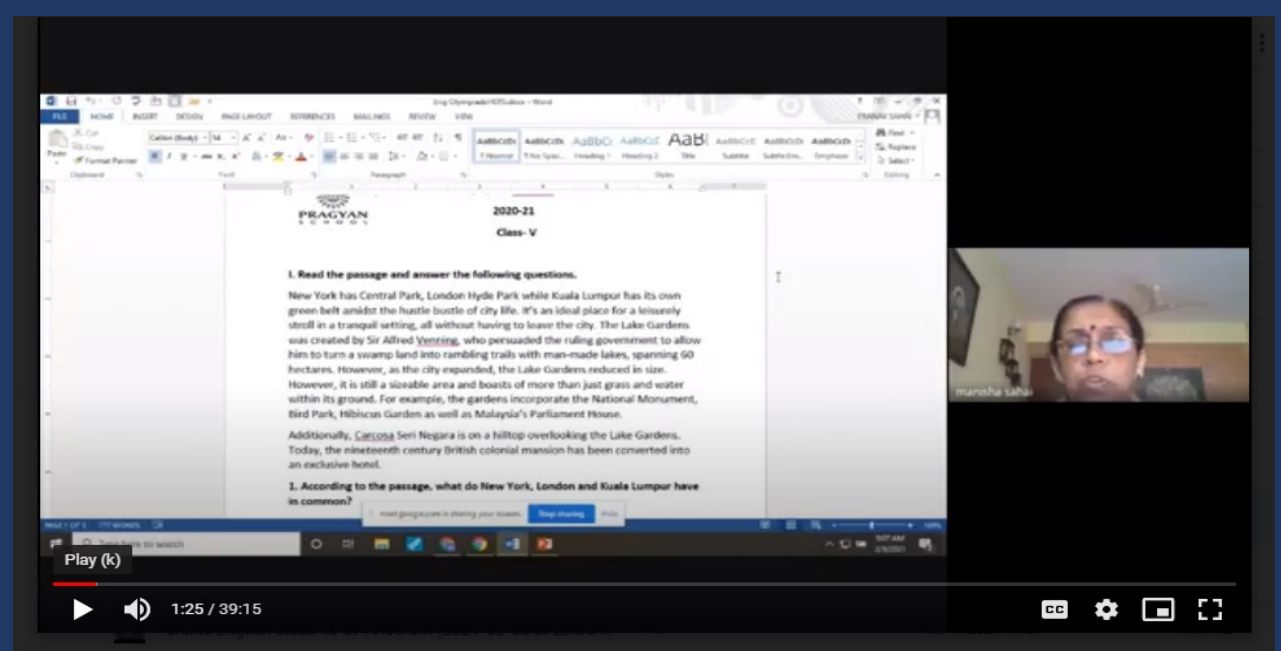


Students of class 4 had the assessments of Hindi Writing Skill and reading. They also revised the poem and difficult words for their next assessments.

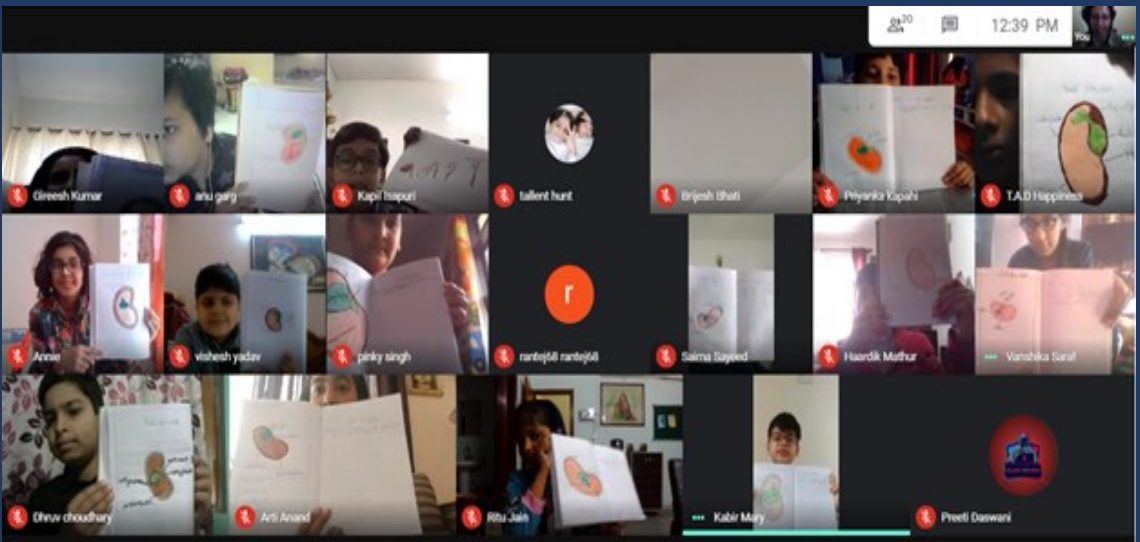

# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

With the ongoing SA2 assessment cycle, EVS Orals and EVS Diagram assessment was conducted this week. The students were also introduced to the concept of seed dispersal and its importance was discussed in the online class. The five agents of dispersal- wind, water, animals, explosion and gravity were also explained citing various examples. Videos related to the concepts taught were shown to strengthen the understanding. As part of written work, students were made to write the difficult words of the lesson and oral revision was also taken as part of the recapitulation.






**L-20: How Do Plants Reproduce?**

**Wind Dispersal:**

- Some seeds that are very light in weight are carried away from the parent plant by the wind. These include orchid and poppy seeds.
- Some seeds, such as dandelion, have hair-like growths that catch the wind and help carry the seeds away from the parent plant.

**Water Dispersal:**

- Some seeds are hollow and filled with air and they get carried away by water. These include coconut and palm seeds.

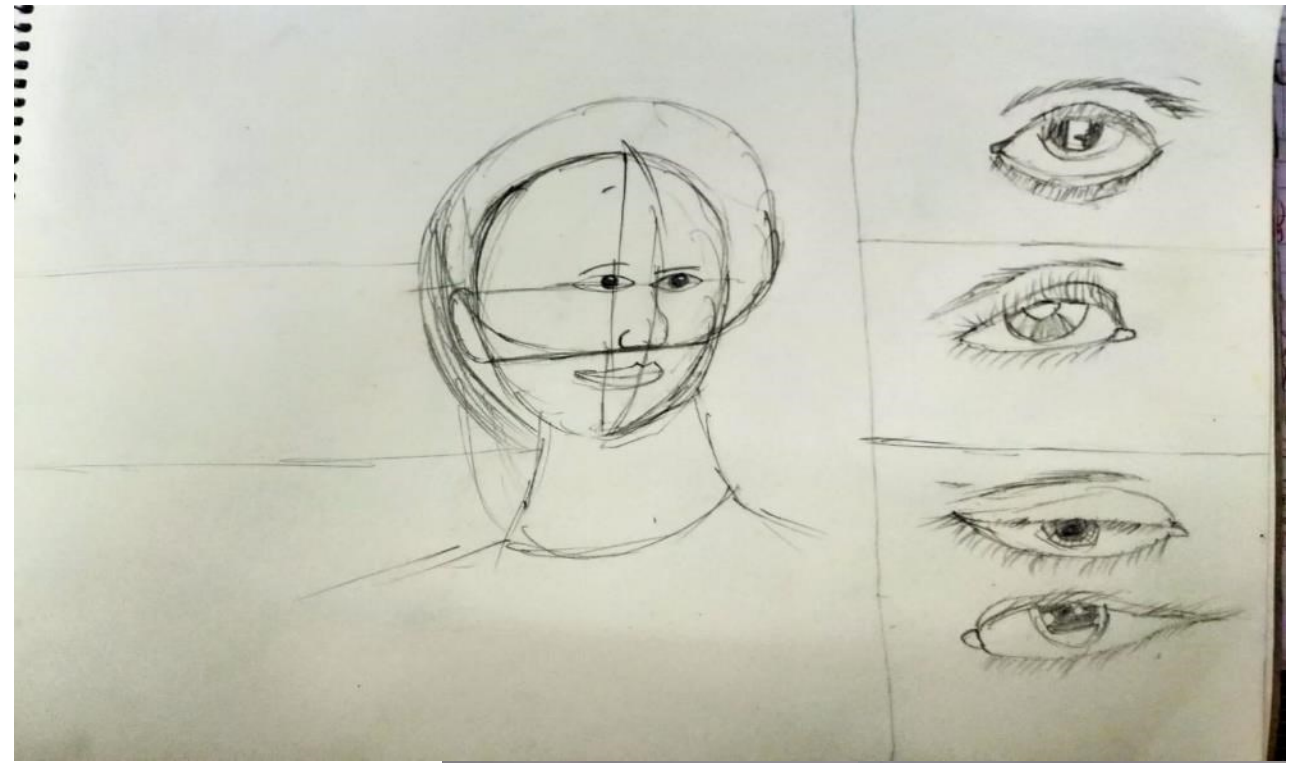

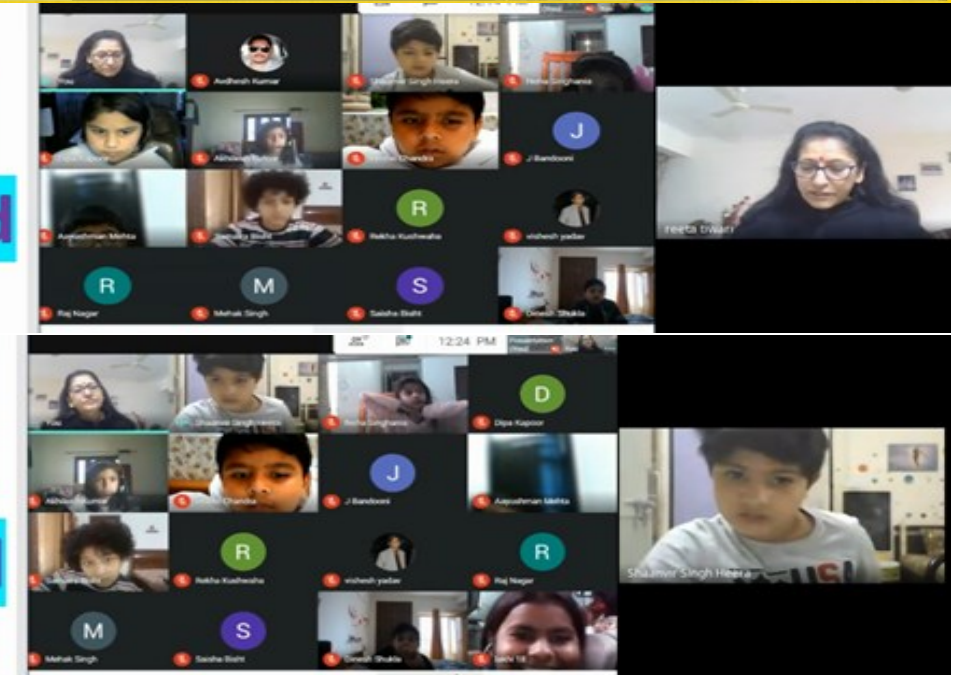
# COLLABORATIVE SESSION

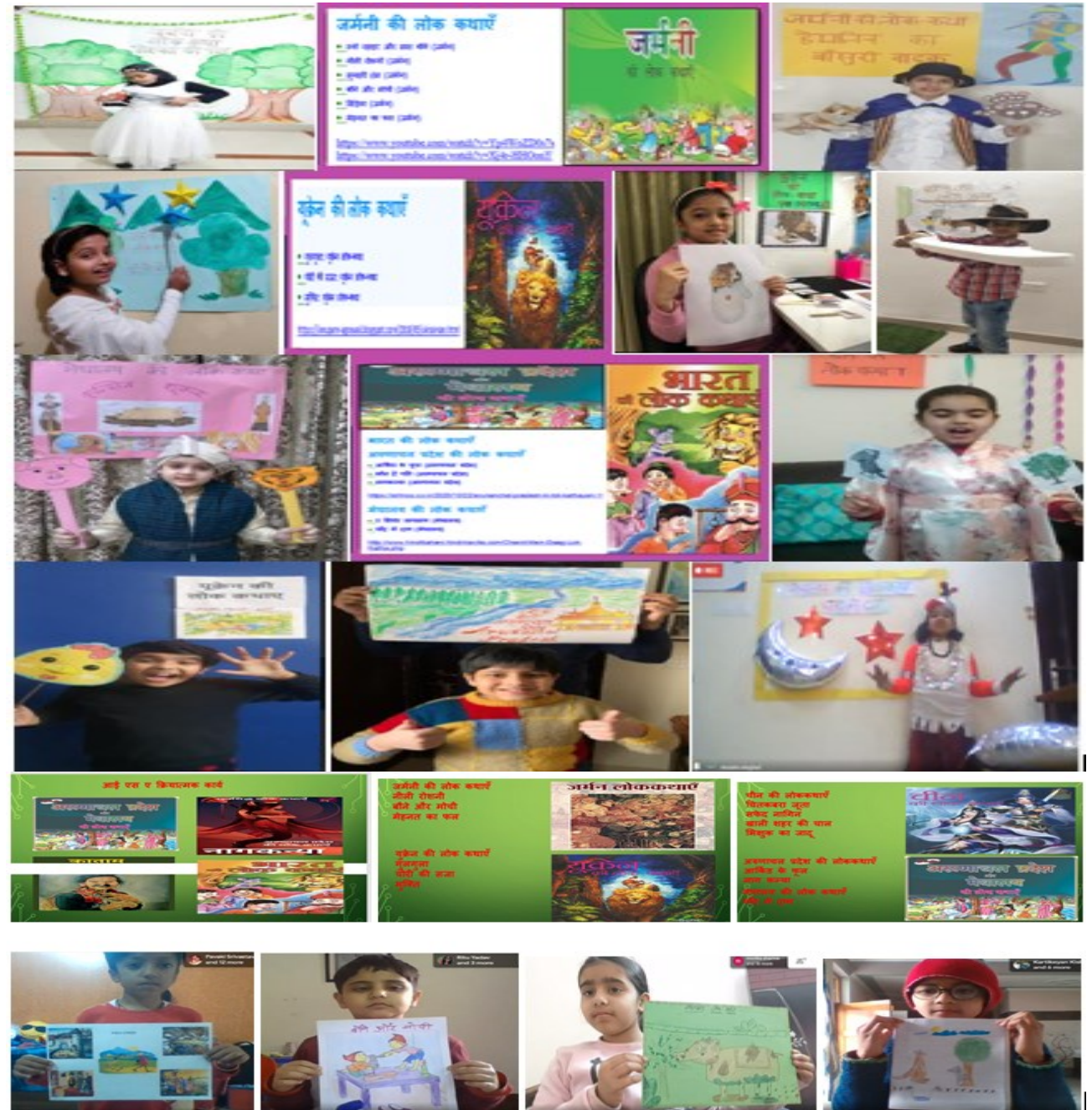

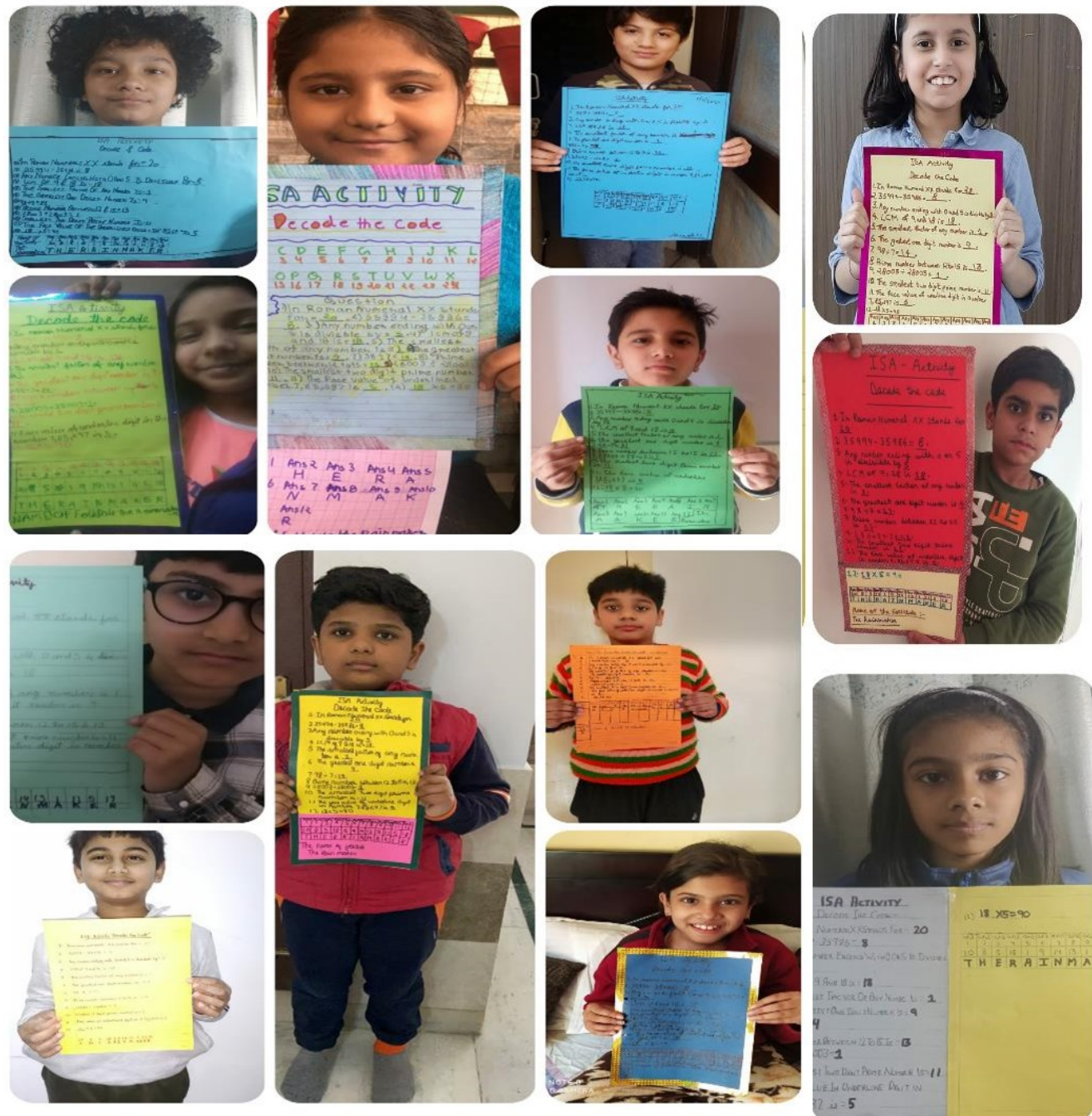
# HINDI -ISA ACTIVITY

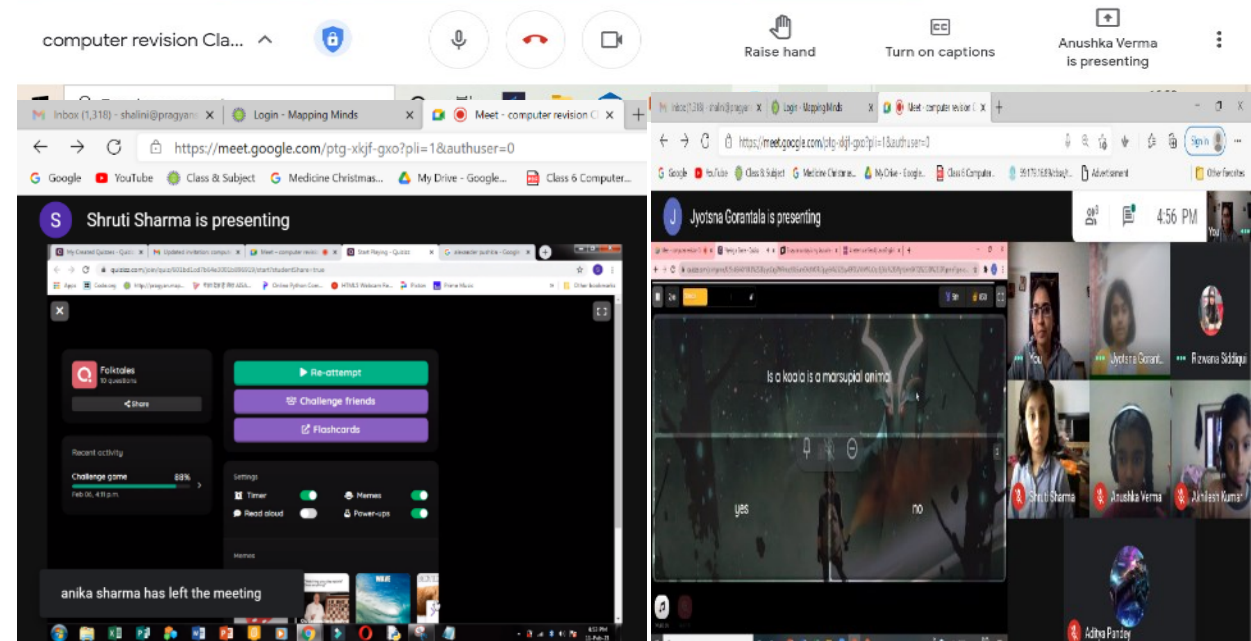
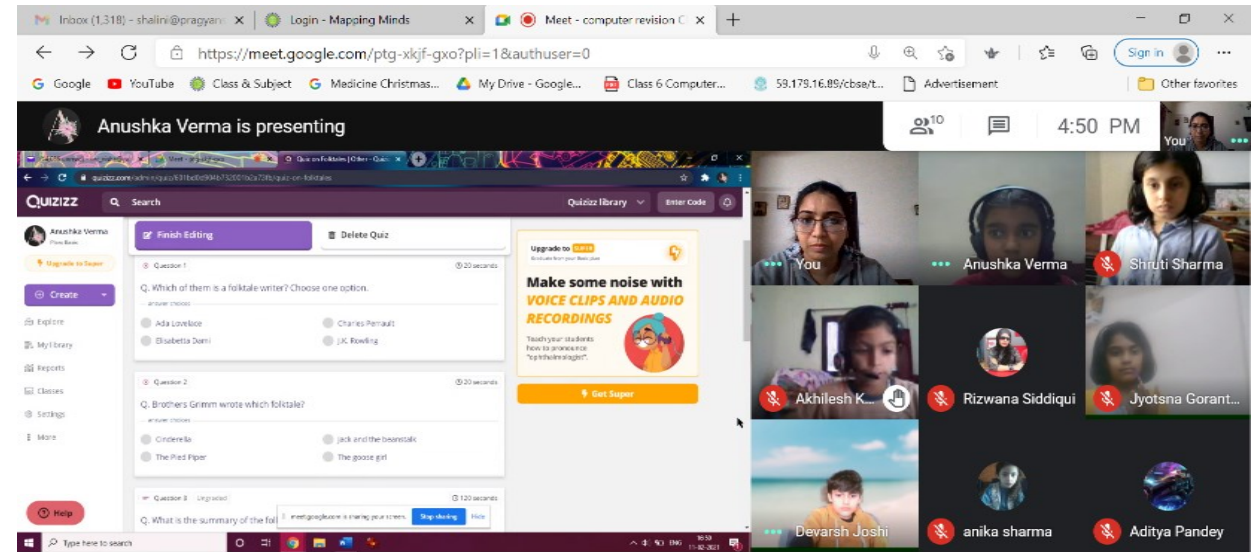
# MATH -ISA ACTIVITY
