SPECIAL EVENING ART CLASS

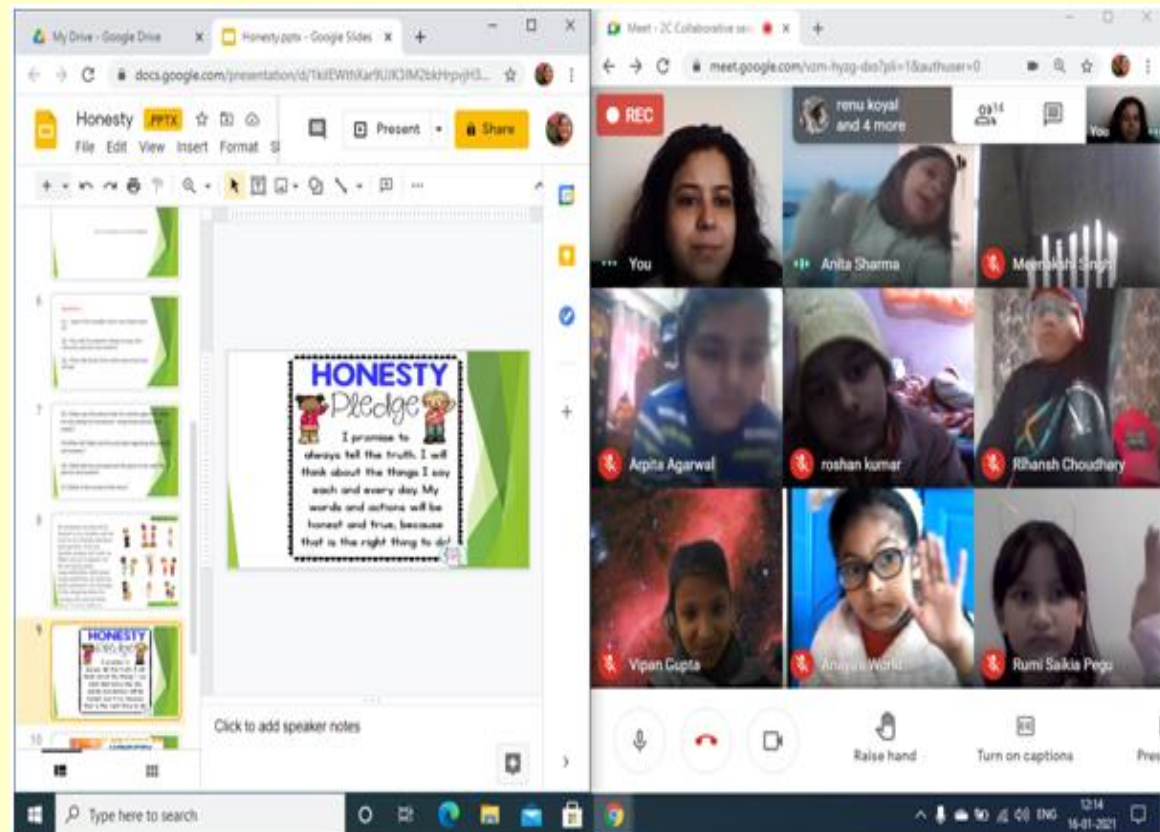

ex. Quickly, swiftly, slowly, rapidly

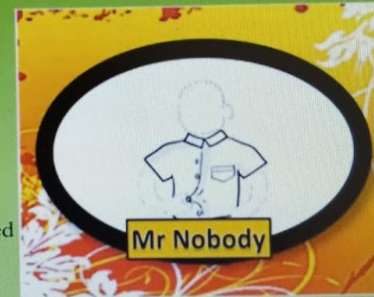

ART CLASS

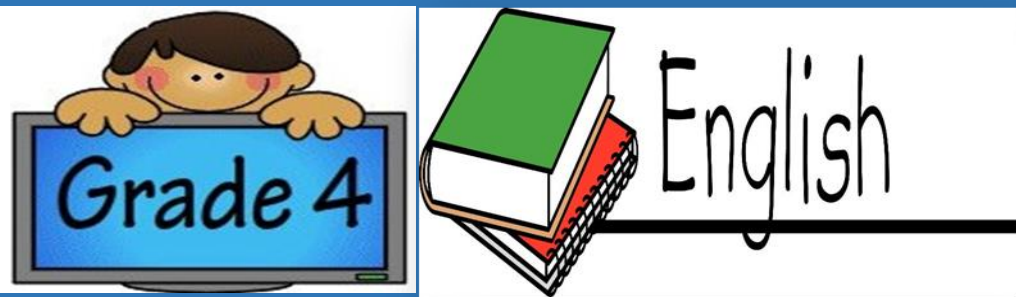

Grade 4 ART CLASS

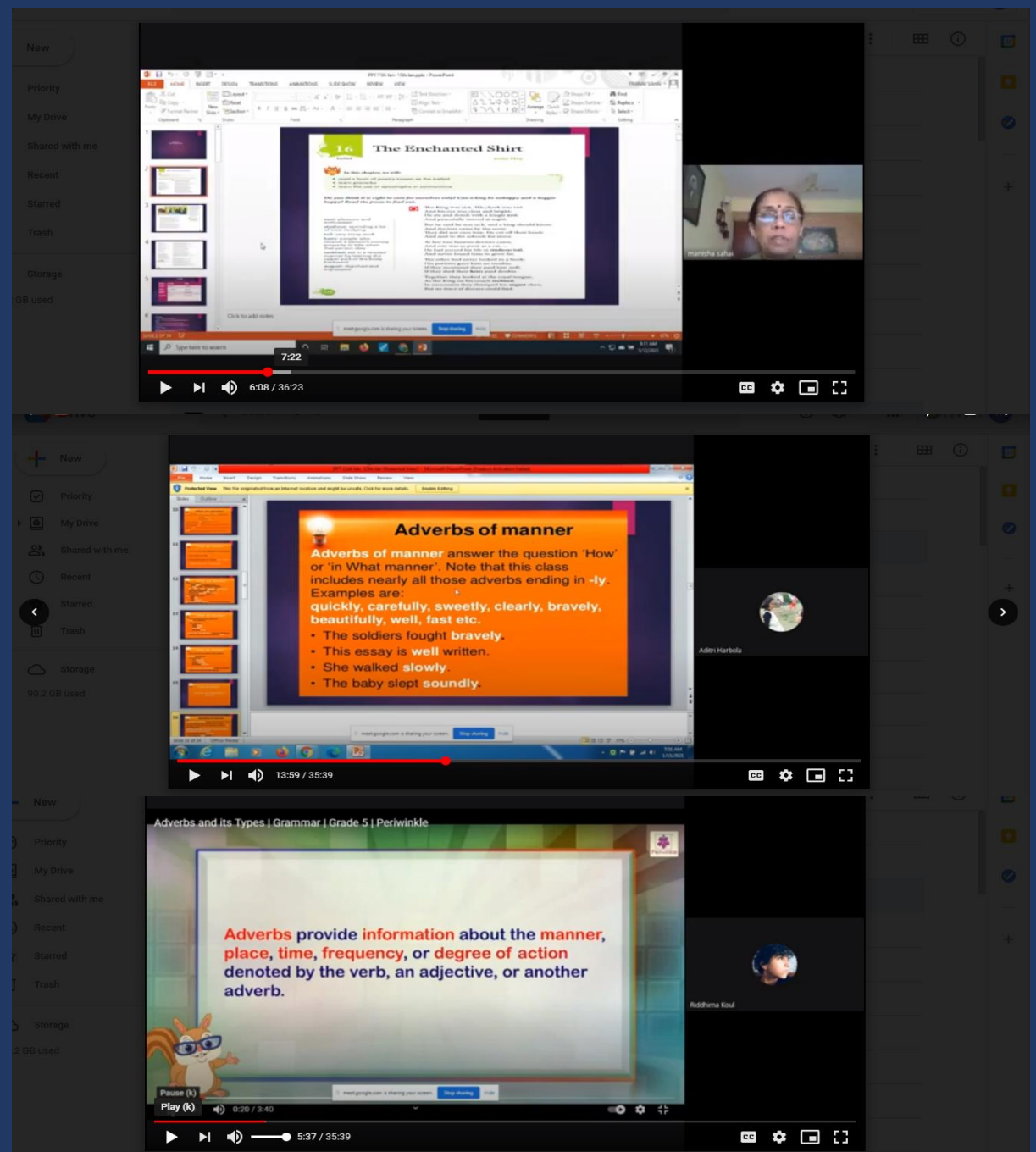


Students of class 4 C enjoyed making beautiful and colourful drawings for Republic day. Some students made Red fort, some made Indian army and some made Indian flag over the sky.





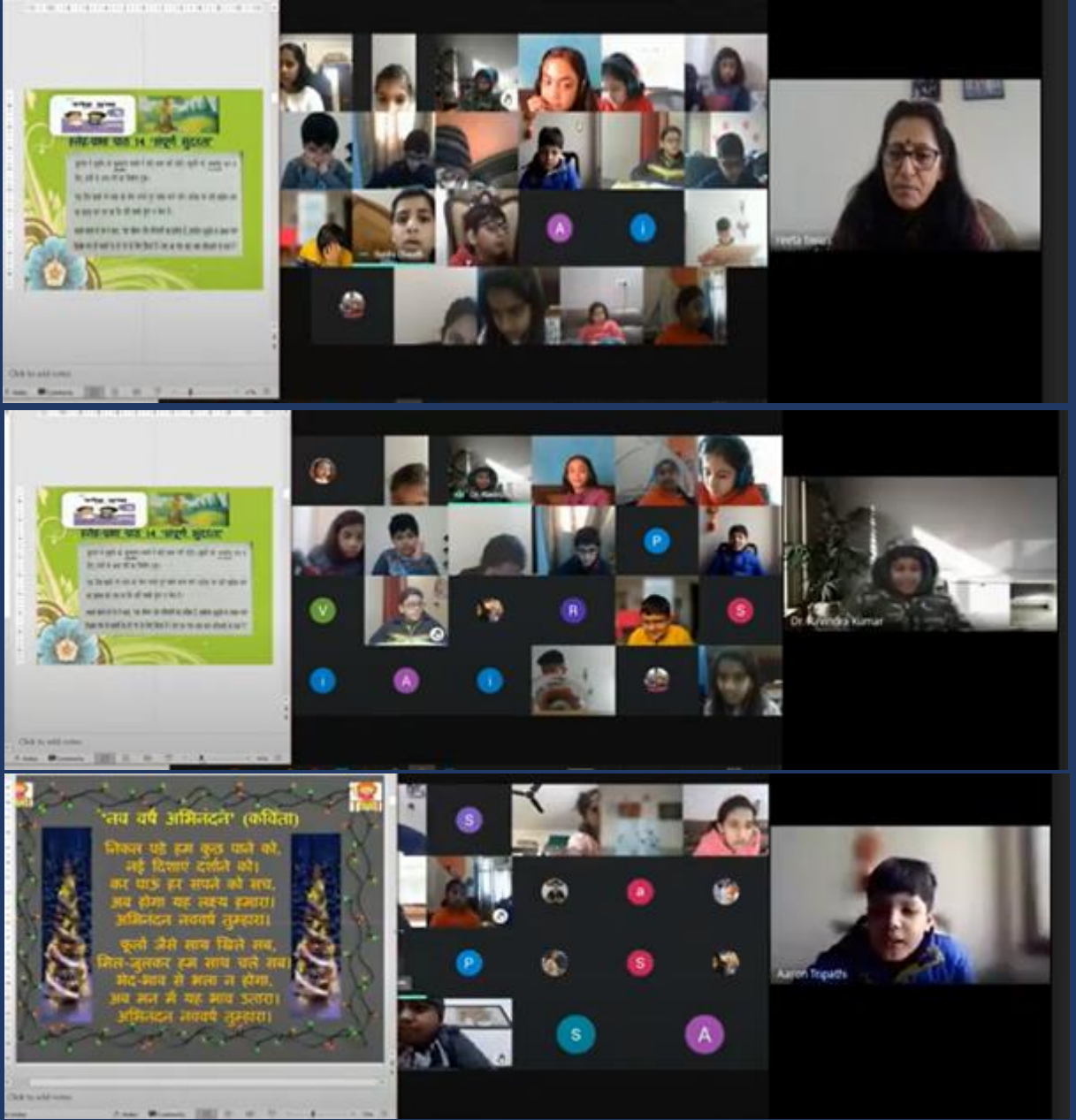

Types of Energy

Chemical Energy:

- Chemical energy is energy stored in the molecules of any substance. It is the energy that holds these particles together. Biomass, petroleum, natural gas and propane are examples of stored chemical energy.
- We consume carbohydrates as food. Carbohydrate molecules also store energy. Body cells obtain this stored energy by a process called respiration. Some of this stored potential energy becomes kinetic energy used for cell functions and muscle movement. Some of it also becomes internal heat energy that keeps the body warm.

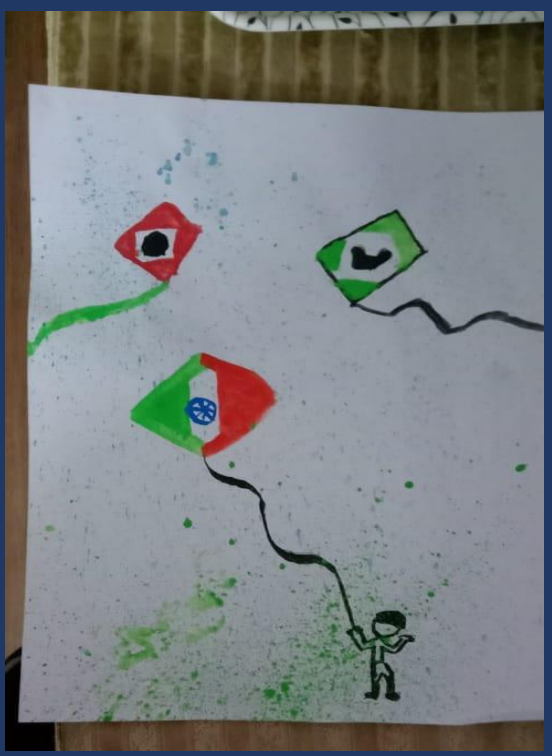

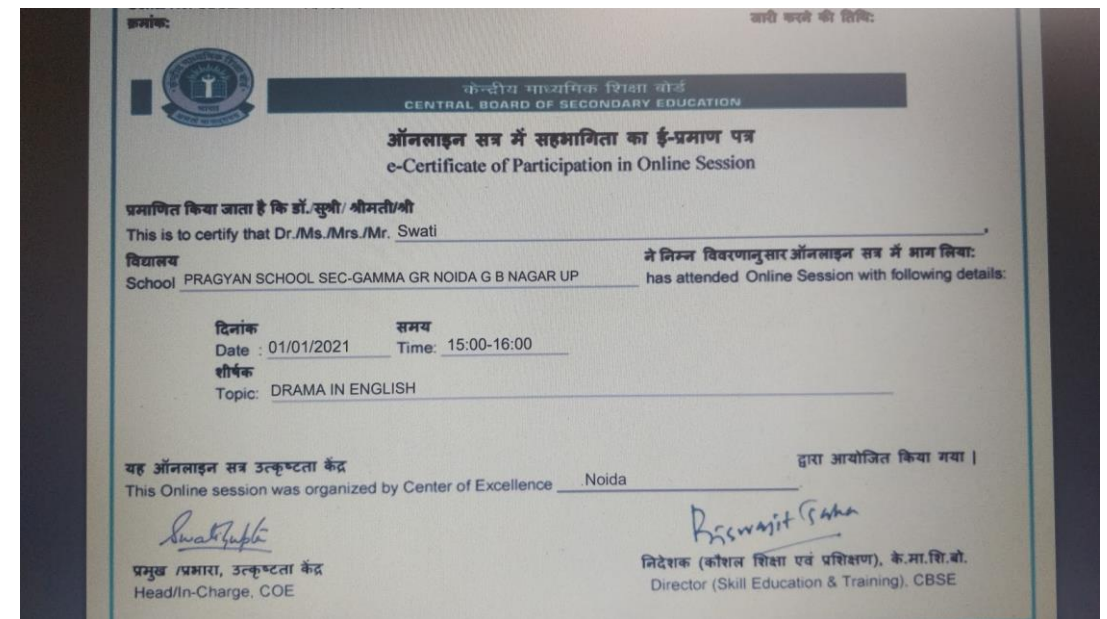
COLLABORATIVE SESSION: 3-5
