# NURSERY



**English** – Revision Of letters A-Z was done by doing the sequence writing, missing letters, circle the lowercase letters in the notebook.

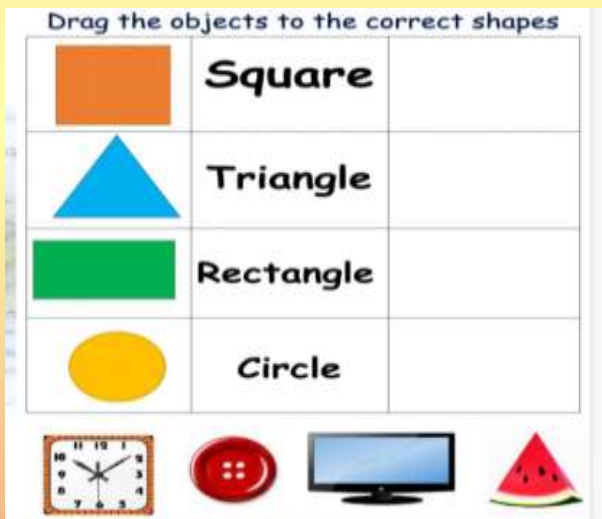
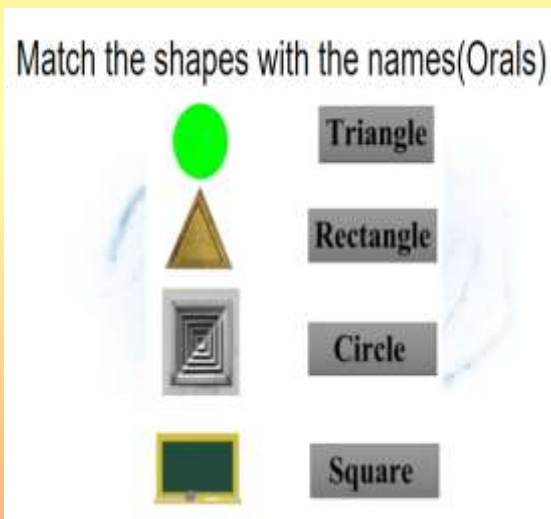
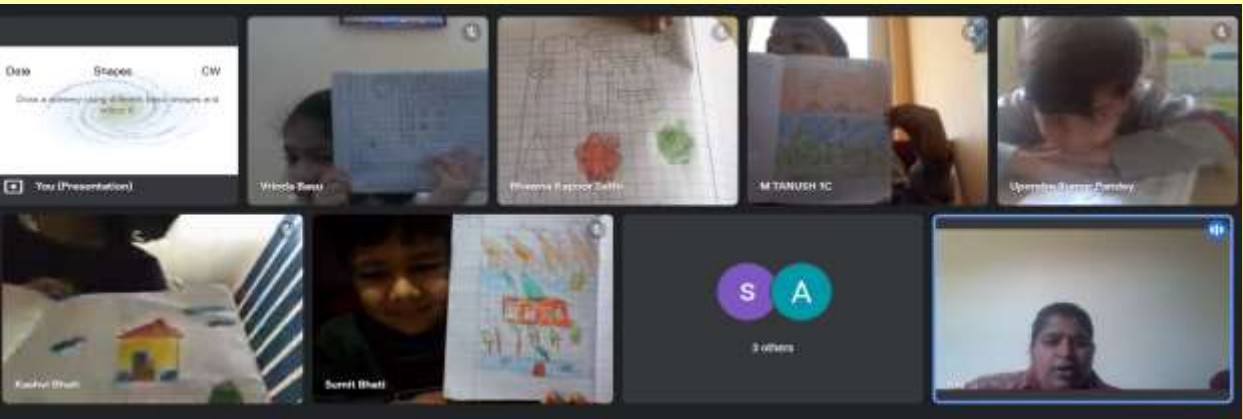
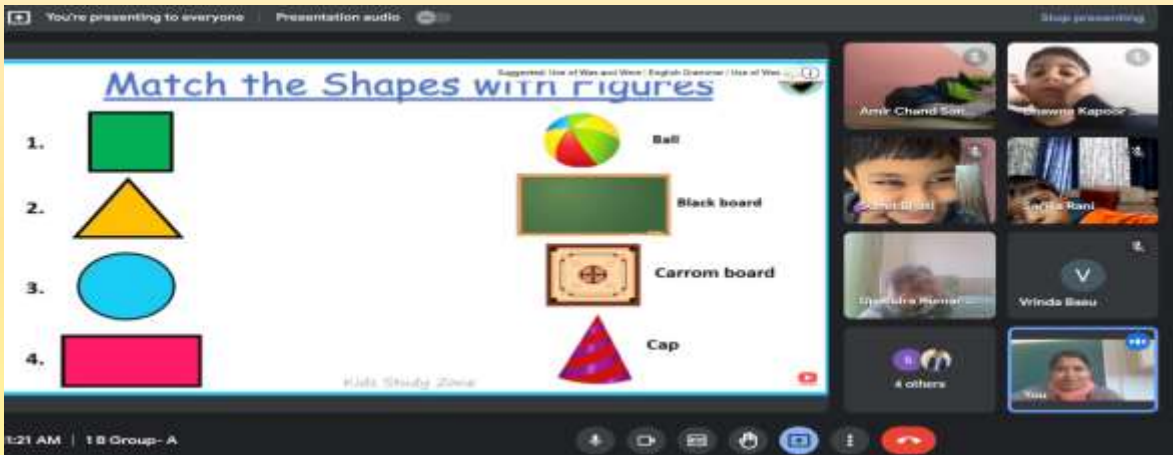
**EVS** - Revision of water animals were done in the EVS class. Students enjoyed watching the video related to the topic.

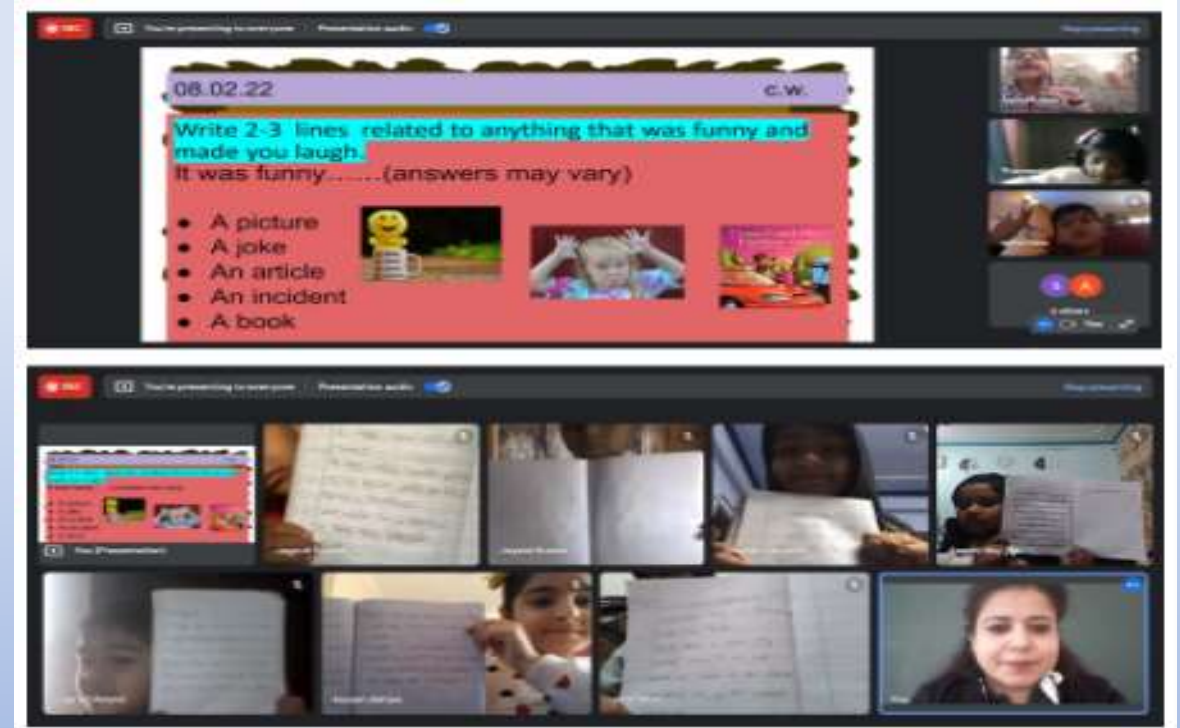

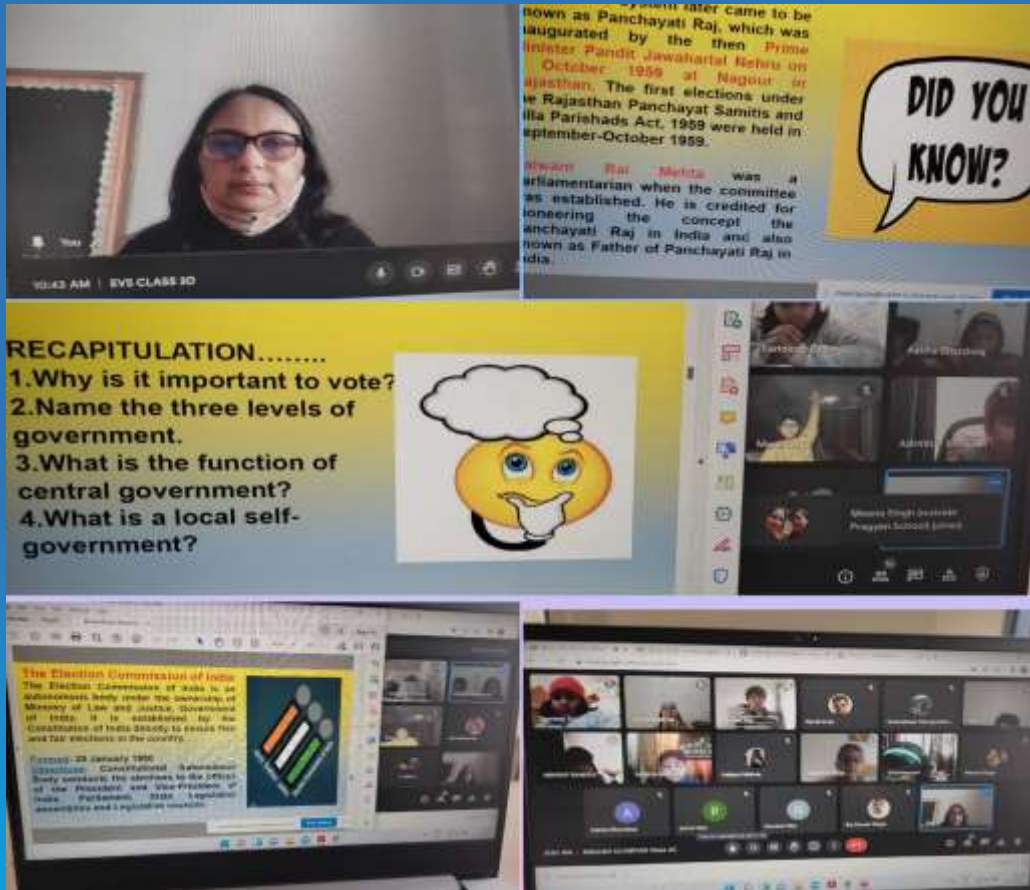


Students of Class 3 learnt various foot steps and jumps with rhythm. They also started learning new dance sequences for Holi on the contemporary/fusion music.

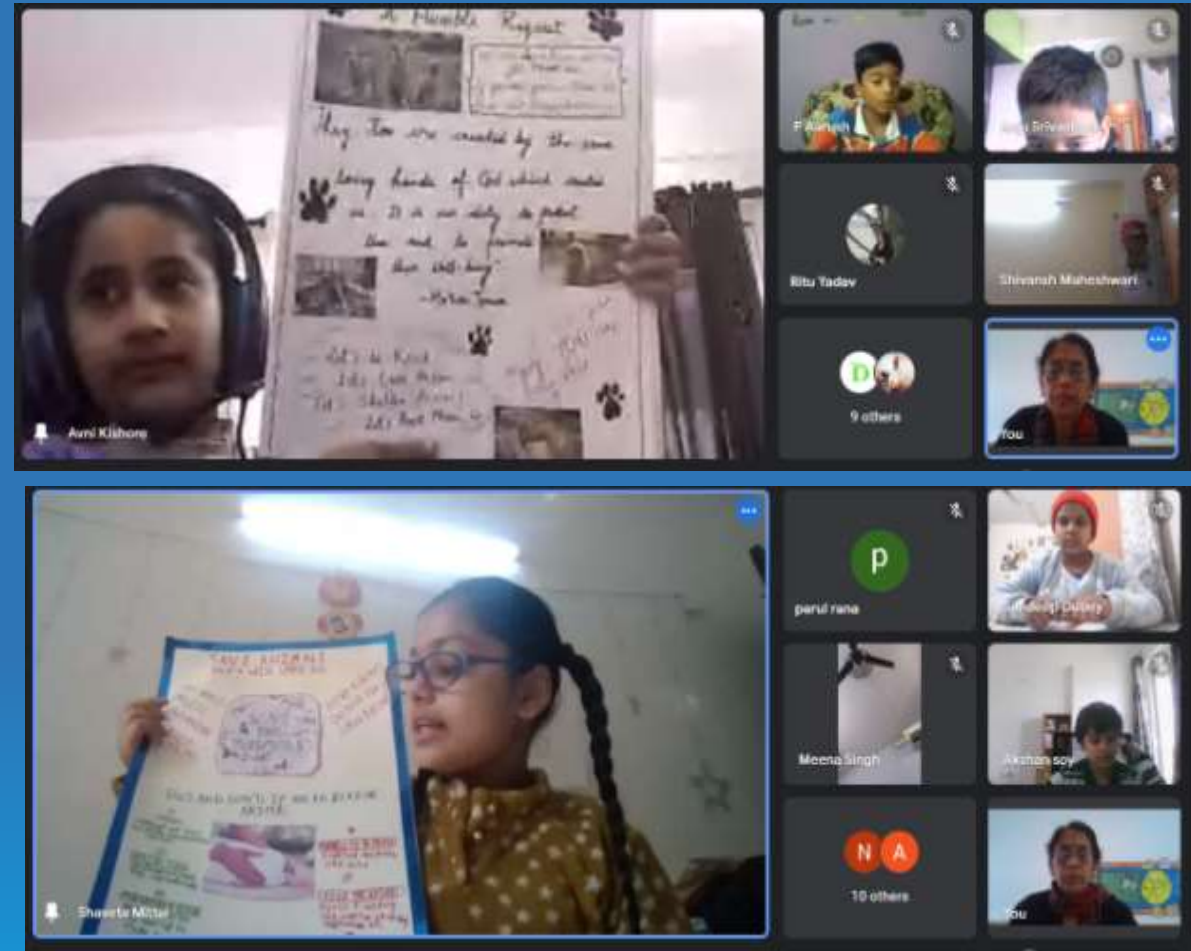

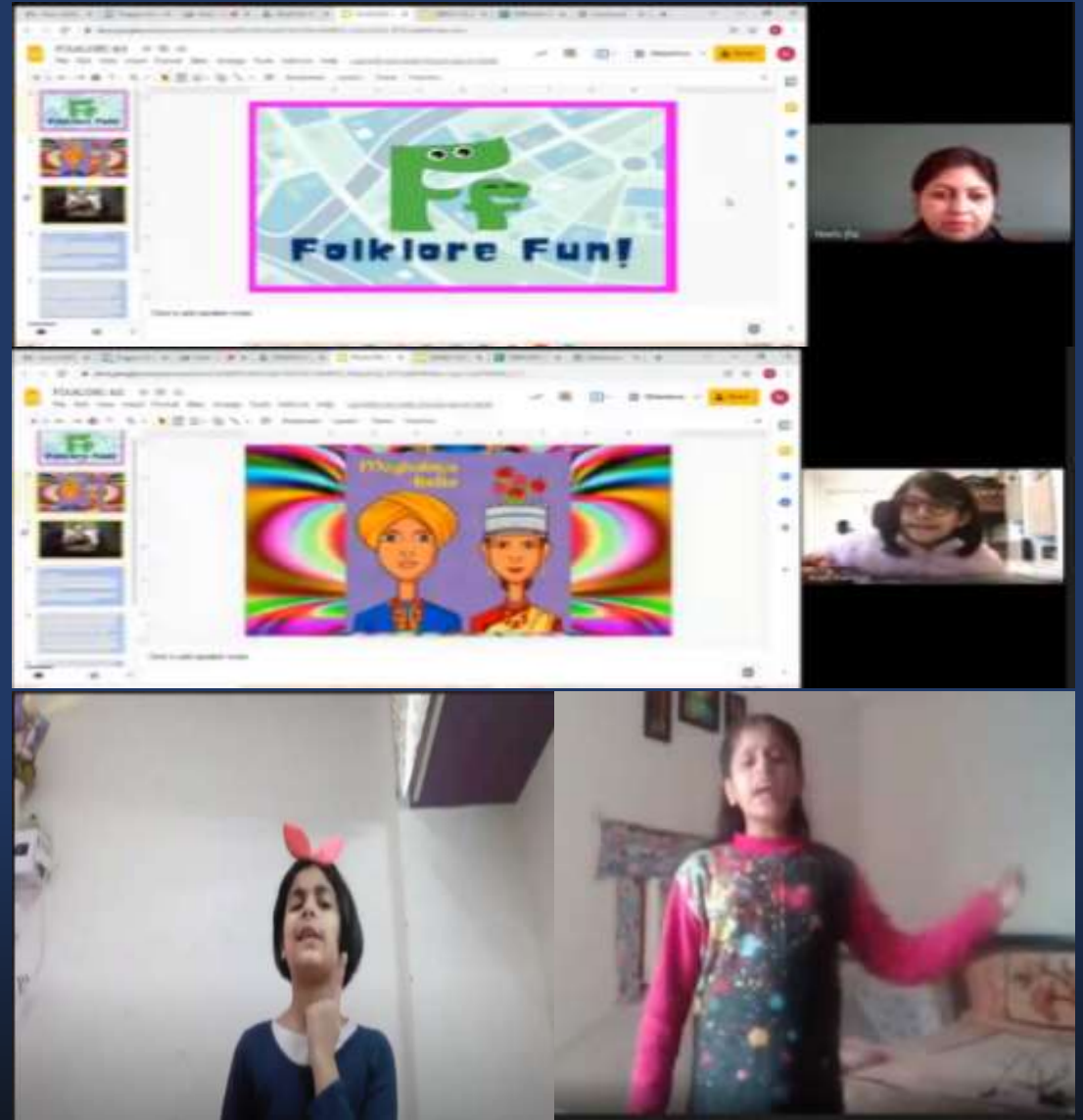


During the week students of class 4 had their assessments in Reading, Recitation, Dictation and Activity. They also completed the written tasks of lesson The Girl Who Stepped on the Loaf. Practice for English Olympiad was given to the students through a google form. They also did the activity of Folklore Fun, which was a part of reading challenge campaign.





Students of grade 5 had the assessments of reading, recitation, dictation and activity during this week. They were also given practice for the forthcoming English Olympiad. They did a google form based on the syllabus of the olympiad. They also read the chapter, Pepper, the Phantom Pet - I and wrote the new words of this lesson. Students enjoyed doing the activity, Folklore Fun which was a part of the 100 Days Reading Campaign.





# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

The students of grade 5 were acquainted with the plant world reproduction with the introduction of L-20: How Do Plants Reproduce?. The structure of the seed along with the functions of its various parts- seed coat, endosperm and cotyledons was explained in detail. This was followed by discussion on the comparison between monocots and dicots. The process of germination along with its various requirements was also explained. Videos related to the topic were shown to strengthen the understanding of the students. The revision for the upcoming minor assessments of the SA2 assessment cycle was also done during the online class.

**L-20: How Do Plants Reproduce?**

**Wind Dispersal:**

- Some seeds that are very light in weight are carried away from the parent plant by the wind. These include orchid and poppy seeds.
- Some seeds, such as dandelion, have hair-like growths that catch the wind and help carry the seeds away from the parent plant.

**Water Dispersal:**

- Some seeds are hollow and filled with air and they get carried away by water. These include coconut and palm seeds.

**L-20: How Do Plants Reproduce?**

**Seed Dispersal**

- The process of scattering of seeds away from the parent plant is called seed dispersal.
- If all the seeds fall and grow beneath the parent plant, it would cause overcrowding.
- The seeds would have to struggle for space, air, water, nutrients and sunlight.
- Strong wind dispersal ensures that all seeds get a better chance of finding the right conditions to grow in.

**L-20: How Do Plants Reproduce?**

**Animal Dispersal**

- Fruits form a part of the diet of some animals. While eating the pulp of the fruit is digested, the seeds in the pulp and stones get passed out of the digestive system and are thus dispersed.
- The seeds of **sun-heli** and the **hatched plant** have hooks on them, which get attached to the fur of animals. The animals later shake off these seeds far from the parent plant and thus help in seed dispersal.

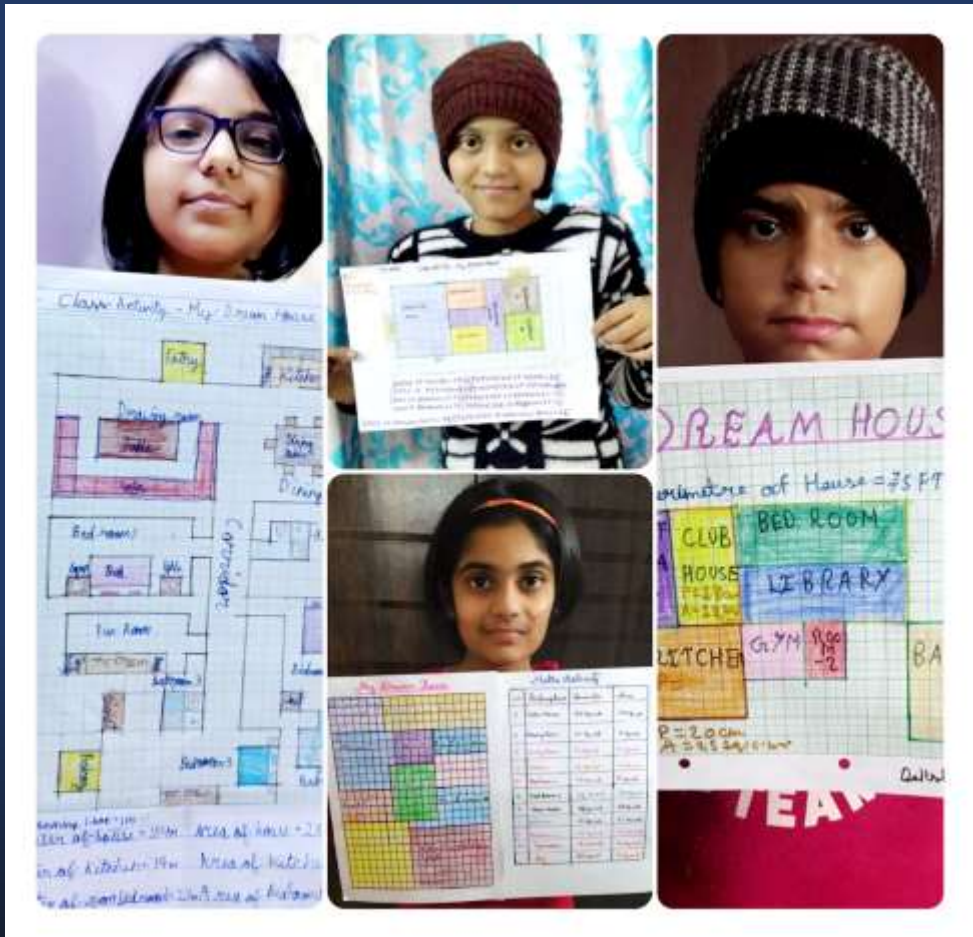
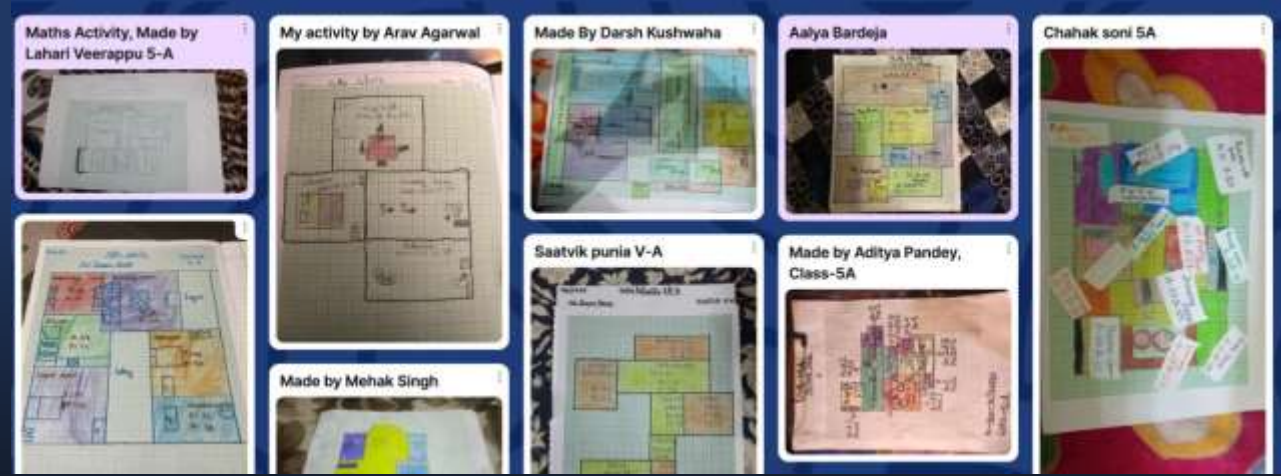

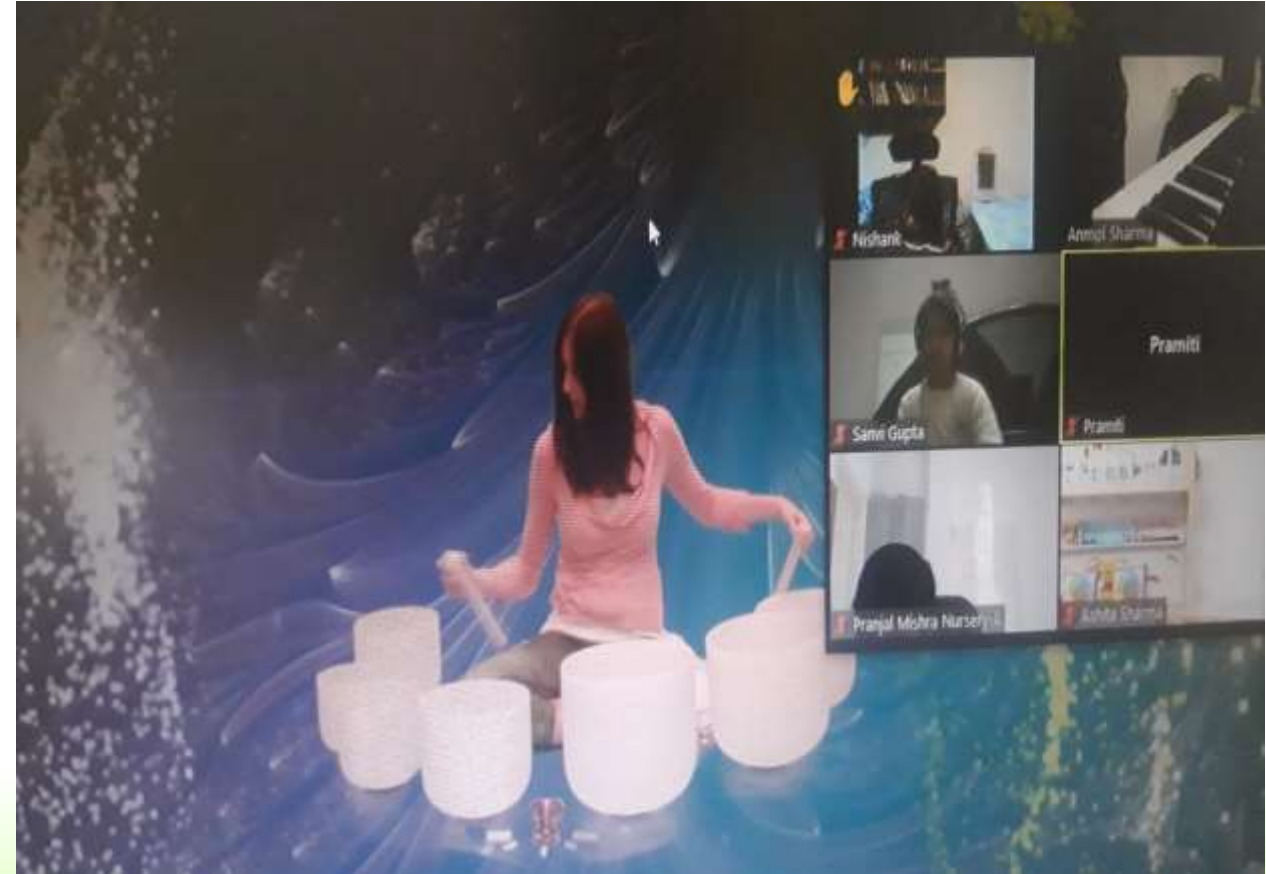
Students of classes 3 to 5 practiced for the forthcoming Inter Class Dot Painting Activity. They also learnt to make weaving fish and tortoises.



# WELLNESS SESSION: MUSIC THERAPY (3 & 5)

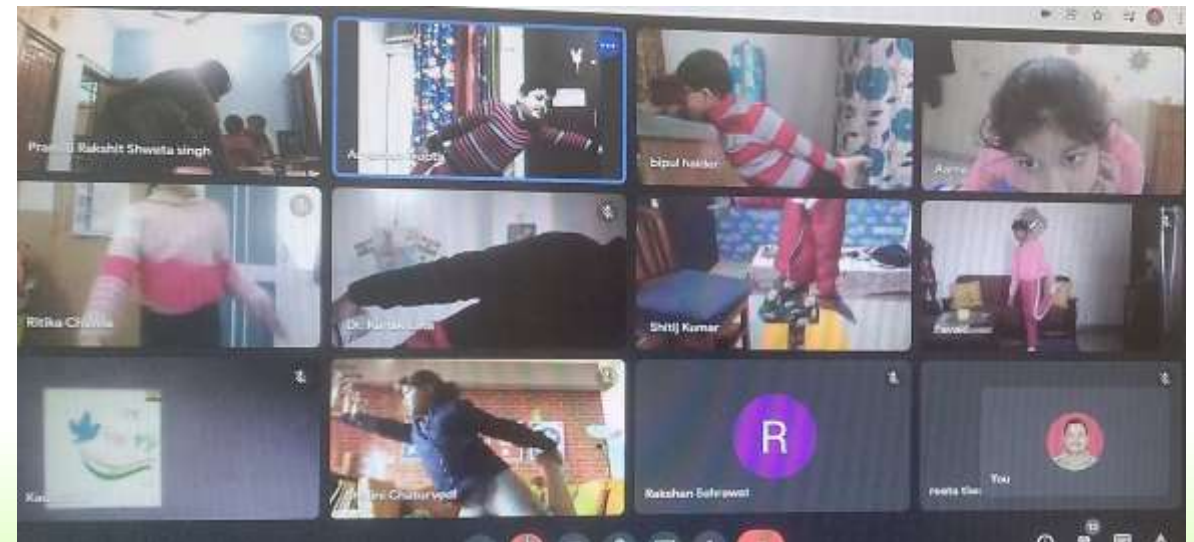

# PHYSICAL FITNESS ( 3 - 5 )

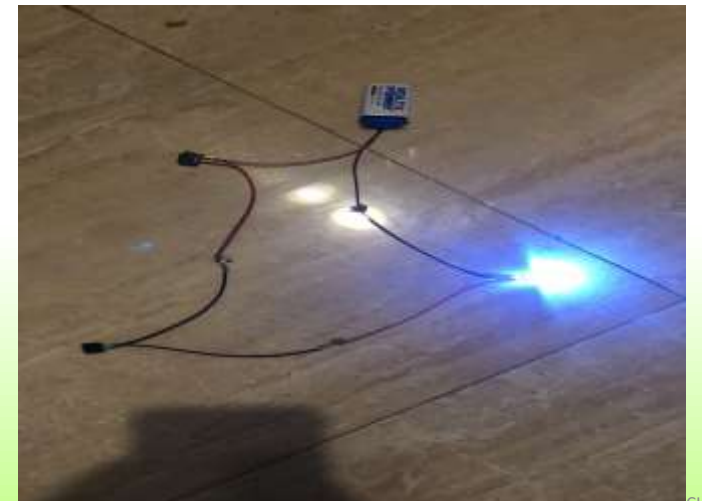

# STEM SESSION( 3 - 5 )

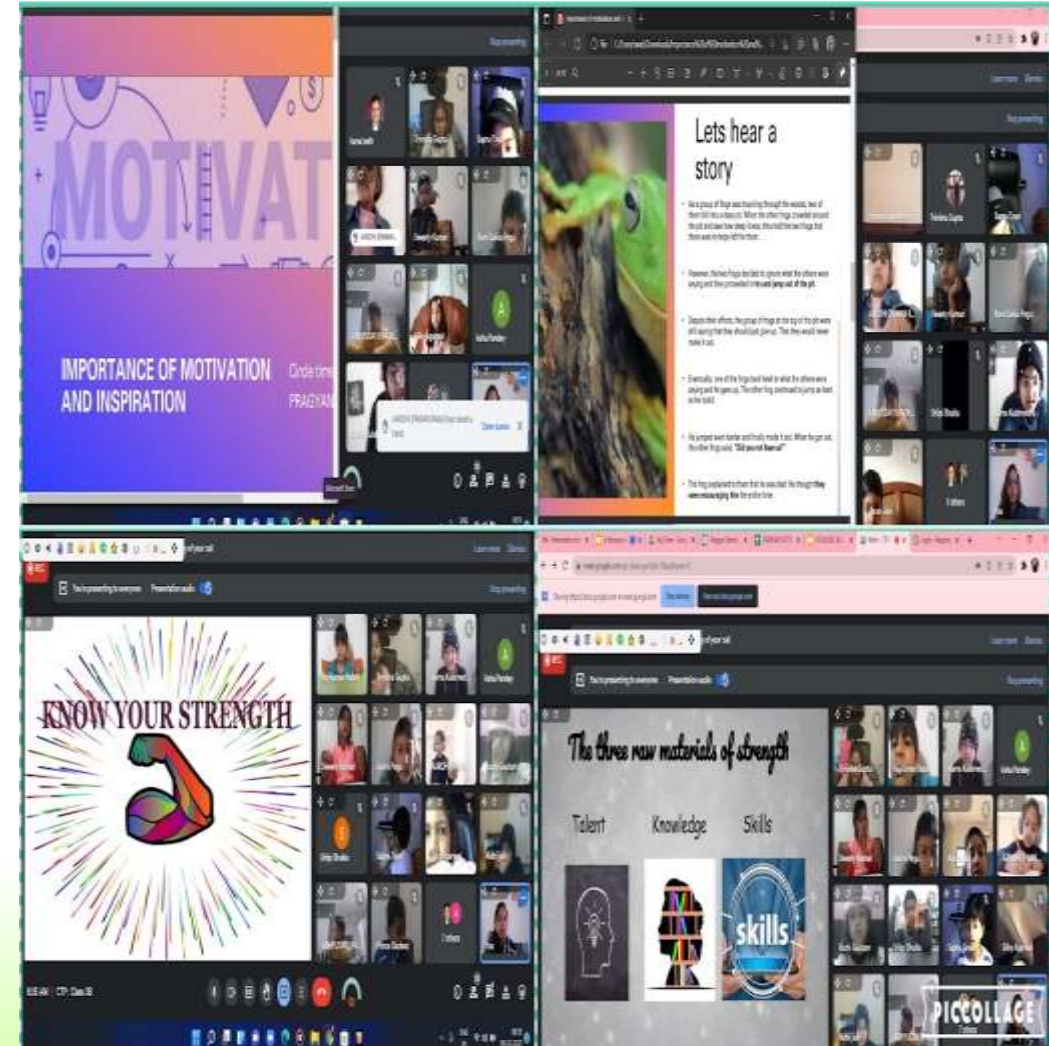

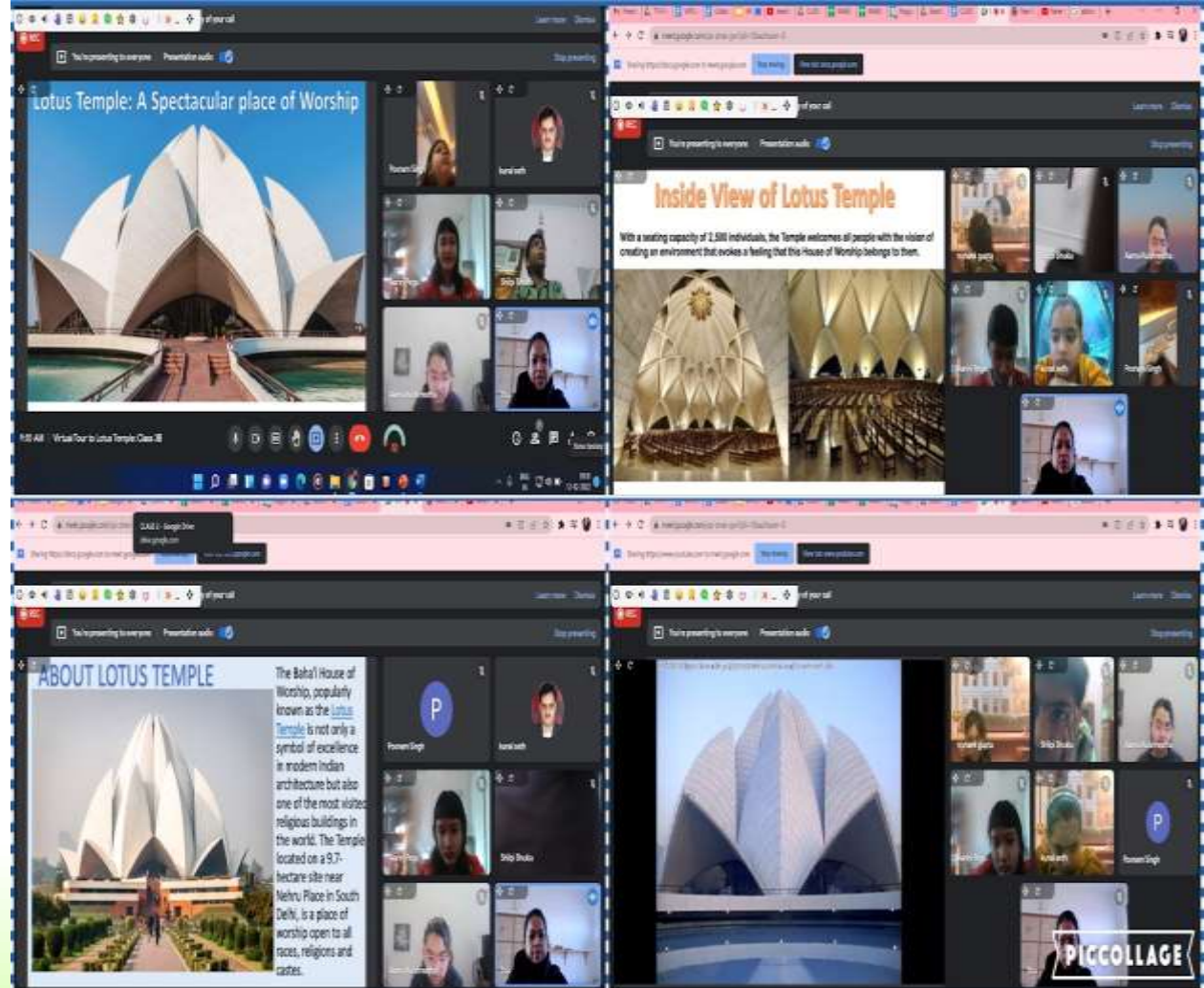
# CLASS TEACHER PERIOD (3-5)

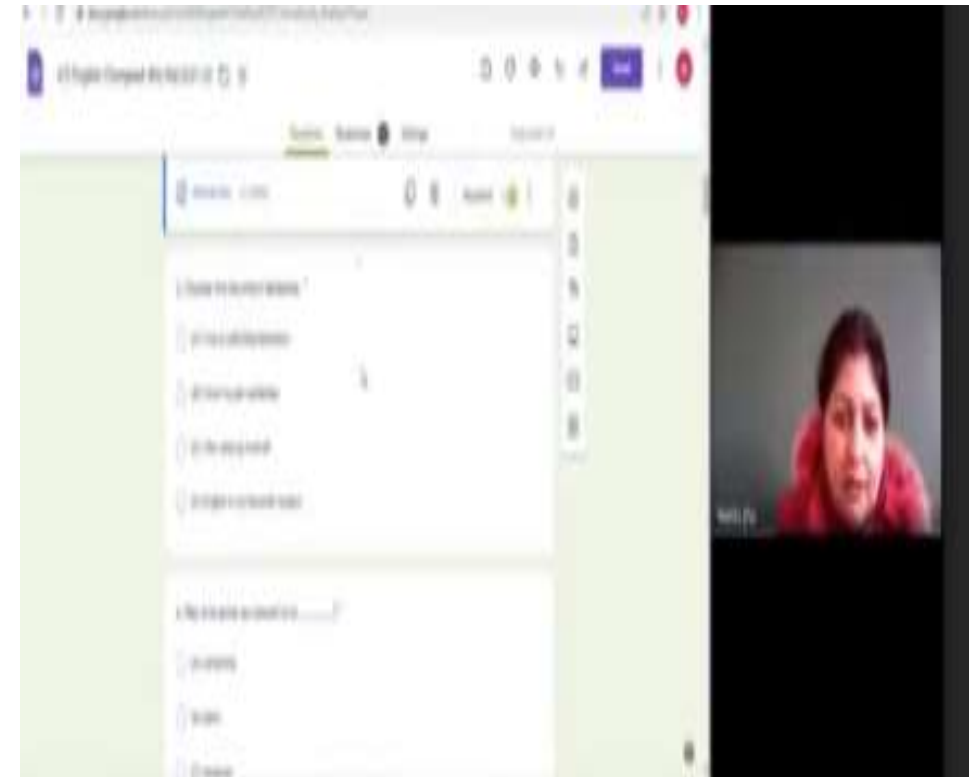
# VIRTUAL TOURS (3-5)

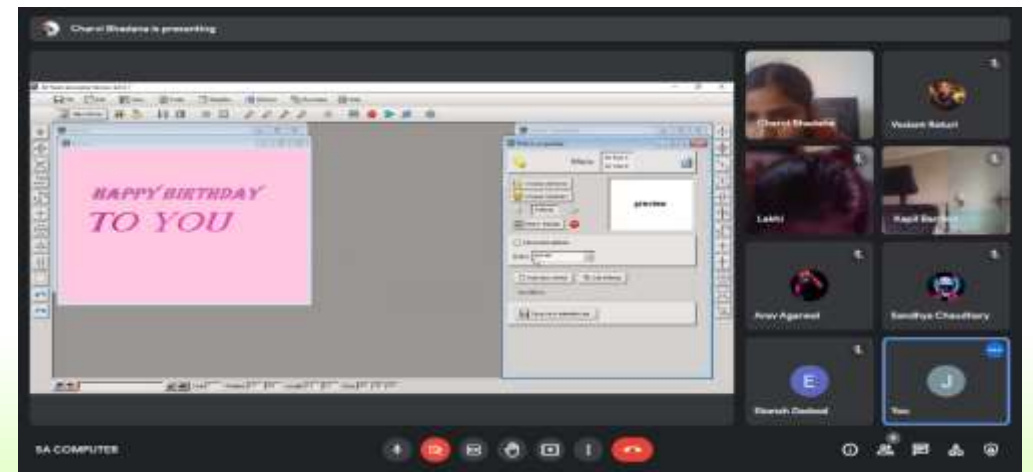
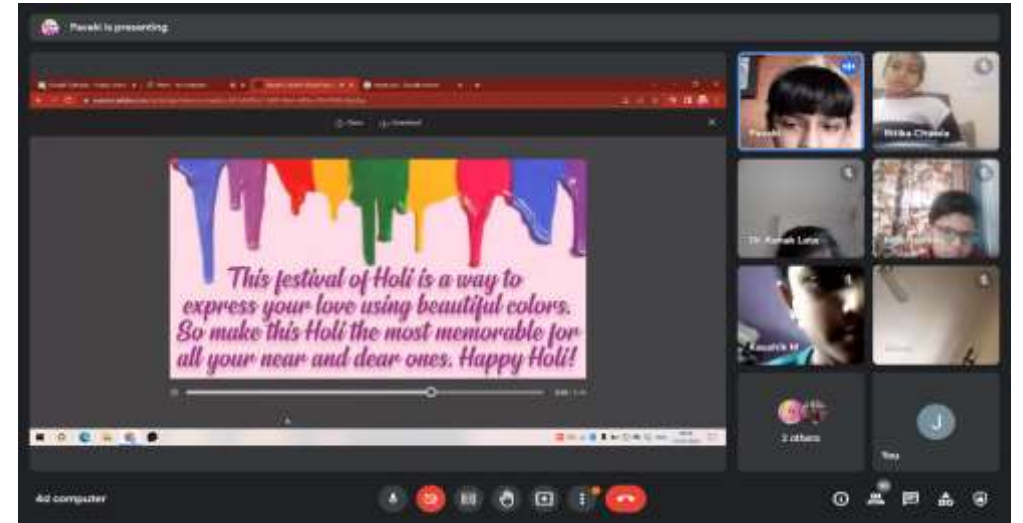


# COMPUTER (3-5)

Students of Grade 4 learnt how to make videos in Adobe Spark They had also made beautiful Videos on HOLI

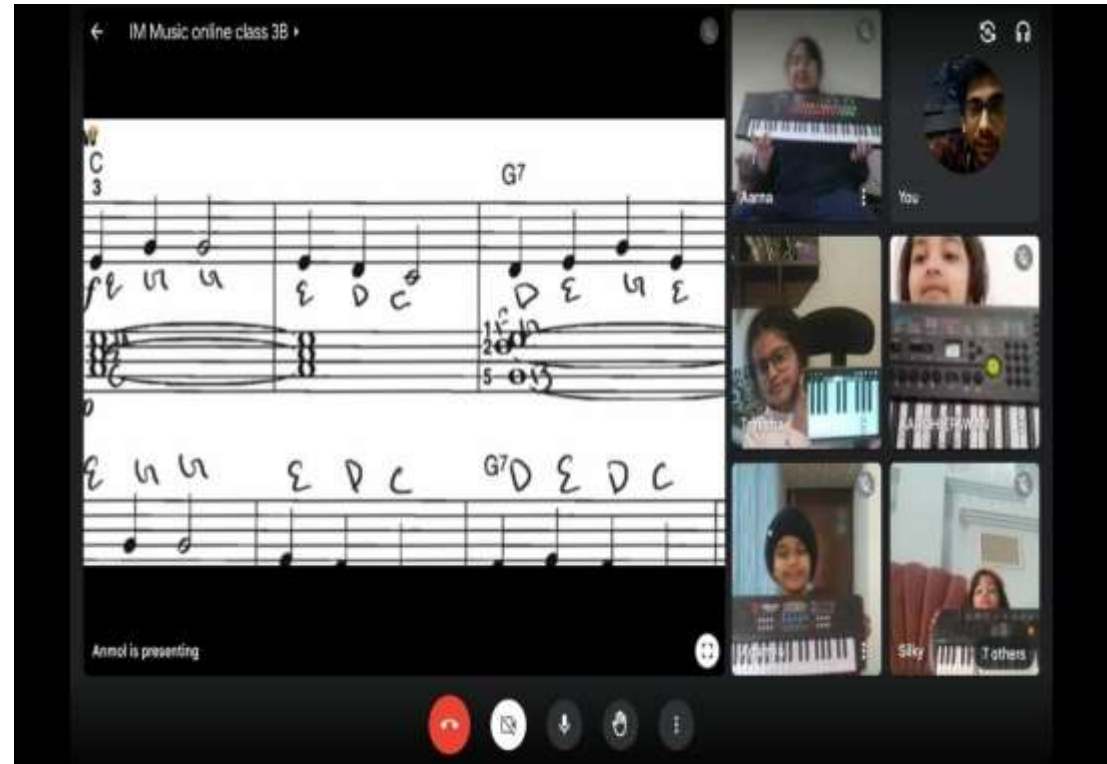
Students of Grade 5 were taught Flash animator in which they learnt how to add 3D shapes and 3D Text and animate it
