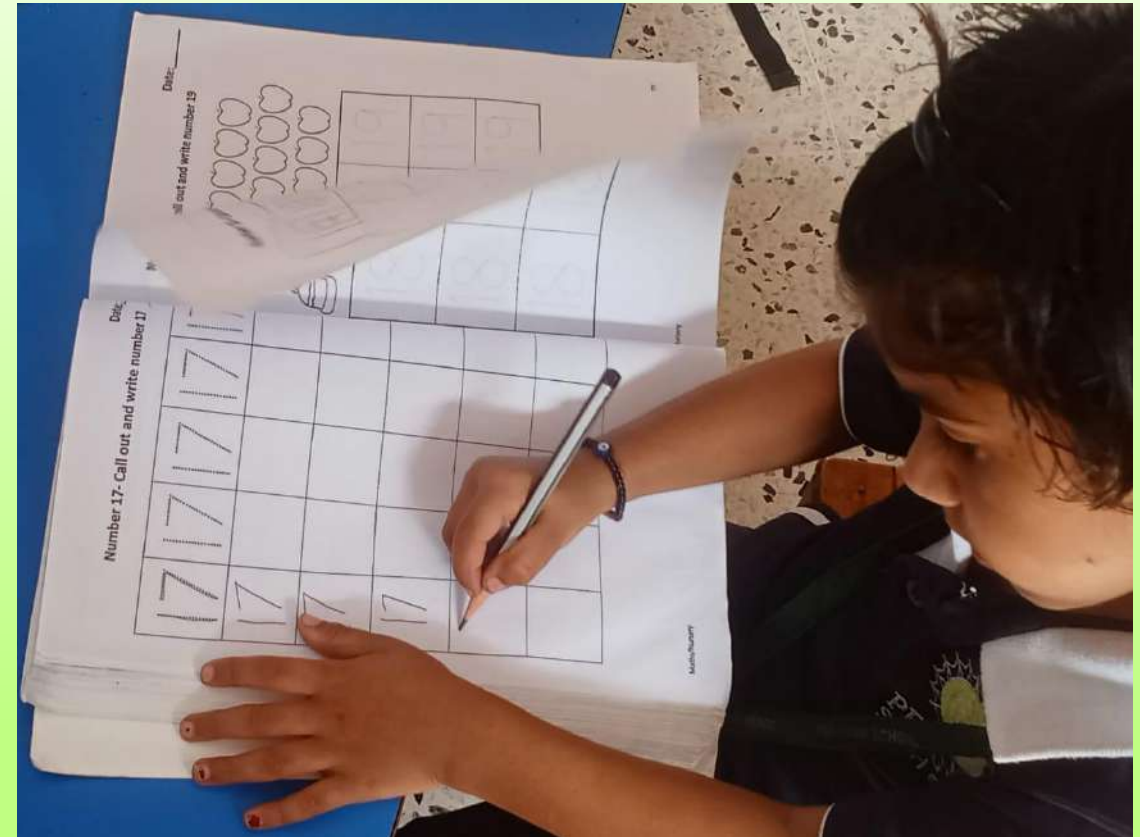
ENGLISH

Letter C was introduced to the children with the help of pictures and different objects. They also enjoyed the Jolly phonics song of letter C. Students did worksheets related to the letter in their workbook and also practiced writing letter C in their notebook.



MATHS

This week number 17 was introduced to the students and children did counting using blocks. They also practiced writing the number in their notebook as well as in their workbook.



HINDI

Vyanjan 'न' was introduced to the students with the help of pictures. They also enjoyed colouring 'न' related objects in their Hindi letter book.



GENERAL AWARENESS

As part of general awareness children did discussion on different modes of transportation in the class. Students participated in class discussion about land, water and air transport and enjoyed colouring the worksheets related to the topic. Children also enjoyed a rhyme related to transportation.



EASP

Nursery students participated in 100m races, improving their running skills. General exercises enhanced gross motor skills and balancing games developed agility.



KINDERGARTEN



ENGLISH

The students revised 'at,' 'an,' 'ap,' and 'ag' word families and completed a worksheet related to all the 'a' family words in their workbook. Word families help children recognize patterns in words, making it easier for them to decode and read new words. Learning word families builds a foundation for early reading skills.

MATHS

This week, students were introduced to the concept of ascending order. To solidify this concept, an activity was conducted using flashcards. The students had to arrange the flashcards in ascending order. This helped the students to enhance their ability to compare numbers and improve their arithmetic skills by understanding sequences and patterns.



HINDI

Students were introduced to the vyanjan य. To make learning more engaging, students were encouraged to colour pictures beginning with vyanjan य and write the vyanjan in their notebook. This helped them associate visual creativity with language learning.



DANCE

Dance helps improve motor skills, balance, coordination, and flexibility, which are crucial for young children as they grow and develop physically. Students enjoyed the song Dhaker tali.



CIRCLE TIME

During Circle Time, students had an engaging discussion about transportation and community helpers. The children asked thoughtful questions about how different vehicles help us travel and the role that community helpers, like firefighters, doctors, and teachers play in our daily lives. This interactive session allowed students to share their ideas and deepen their understanding of how people and services work together to support the community.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY

This week, students were engaged in a hands-on math activity to learn about ascending and descending order. Using flashcards and colorful blocks, the children worked together to arrange numbers from smallest to largest and vice versa. This interactive approach not only strengthened their understanding of number sequences but also made learning fun and engaging.



SKILL BASED LEARNING

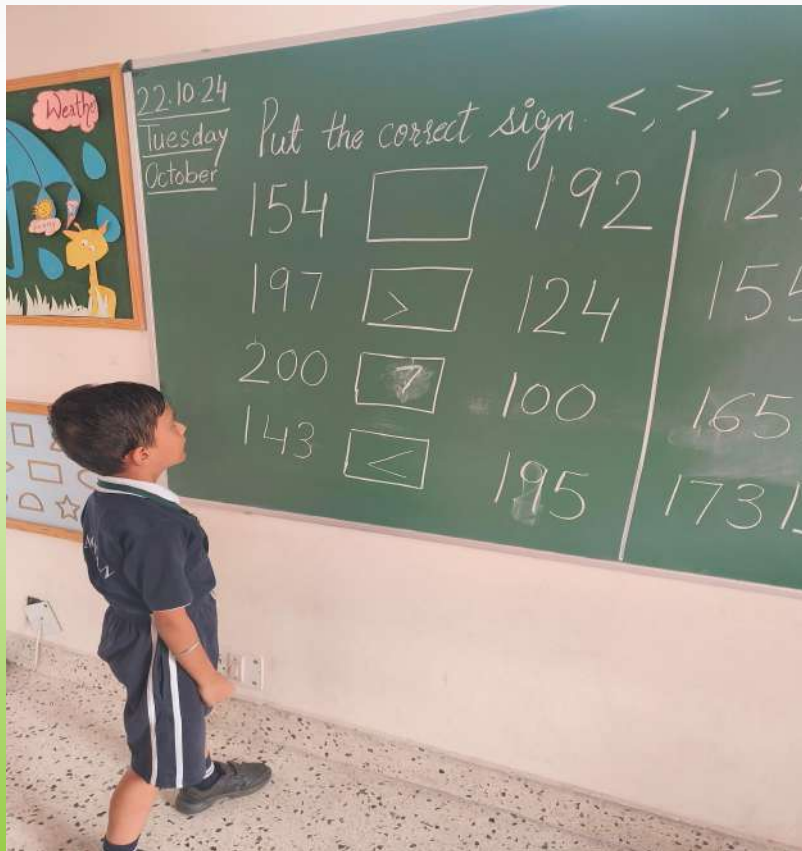

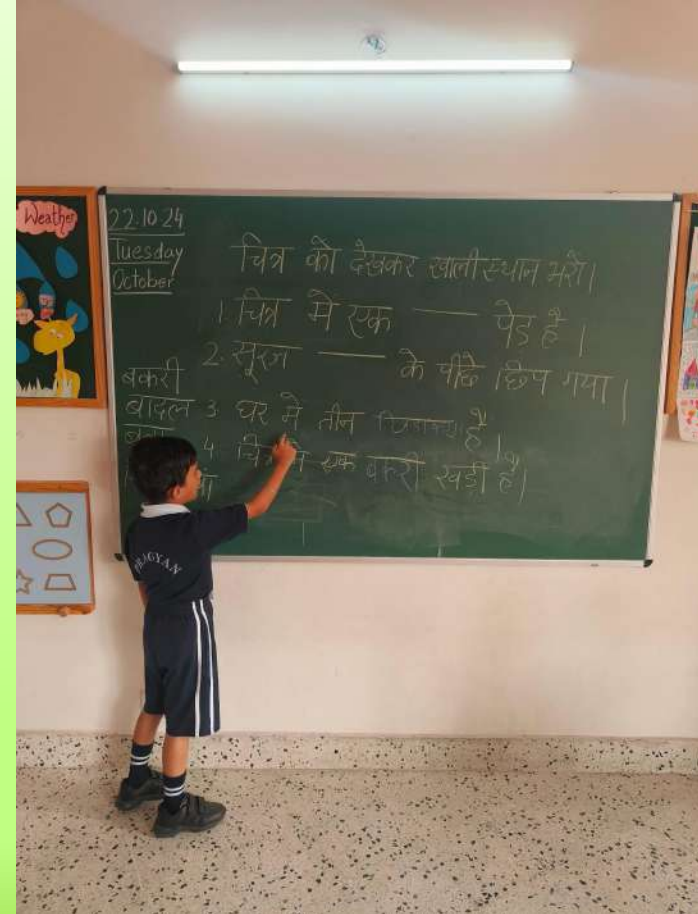
MATHS

During this week students did number names, oral counting 150 to 200, put the correct sign, and arranged the numbers in ascending order. They practiced these topics during board work in their workbooks.



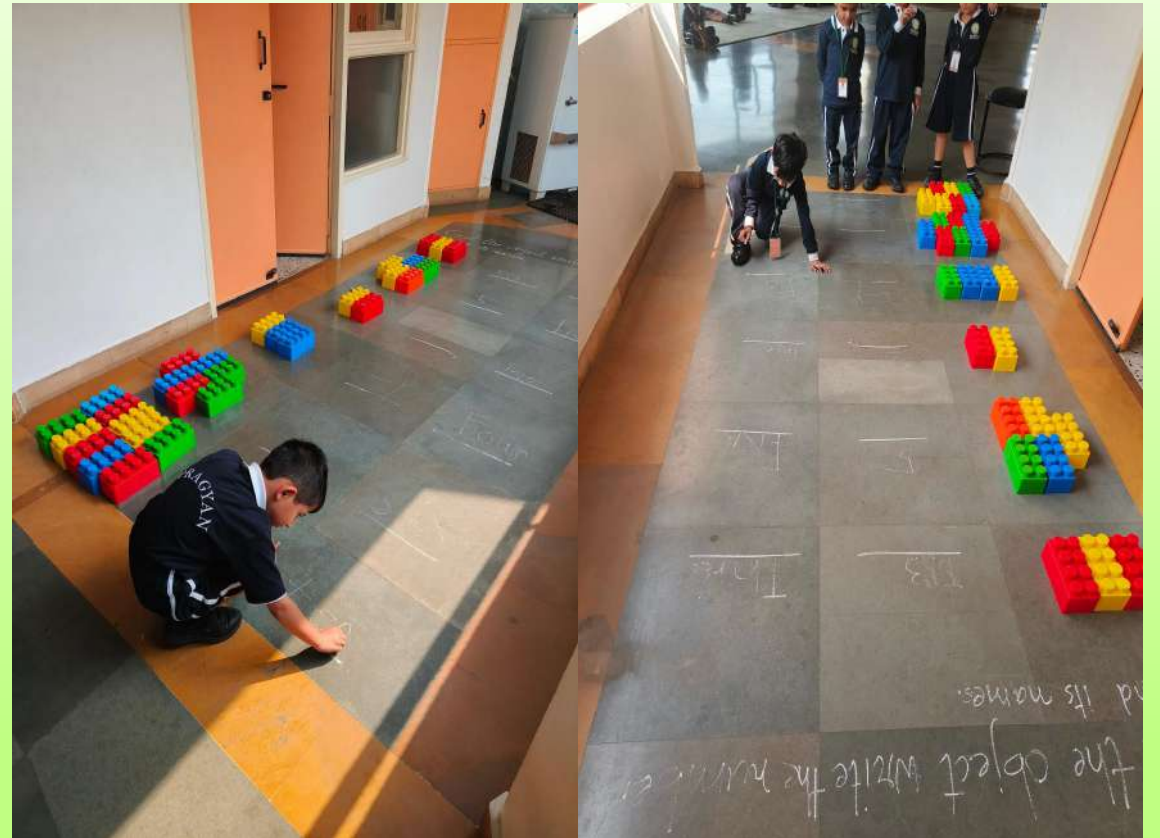
HINDI

During the week students of UKG had done counting 180-200. By doing hands-on activity they learned and revised number names, and put the correct sign by comparing numbers.



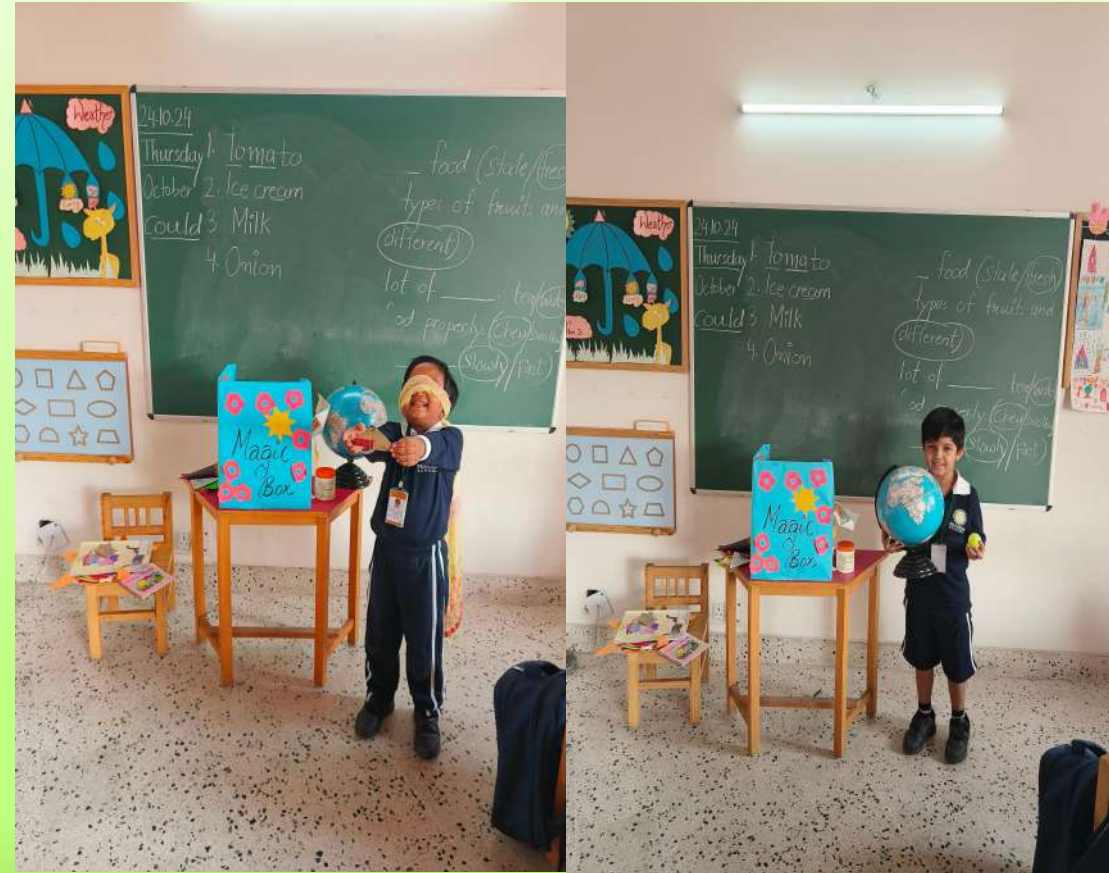
INTER CLASS ACTIVITY: FUN WITH SHAPES

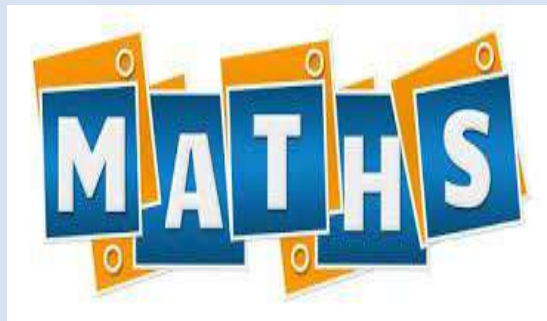

Colouring and drawing both help kids improve fine motor skills. They also train the brain to focus. Students of grade 1 practiced colouring the picture of 'rabbit' in their sparkle book this week. Students of class 2 have done the mosaic art in tulip flower in their sparkle book.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)

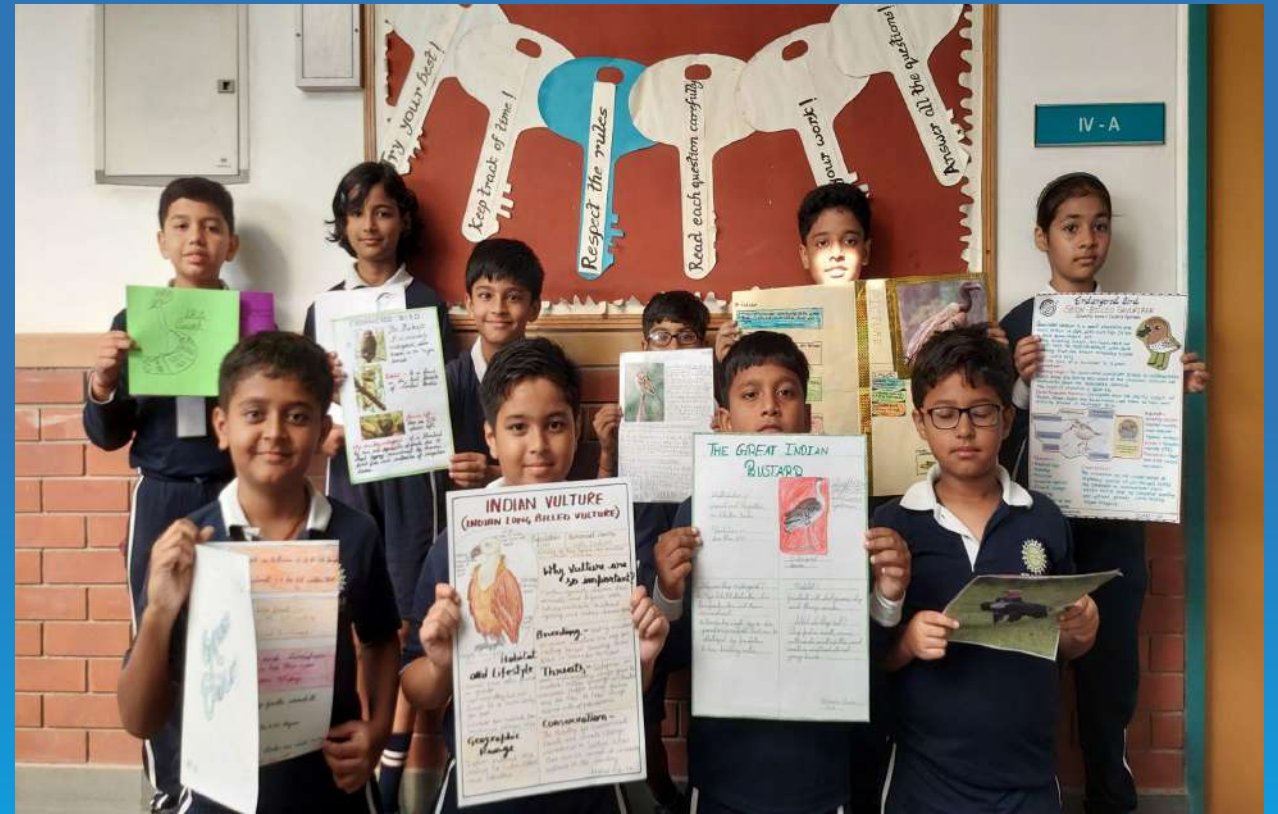
हिन्दी

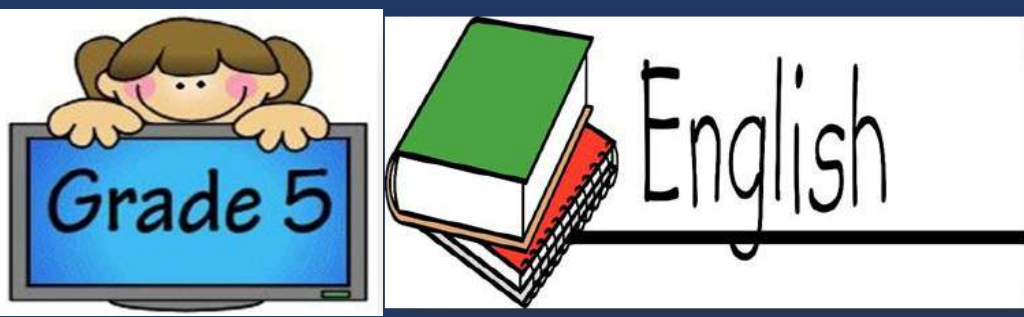




ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE
