# NURSERY



## ENGLISH

Letter V has been revised through picture flashcards and written practice in their workbooks and notebooks.

# MATHS

Children did written practice of number 8 in their workbooks. They also revised oral counting of number 1-40. Children were introduced to oval shape and they enjoyed colouring the worksheet related to the topic.



# HINDI

Revision of vyanjan 'ठ' was done with the help of pictures and through sandpaper tracing.



# GENERAL AWARENESS

As part of Janmashtami celebration children enjoyed colouring the worksheet related to Janmashtami. They also participated in class discussion on Janmashtami and lord Krishna.



# EVS

The bird vulture was introduced to the children during EVS class with the help of pictures. They learnt about vulture and enjoyed colouring the worksheets.



# KINDERGARTEN



## ENGLISH

Introduction of the letter 'n' was done through flashcards, pictures and stories. Children wrote letter n in their workbook and notebook. Introduction of sight words (look, big and this) was done through flash cards.

# MATHS

Students of kindergarten enjoyed learning the skip counting of 2. They enjoyed the bunny hopping activity and worksheets related to it. Introduction of numbers from 110-120 was done through flash cards. Recap of numbers from 0-110 was done to strengthen their concept.



# HINDI

Introduction of vyanjan 'प' was done through stories, pictures and flashcards. Written practice of the same was done in their workbook and notebook.



# GENERAL AWARENESS

It is important for children to learn about the environment around them. This week the children learnt about plants. Discussion on why plants are important to us and the different parts of plants were done in class. Children enjoyed colouring worksheets related to the topic.



# EVS

This week the children were introduced to another wild animal Giraffe. They learnt about its habitat and also coloured a worksheet related to the topic.



# MUSIC(NUR & KG)

The benefits of music education for children include brain development and academic achievement. Students of Nursery and KG enjoyed doing practice of folk songs during music class.



# YOGA (NUR & KG)

Regular practice of yoga improves a child's flexibility, which can reduce their chance of injury. This week the children practiced Surya namaskar, Ustrasana, simhasana, Gomukhasana, marjariasana, butterfly and bhujangasana.



# JANMASHTAMI SPECIAL ASSEMBLY

Gokulashtami is merely another name for Krishna Janmashtami, the date of Krishna's birth. The students of the nursery conducted the special assembly on Janmashtami on 6th September, 2023. A fun and frolic celebration included singing, dancing and a skit highlighting Krishna's childhood. The students were dressed as Kanha and Radha to celebrate the occasion.





“Poetry - the best words in the best order”. Students of class 1 were taught the poem of the month during the week. They learned the poem during the class and practiced the same with voice modulation. Later this week they learned how to use magic ‘e’ or silent ‘e’. It will help a child to read, write and relate English words and language more easily and quickly.





# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

National festivals play an important role in planting the seed of nationalism and patriotism among the people of India. Celebration of these festivals commemorates the sacrifices of our great leaders and freedom fighters who laid down their lives in the foundation of this country. This week children learned about the need to celebrate national festivals and why we celebrate them. They read the lesson and also made two national symbols of our country in the notebook along with the new words.





# Math

Children of class 1 learnt number names from 40 - 49. They did written work related to it. Mental math refers to doing math calculations without the use of any tool. Students practiced mental sums during the class as a part of class activity.

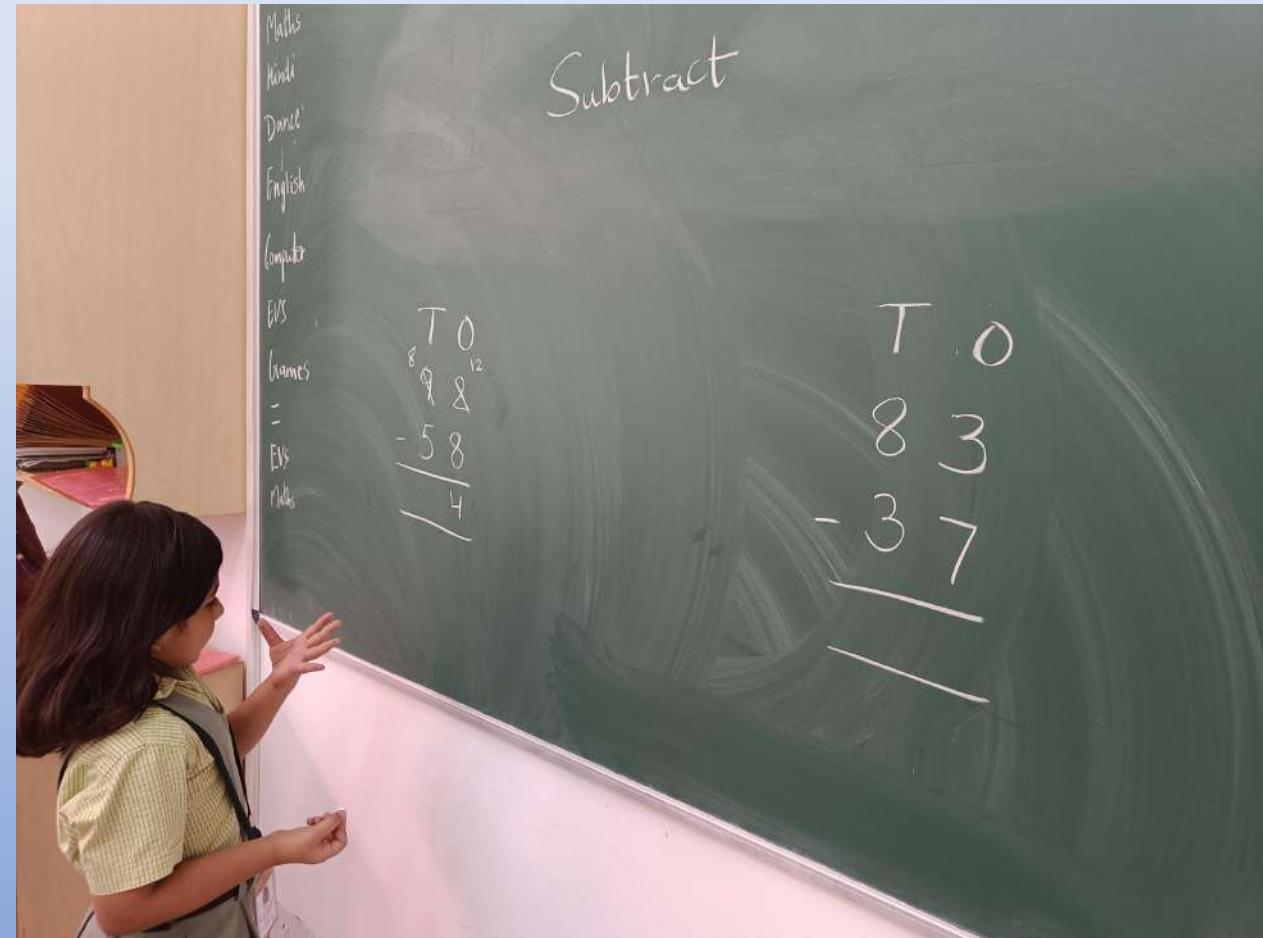




# Math

Students of class 2 were introduced to 3D shapes like cylinder, cube, cuboid, cone and sphere etc. They learnt about their faces, vertices and edges. They also revised subtraction with regrouping and practiced doing word problems of Multiplication in their notebooks. Also answered a few questions based on the mental math that was posed during the regular math class. Students could give the correct answer orally for the dodging of tables till 8.

These quick movements raise heart rate, challenge both balance and coordination, and help to improve speed and athletic performance of a body.

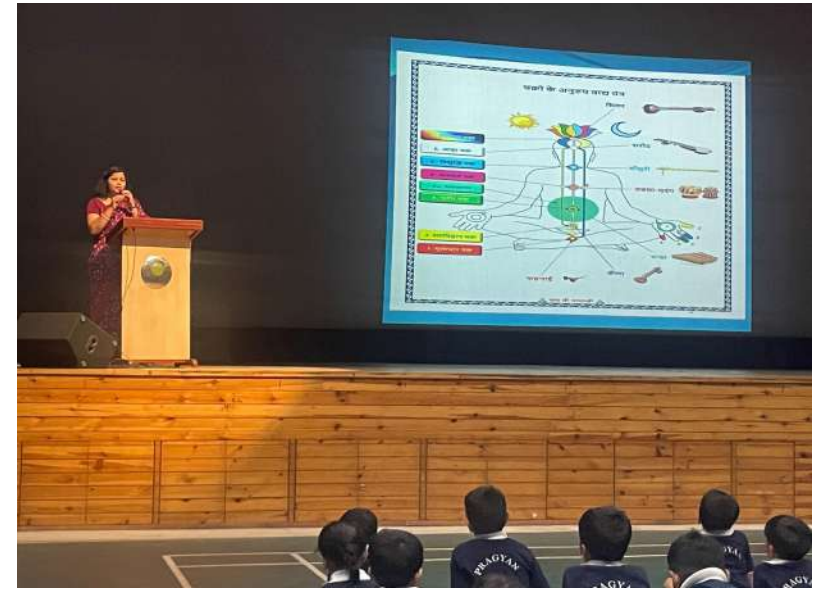
# CELEBRATING FESTIVAL
