# NURSERY



## ENGLISH

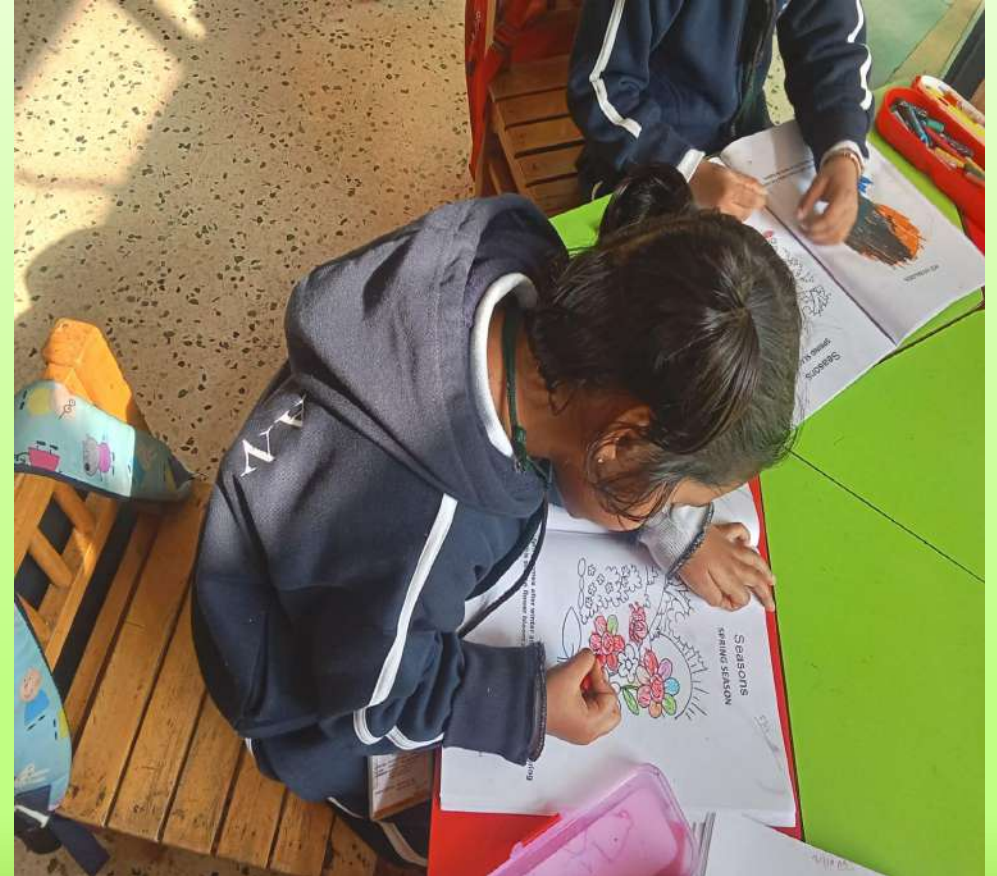
# HINDI

# KINDERGARTEN

## ENGLISH



Recap of 'e' family words was done through flashcards along with the introduction of 'ig' family words. Students also practiced writing 'ig' family words in their notebook and did worksheets based on 'ig' family.

# HINDI

Introduction of Vyanjan 'ट' was done with the help of pictures. Students wrote 'ट' in their notebook and workbook.



# GENERAL AWARENESS

Recapitulation of the topics transport and community helpers were done in the class through worksheets. Children were also introduced to the topic 'Seasons'.



# DANCE

Dance is a self-expression that allows the child to grow into themselves as they learn about the world around them. Students enjoyed practicing the dance movements for the upcoming Grandparents day event.



# RESOURCE ACTIVITIES

During the week students enjoyed a few resource activities like play with numbers,recapitulation of vyanjans, discussion on seasons, reciting the rhymes done so far. Students tried to arrange the numbers in ascending order, then choose the correct number name, and finally place the sharpeners as per the number. Some of the learning outcomes of these activities were recognition, observation, critical thinking and strengthening of the concepts taught.



# YOGA (NUR & KG)

Yoga improves balance, strength and aerobic capacity in children. Students of class Nursery and KG practiced some yoga asanas to stay fit.





Students of grade 1 were introduced to the poem of the month ‘A happy child’. They were also introduced to the concept of ‘Punctuation’ in English class where they were taught to use capital letters in the beginning of any sentence and end it with a full stop (.) or question mark (?). They were shown a youtube video for reference as well.





# Math

Children of class 1 practiced sums based on subtraction and money. In the money chapter they did addition and subtraction of money. In the subtraction chapter they practiced single digit subtraction. Revision helps students gauge their strengths and knowledge in a particular subject.





# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Students of grade 1 were introduced to the concept of living and nonliving things this week. They were engrossed in the thinking activity about the topic. Students were engaged and had an entertaining class discussion on the topic: can we change non-living things into living things?

In the initial grade, students explored the letter "औ," its associated matra, and the proper pronunciation. They participated in reading activities that featured words incorporating the matra and subsequently finished a classroom task 'मात्रा खड़ी' in their notebooks. Additionally, a video was shown to augment their understanding of how matras are utilized in words. They also revised the इ/ ई matra and drew a few pictures related to the matras.





Safety is very important for everyone. Students of class 2 read the chapter - Safety during their EVS class. They also enjoyed drawing a first aid box and shared its importance with their classmates.

# PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)

Students of class 1 did regular exercises and stretching exercises. Also they practiced march past. It teaches discipline, coordination, and respect. It helps students to develop a sense of pride and responsibility, as well as a sense of teamwork. By marching in step with others, students learn to cooperate and move in unison. Marching also teaches students to obey commands quickly and accurately.



# LIBRARY (1 & 2)

A traditional form of teaching is storytelling. One of the most important benefits of reading stories is that it helps children have better cognitive skills and encourages them to learn, write, and read. Students of classes 1 & 2 had a storytelling session in which the librarian narrated a story called Greedy Dog in class 1 and class 2 Fox and Crane. After the story narration, they had a question-answer session. The children resumed reading other books after the session.





Students of class 3 were introduced to the poem of the month 'My Brother Ate My Smartphone.' They revised the grammatical concept of Degrees of Comparison and did related exercises. The lesson Amparo's Journey was introduced too. The new words and their meanings and questions and answers were done too. They read from the reader and wrote a paragraph on The Funniest Zoo Animal.





Students of class 3 read the chapter “Jal hi Jeevan hai.They also started reciting the poem of the month, ‘Nav Varsh’.





Students of class 4 were taught the concept of Tenses. Explanation was done followed by related written work in the notebook and practice worksheets. Topic Subject Verb Agreement was introduced. Poem and new words of the month were introduced. Lesson Wizard of Oz was introduced.

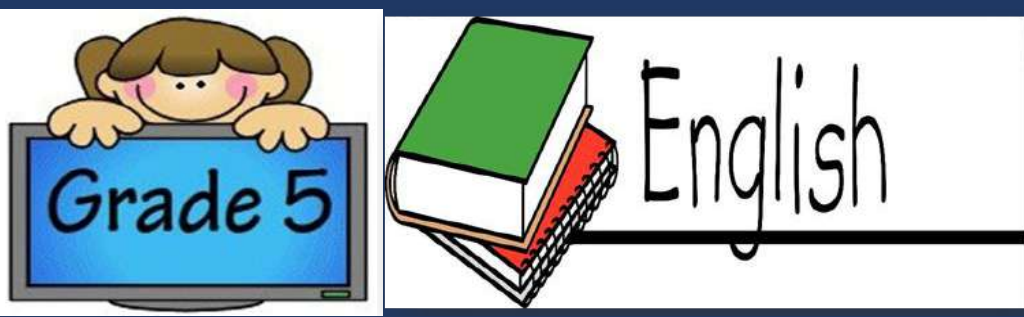




# हिन्दी

Students of Class 5B presented the morning assembly on the topic, “PEACE”. They did prayer and presented news. They conducted a quiz too. Students shared useful information about how we can maintain peace on earth. They shared some facts, recited poems and presented a dance on the theme.
