Music - Students practiced the song ‘Sare jahan se acha’.

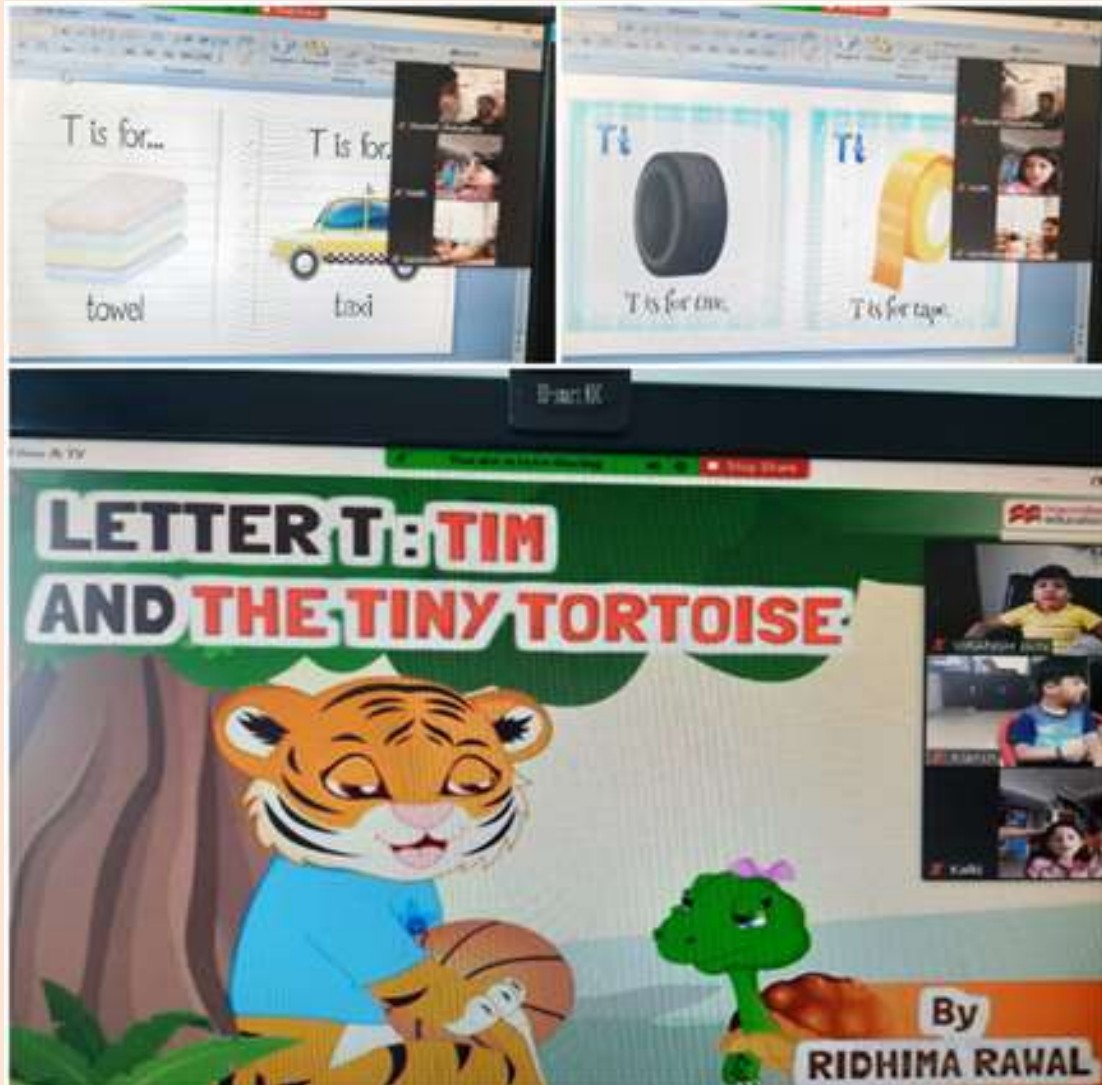

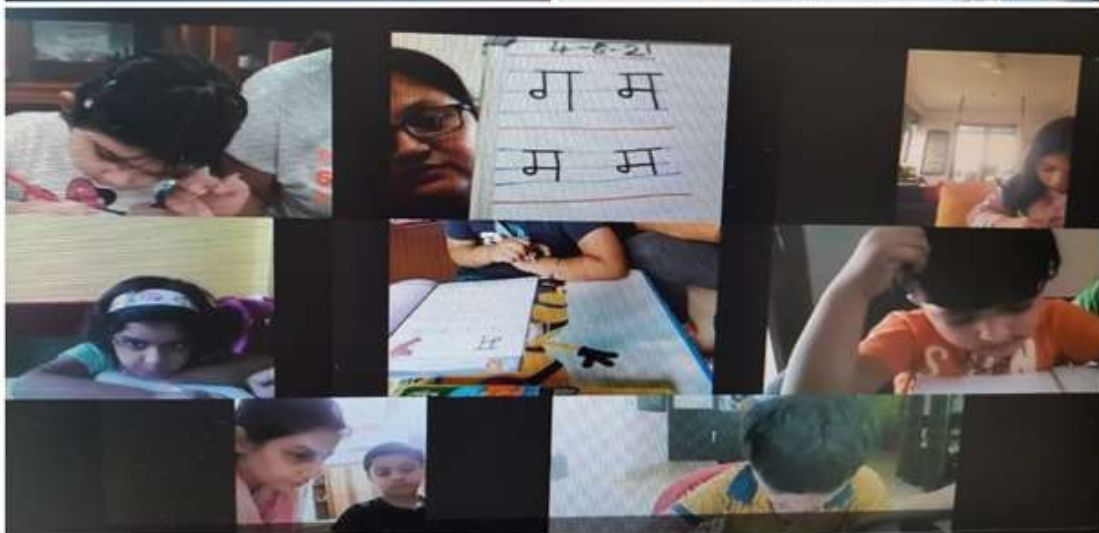
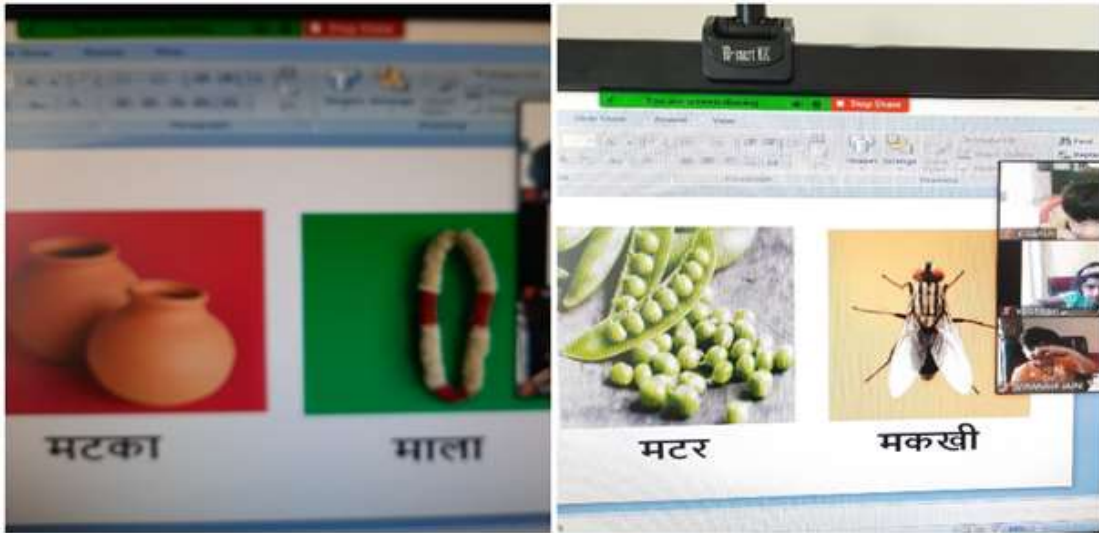

GA - Students learnt about food that why we should eat healthy food and why we should avoid eating junk food etc. Colouring worksheets of the topic we're done.

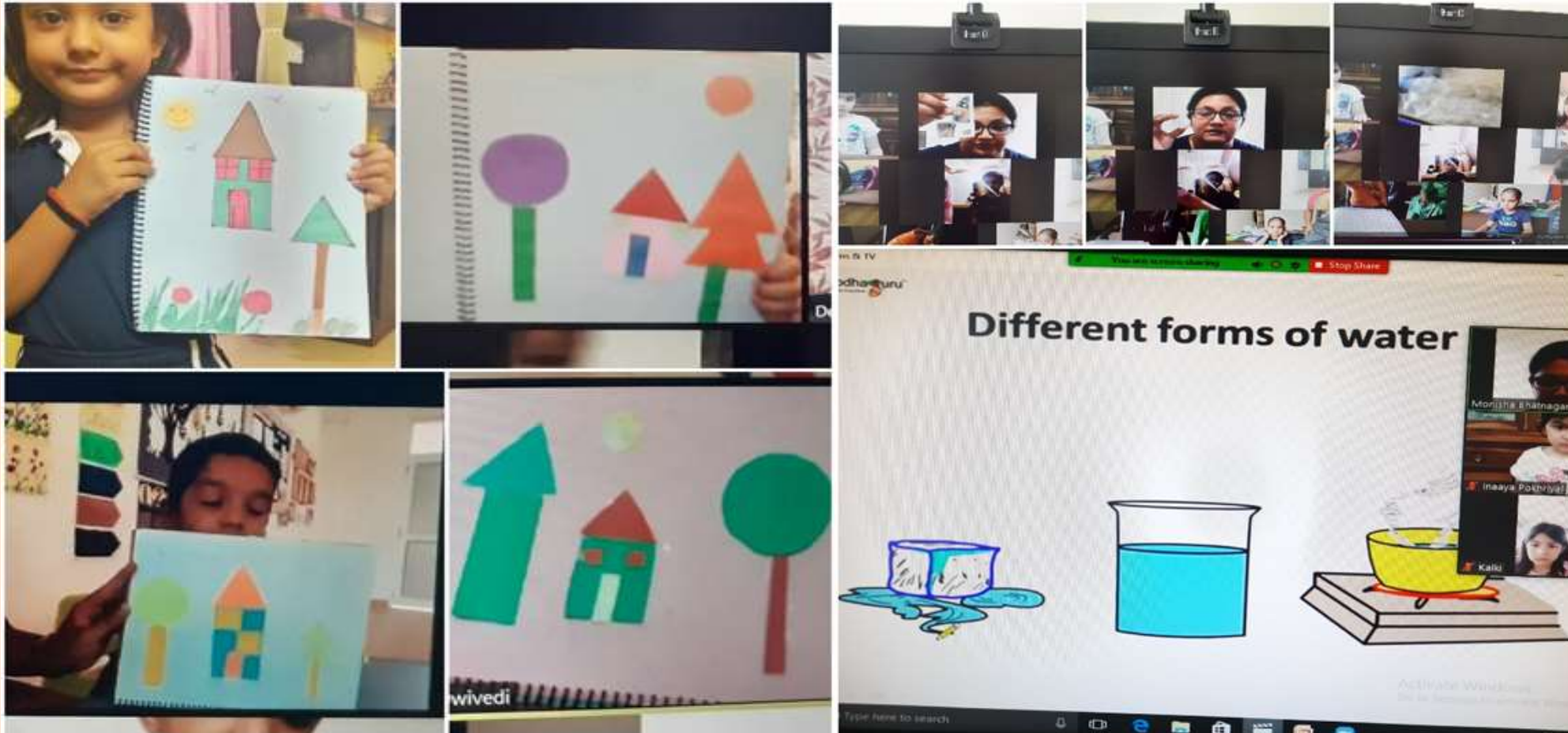
Music -students enjoyed learning Sare Jahan se Achaa in the class.

Class Activity - Students enjoyed activity of fun with shapes.

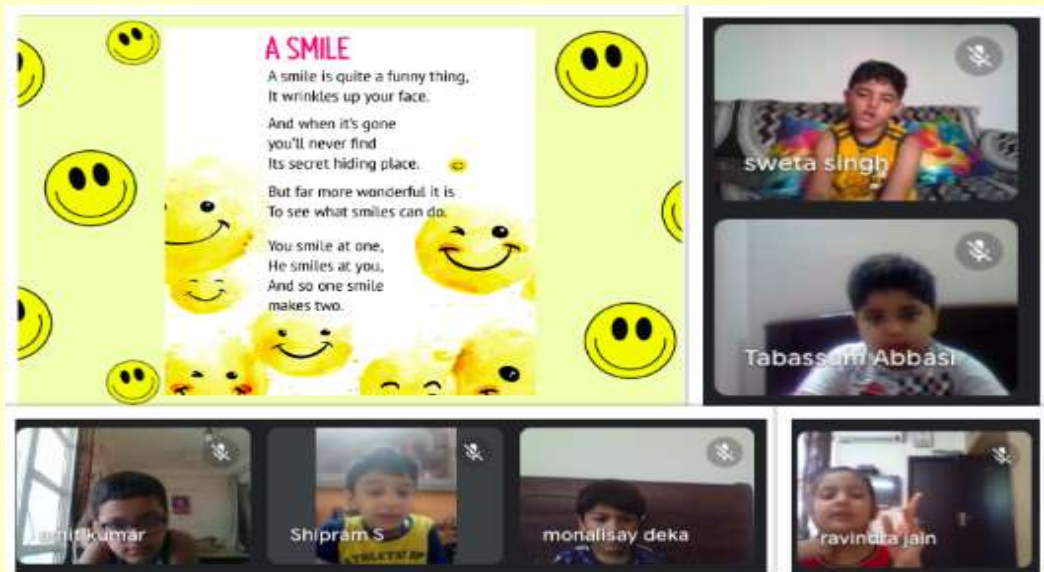
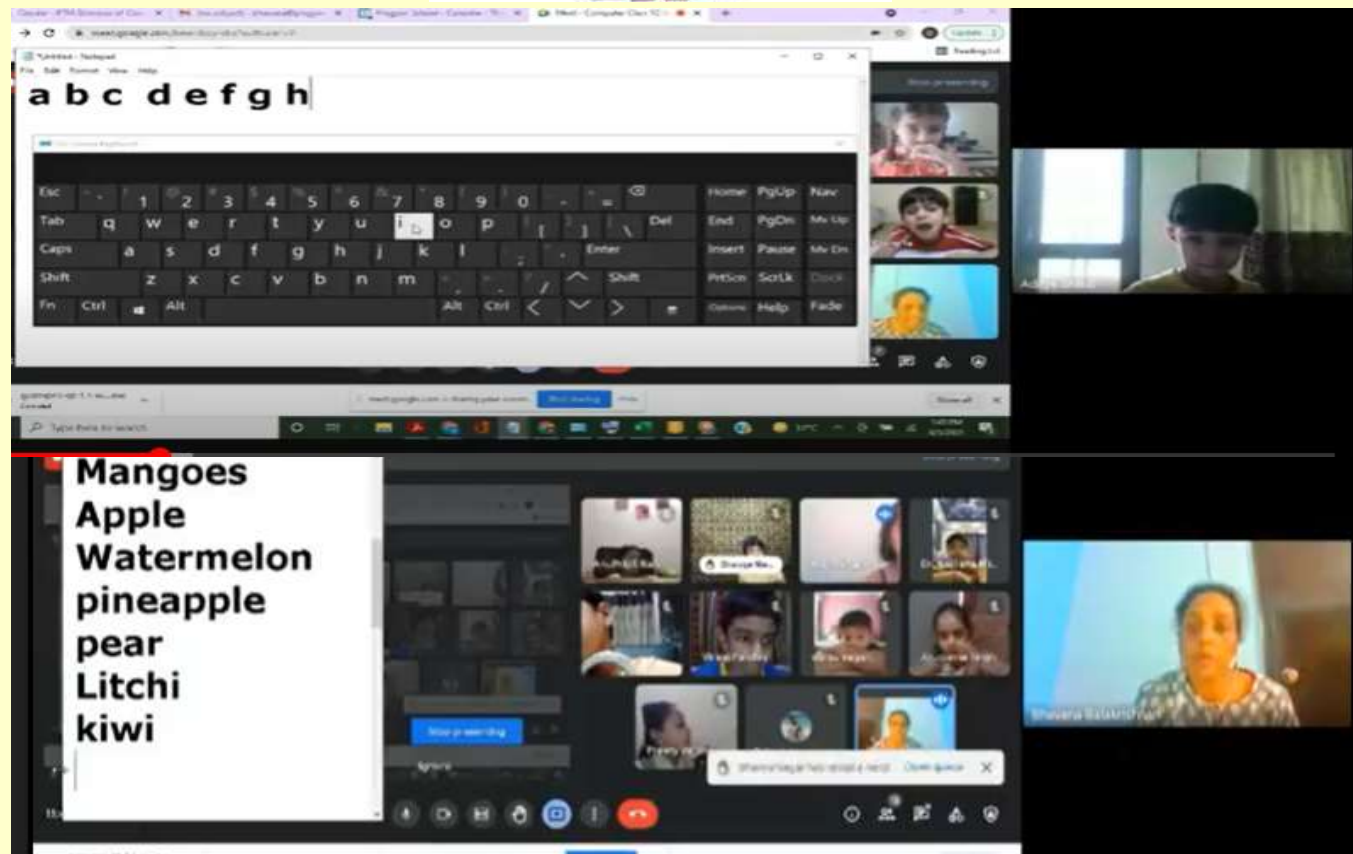
Science Demo - Students were explained about three states of water ,liquid solid and gas .

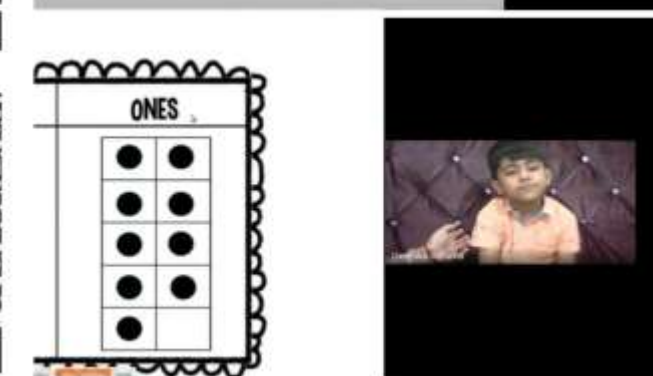
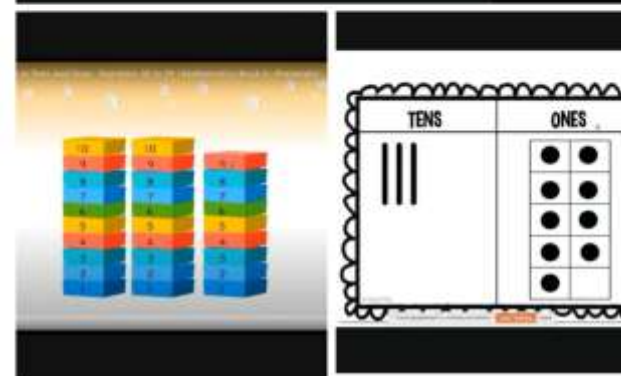
Festivals of India

India is known as a "Land of festivals". Every year India celebrates hundreds of festivals across different religions. Festivals in India celebrate the unity in diversity of the country.

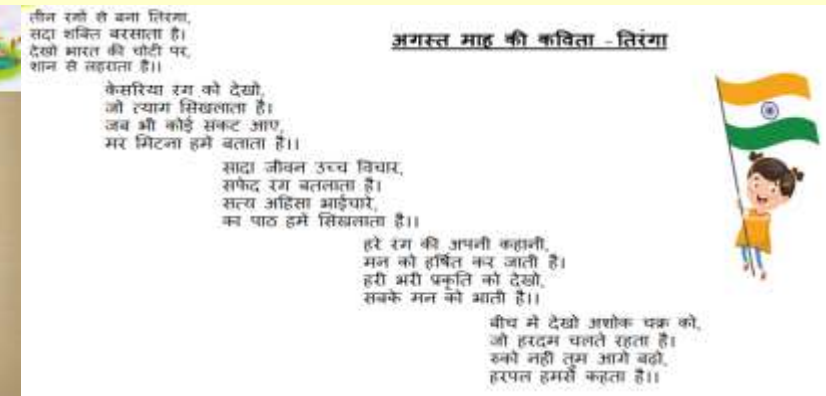
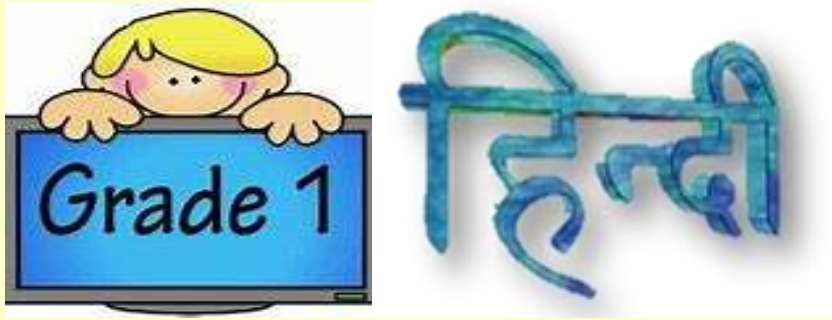

CLASS TEACHER PERIOD(1&2)

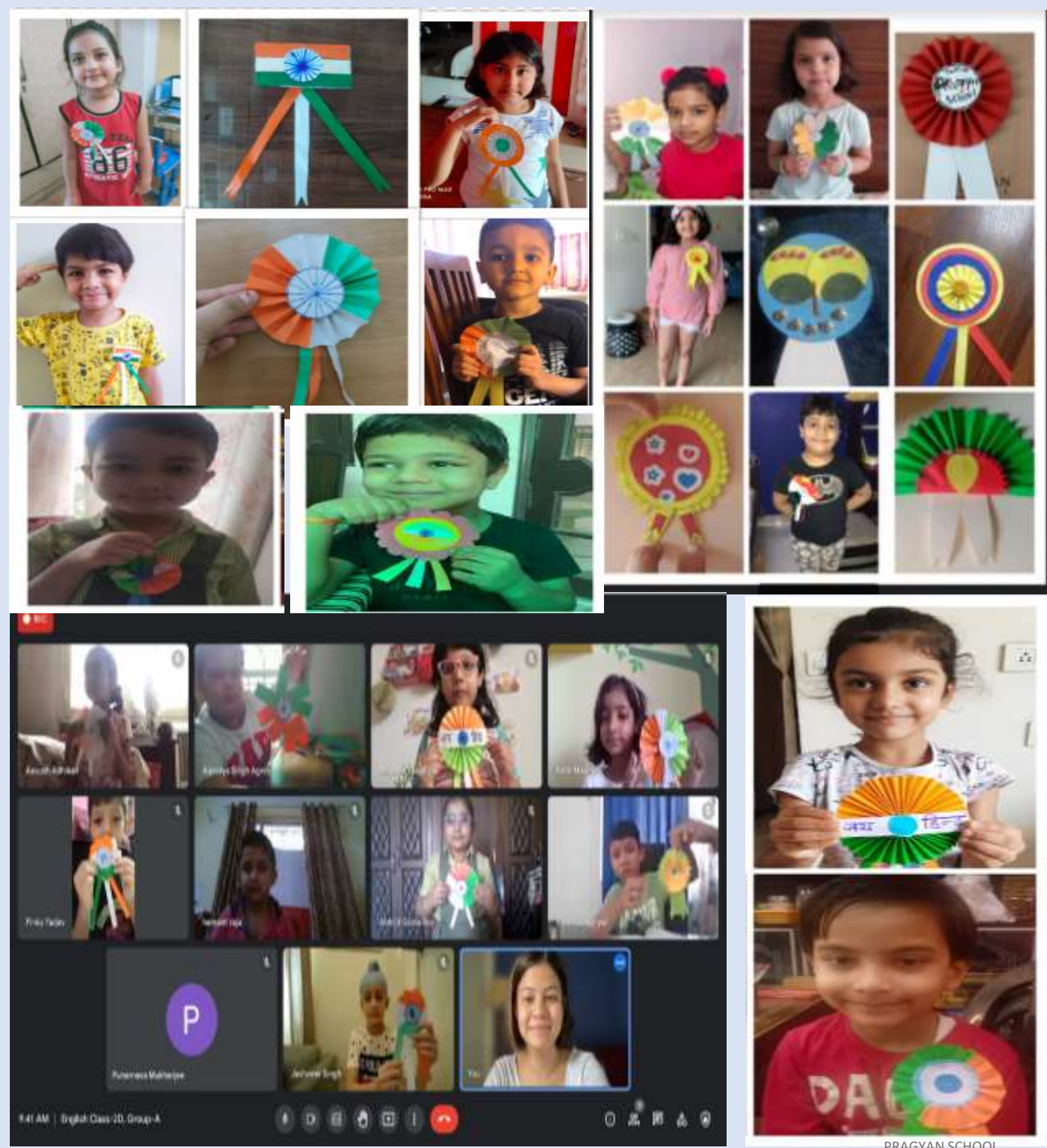

Nerves

- Nerves spread through the spinal cord to the face, ears, eyes, nose and the rest of the body.
- They form a web within the body.
- Each nerve is a bundle of hundreds or thousands of neurons (nerve cells).
- There are two main types of nerves:
 - Sensory Nerves take information from the sense organs and pass it to the brain through the spinal cord.
 - Motor Nerves pass instructions to carry out actions, given by the brain, to muscles and other parts of the body.
