**Maths**: Oral practice of forward counting (0-20) and backward counting (20-0) was done in the class. Written practice of what comes After, Before and Between was done in the class.



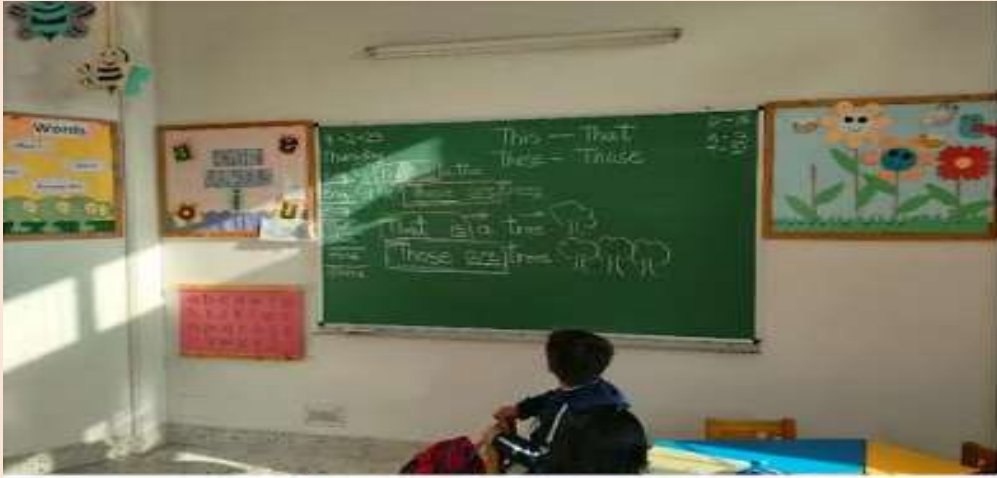


**GA**: Introduction of different type of tools used by community helpers was done in the class.
