NURSERY



ENGLISH

Letter T was introduced to the children of nursery with the help of flashcards. Jolly phonics song of letter T was also done with the children. Students did worksheets related to the topic in their workbook.

MATHS

Curve lines was introduced to the nursery children and they enjoyed worksheets related to the concept. Numeral 2 was also introduced through sandpaper tracing. They also practiced the same in their workbook.



GENERAL AWARENESS

As part of general awareness, discussion on My Family was done with the students. They also enjoyed the “Finger Family” rhyme and coloured worksheets related to the topic.



KINDERGARTEN

ENGLISH



Introduction of the letter 'e' was done through flashcards and pictures. Phonics sound of 'e' was taught to the children. They practiced writing the letter 'e' in their workbook and notebook. Sight words like this, that, home, has were introduced through flash cards.

MATHS

Recapitulation of what comes after and before was done. The concept of what comes in between was introduced with the help of objects. Children did worksheets based on the concepts.





MATHS

During this week students revised what comes after, before and in between concepts in the notebook. They were introduced to a new topic ascending order through an activity with teaching aids like blocks, pencils, bottles and standing in a queue according to their heights etc.



DANCE(NUR-UKG)

This week students of Nursery - UKG delved into the rhythms of different songs. Little dancers learned intricate steps and embraced the joy of movement.



YOGA (NUR-UKG)

This week, students of Nursery learned Vajrasana, Shavasana, Vrikshasana, and Tadasana. They demonstrated focus, flexibility, and balance during yoga sessions. These poses promote relaxation, strength, and posture improvement.



EASP(NUR-UKG)

This week in EASP, students focused on hurdle race, zigzag race, catch throw and balancing activities. Progress is evident as students are refining their techniques and demonstrating increased coordination and agility.



INTER CLASS ACTIVITY

Students of classes Nur - UKG had their Inter class Wednesday activity - "Tear & paste" on 8th May, 2024. They were taught the method of tearing & pasting during their regular art class. The best entries were assessed on the basis of neatness and presentation. Winners will soon be awarded with certificates.



HANDS ON ACTIVITY (KG & UKG)

During the week students of KG & UKG were engaged in various activities like read the word and choose the rhyming word from the group of words. The activity helped students in developing phonemic awareness, which is crucial for early literacy. Students could identify the pictures and were able to make words by joining two vyanjans. They also did an activity of Pegging the numbers in ascending order that improves fine motor skill, and engages students in experimental play.



SKILL BASED LEARNING(KG &UKG)

This week, our kindergarten students delved into the vital topic of kitchen hygiene as part of skill based learning. It's crucial because instilling good hygiene practices early on sets the foundation for a lifetime of safe food preparation habits. Learning about cleanliness and sanitation in the kitchen, empowers students to take charge of their own health and develop healthy eating habits.

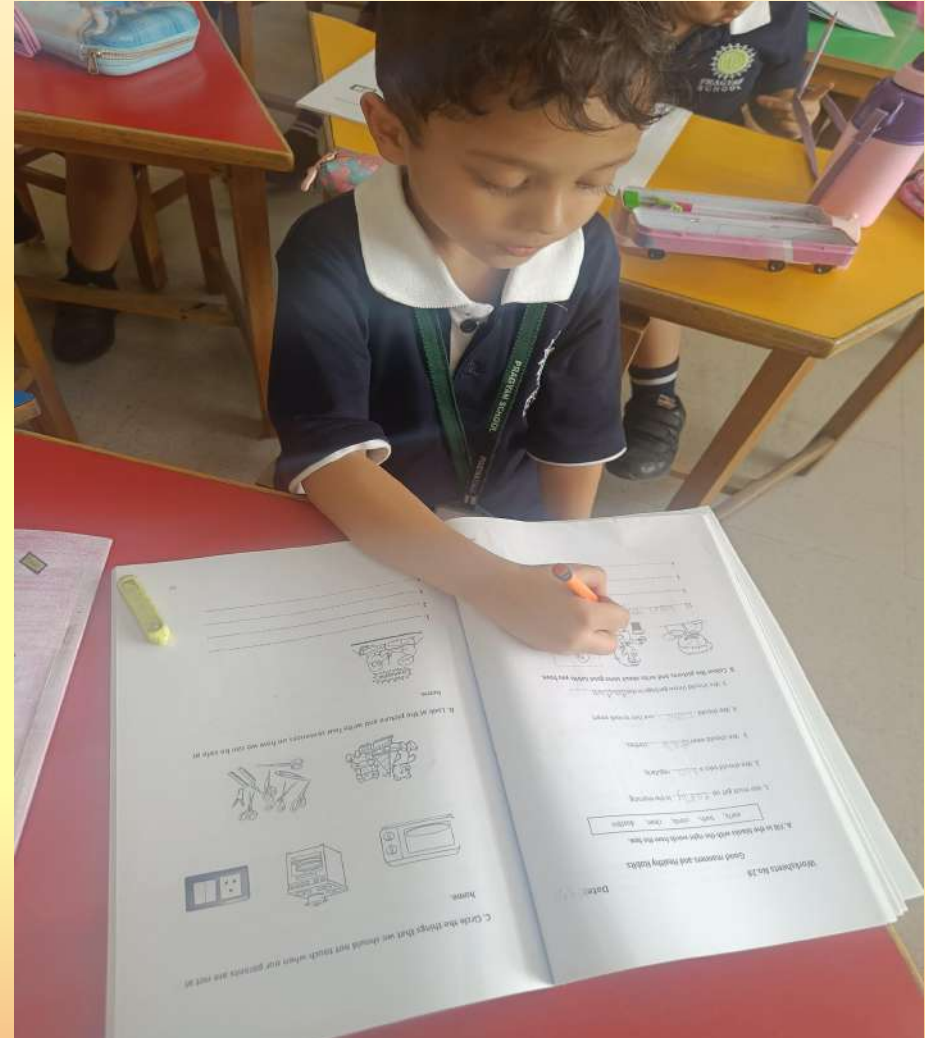
Some of the students also enjoyed a lot while with sand where they were free to make the things of their choice. This helps to improve their creativity and decision making.

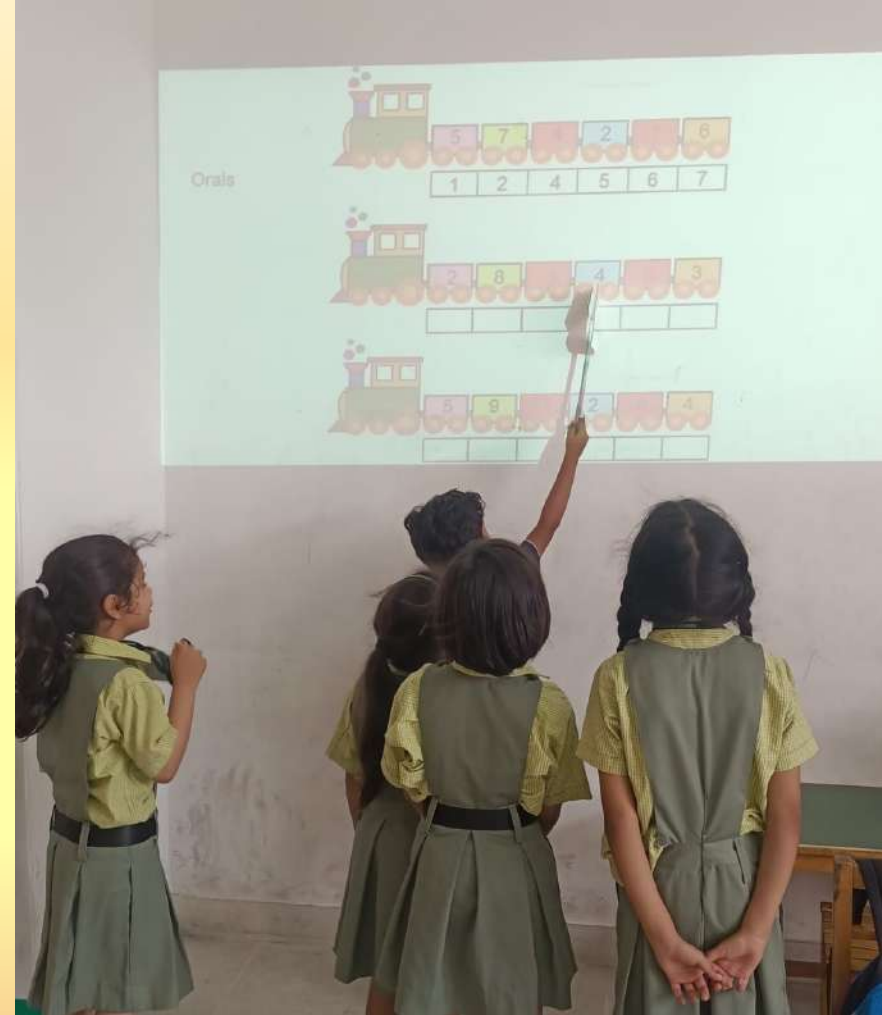




Math

Children of class 1 learnt descending order and basic shapes. Descending order is important because it helps classify data from the most important to the least important item or from the highest value to the lowest value. For example, it can help you compare prices of items by arranging them from their highest to lowest price. Basic shapes concept was also introduced. Related videos and PPTs were shown.

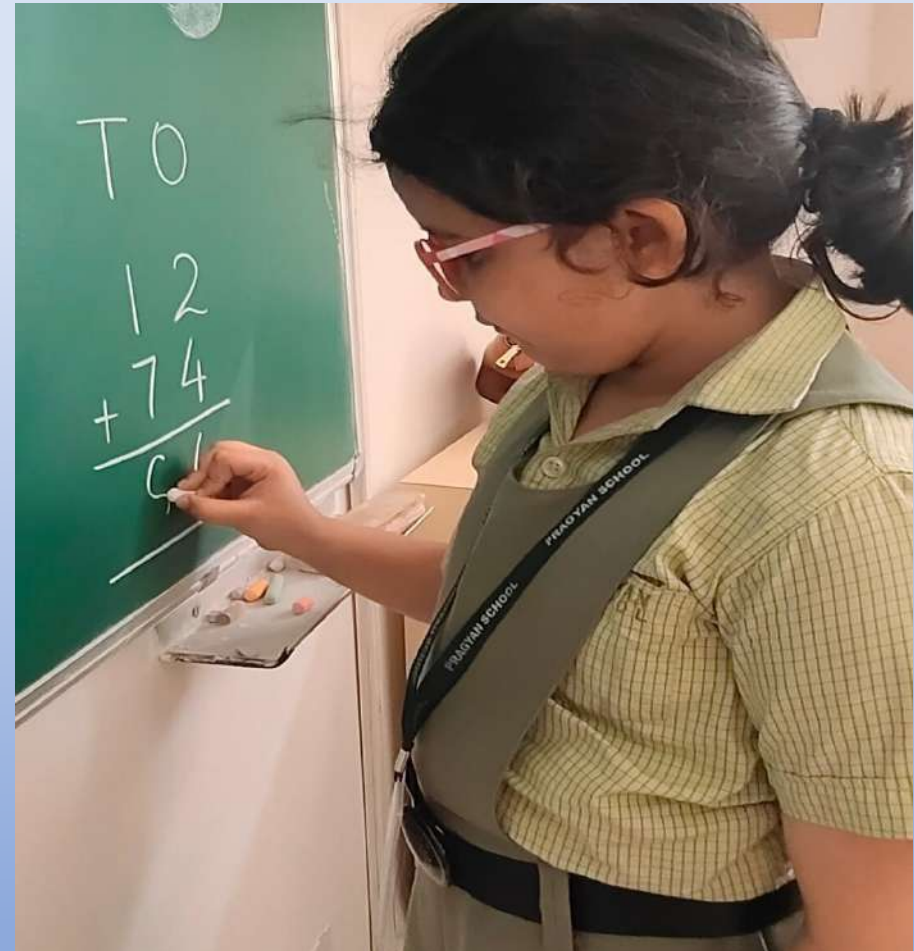




Math

Knowledge of basic addition facts help students to speed up math tasks. Without thorough mastery of the addition facts, kids struggle as they start to tackle subtraction, word problems, and problems with bigger numbers. Students of class 2 understood the facts of addition and applied them in their problem solving. Worksheets based on addition with carry over and addition facts were done by kids in class along with the revision of tables of 5 and 6.



INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC (1&2)



Musical instruments serve as the main conduit for experiencing music, offering both enjoyment and educational opportunities for children. In their instrumental music class, second-grade students are learning basic bongo beats and xylophone melodies.

ART & CRAFT (1&2)



Handprinting engages multiple senses, provides an opportunity for self-expression, improves fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination, and can be a relaxing and calming activity. Students of classes 1 and 2 have done the handprints card making for mother's day in their regular art class.

VOCAL MUSIC (CLASS 2)



Goddess Sharada is also called Saraswati. She is the Goddess of learning. She provides intelligence, mind, wisdom and logic. Children enjoyed learning the prayer hey sharde maa and revised the song hey gyan roopi bhagwan.

DANCE (1&2)

Dance is an art to explore your feelings. It is a great activity for kids of all ages . It improves coordination , self confidence and enhances motor skills. So the students of class 1 started learning a small story enactment through dance.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1 & 2)

Throwing and catching trains the coordination of hand and eye as well as the ability to react and concentration. These are the skills that are of outstanding importance in everyday school life. Children enjoyed learning catch and throw and did regular exercise.
