# NURSERY



## ENGLISH

Letter K was introduced to the children with the help of flashcards. They also did Jolly phonics song of letter K. They also identified different objects starting with letter K. Students did worksheets related to the letter in their workbook.

# EASP

# MATHS

# GENERAL AWARENESS

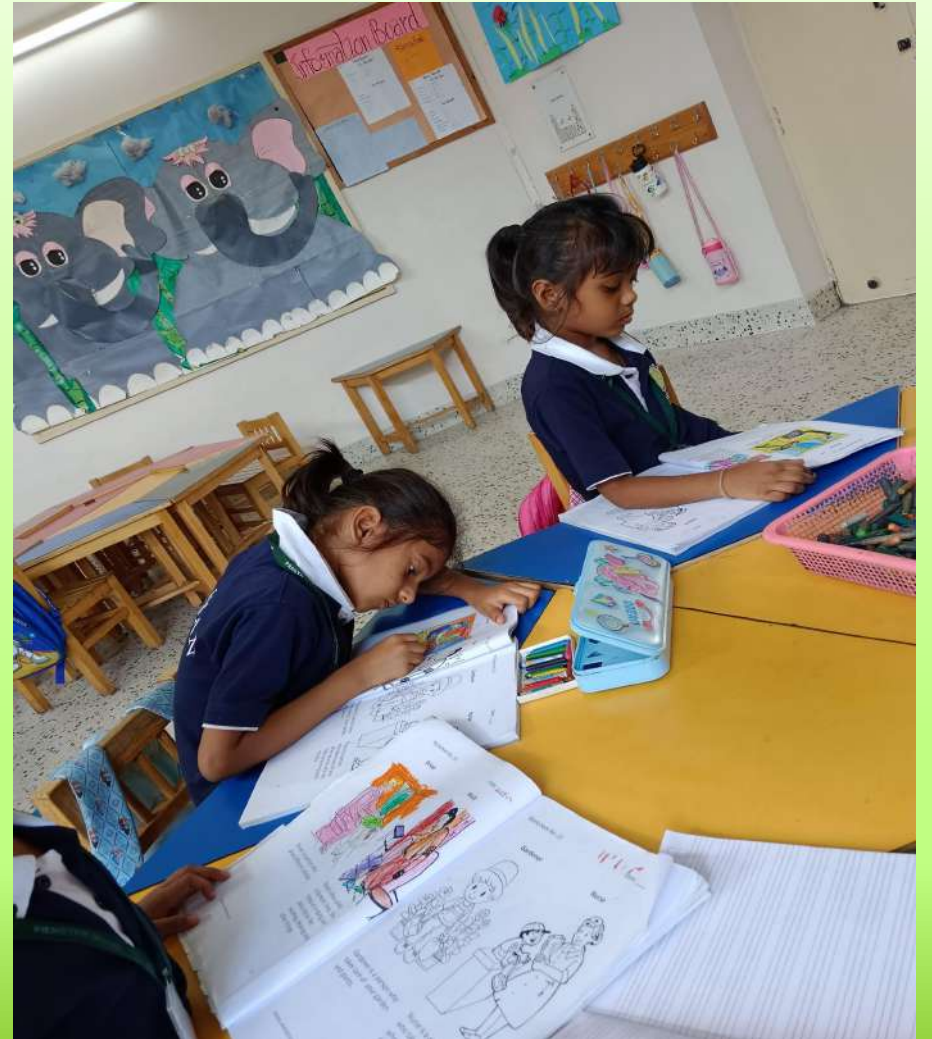
# HINDI

# GENERAL AWARENESS

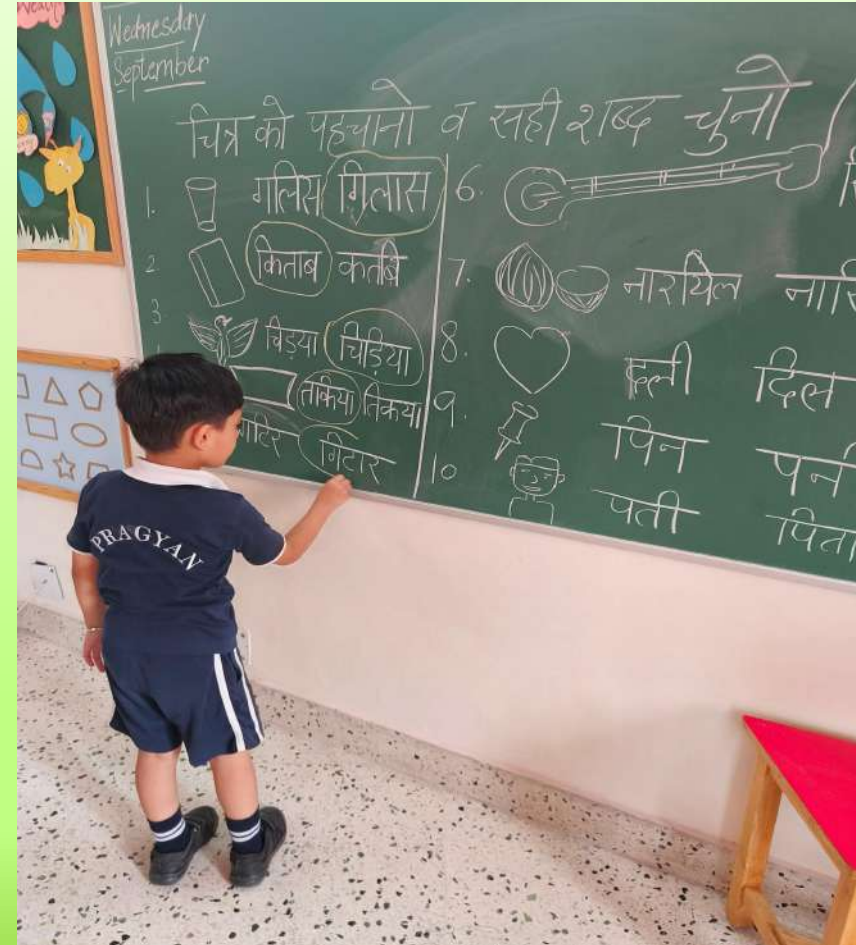
# MATHS

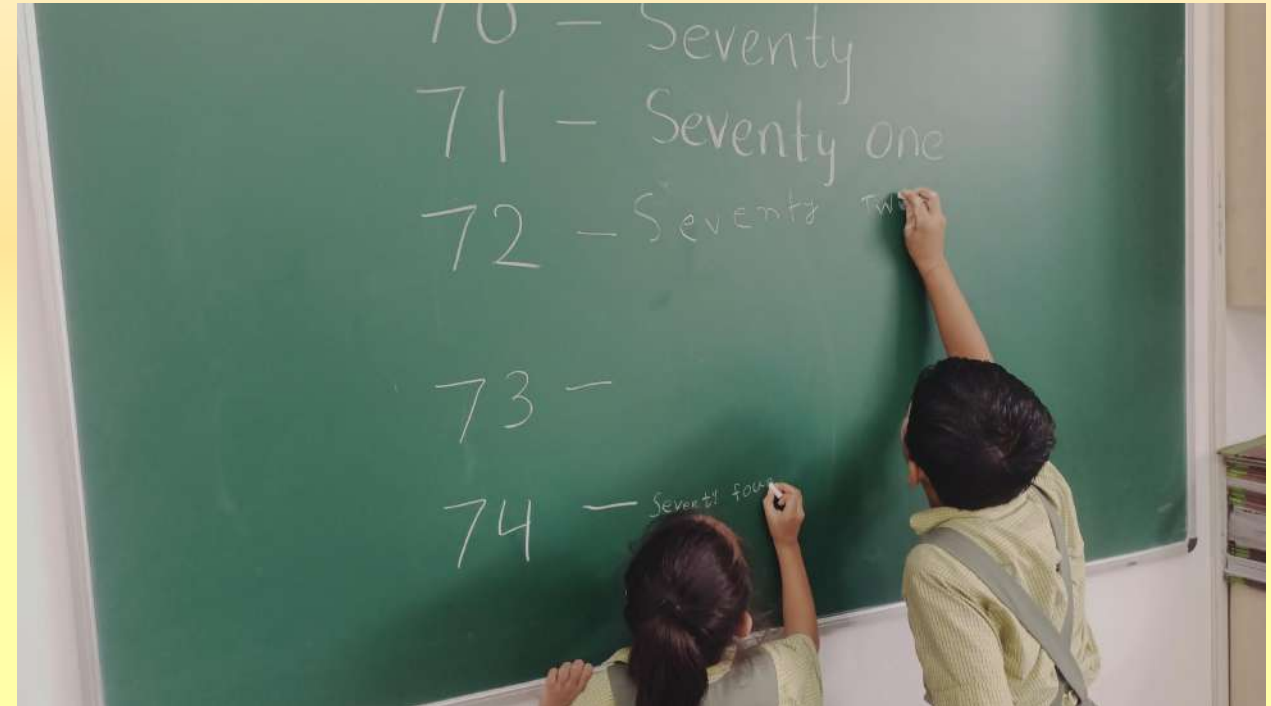
# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

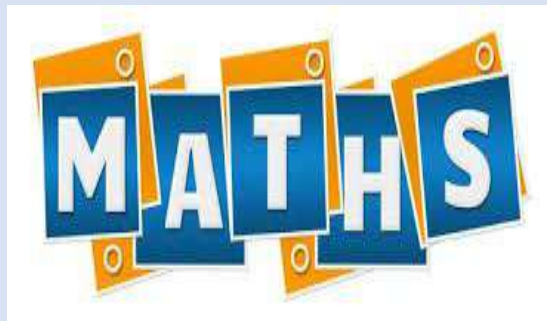
Reading stimulates a child's brain development, enhancing their understanding of the world and fostering critical thinking. Early reading cultivates a strong vocabulary, improves communication skills, and strengthens literacy. The Class 2 students began exploring a new chapter titled "Sharing the Harvest," where each student had the chance to read aloud a few lines. They actively engaged in a class discussion on the theme "Sharing is Caring," enthusiastically contributing their thoughts on how sharing brings them joy.





Clothes protect us from occupational hazards, weather, heat, dust, rain and cold. In continuation to the chapter read last week students of class 2 tried answering the questions related to the chapter - Clothes. They also did a few workbook exercises related to the chapter. Students also actively participated in a class activity where they shared a few points about their favourite festival.





Revision is a critical aspect of the learning process, especially for early learners, as it reinforces understanding and promotes long-term retention of knowledge. Students of grade 2 revised the tables from 2 to 9 and subtraction of two digit numbers. They did worksheets based on the topic of 2D and 3D shapes.



# INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC (1&2)

Introducing children to music during their early developmental years significantly enhances their ability to recognize sounds and grasp the meanings of words. Building on their previous practice of the birthday song, the students were introduced to the second verse (mukhda) of the song. They approached the lesson with great enthusiasm, showing eagerness to learn and apply the musical concepts. This not only strengthened their musical skills but also deepened their understanding of rhythm, melody, and language.



# DANCE (1&2)

Dance is an art to explore our feelings. So the students of class 1, 2 started learning a dance choreography for upcoming school events.



# ART & CRAFT (1&2)



Sketching increases the fine motor skills. Students of grade 2 did the drawing of famous artist “S.H Raza “ in their regular art class. Students of grade 1 drew a landscape drawing in their regular art class.

# VOCAL MUSIC (1&2)

This was followed by question answer session and then the students resumed their reading.

Students worked hard along with their teachers and presented a wonderful exhibition in the school foyer on the theme 'Tiny Treasures'.





Students of class 3 revised the poem of the month 'Send a drop of kindness' and the new words. They were introduced to the lesson 'The Elf and the Dormouse'. They revised the grammatical concepts of punctuation and gender nouns. 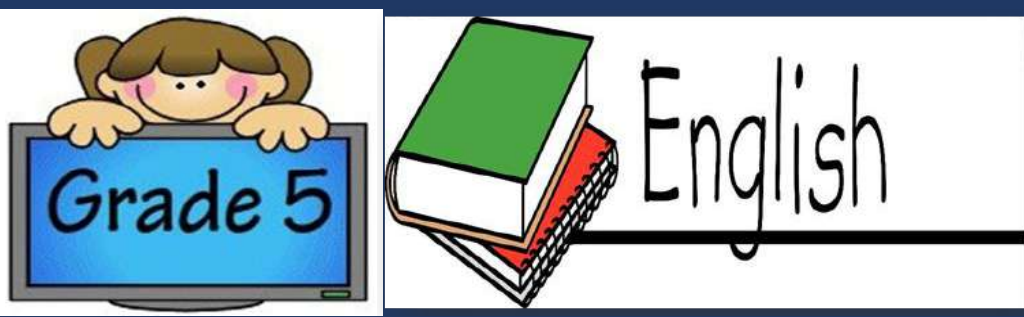




# ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE
